CONG PRESIDENT OR NOT, RAHUL WILL ALWAYS HAVE PRE-EMINENT PLACE IN PARTY - CHIDAMBARAM

Senior Congress leader P. Chidambaram on Sunday favoured a consensus for the post of the AICC chief and asserted that Rahul Gandhi will always have a "pre-eminent place" in the party irrespective of whether he is president or not as he is the "acknowledged leader" of the rank and file.

So far, Rahul Gandhi has declined to take on the mantle of party presidency but may change his mind, the former Union minister and Congress Working Committee member said, just days ahead of the notification of polls to elect the AICC chief.

In an interview with PTI, Chidambaram said there was no occasion for any controversy over the fairness and transparency of the party president polls and asserted that had central election authority chairman Madhusudan Mistry's last statement on

the concerns of some of the leaders come on the first day, the matter would have stood resolved.

Underlining that it is not the practice of any political party to publish the roll of the electoral college, he said the PCC-wise electoral roll will be available for inspection at the office of the PCC concerned, while the all India electoral roll will be available for inspection at the office of the AICC.

"Every nominated candidate will be entitled to a copy of the electoral roll. Mr Mistry has since clarified these self-evident points and the MPs have said they were satisfied. The matter is rested," Chidambaram said.

Lok Sabha members Shashi Tharoor, Manish Tewari, Karti Chidambaram, Pradyut Bordoloi, and Abdul Khaleque, had written to Mistry, seeking clarity on the issue of electoral rolls, to which the party's poll panel chief

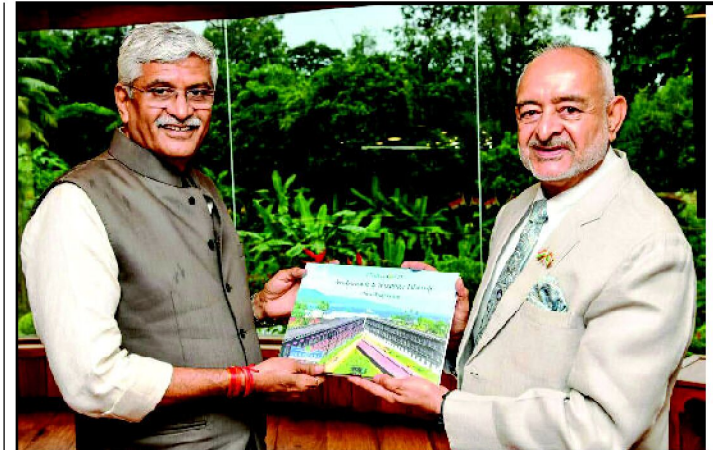


had clarified that anyone wanting to file nomination for the post of Congress president will be able to see the list of the over 9,000 PCC delegates at the AICC's central election authority office from September 20.

P Chidambaram also asked if the media had raised such issues when the BJP or any other party held its party elections.

"I cannot recall Mr J P Nadda asking for the electoral roll or filing his nomination!" he said.

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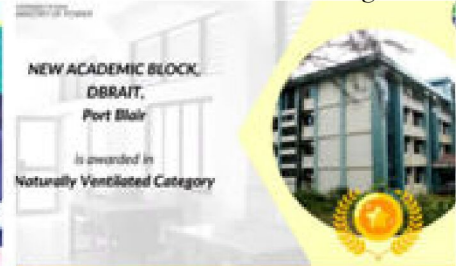

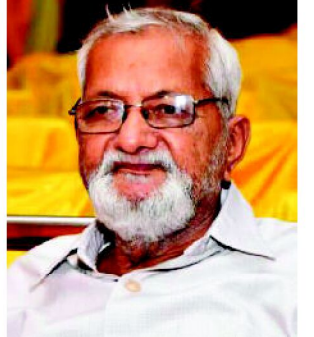

Battling backlogs

The new Supreme Court case listing system devised by CJI UU Lalit seems to be effective, going by a sharp reduction in pendency. In 13 days, SC disposed of 5,200 cases and admitted 1,135 fresh matters – 70,310 matters were pending as of September 1. There's a long way to go but pendency will reduce if cases disposed steadily outnumber new cases. Essentially, CJI's new listing system attempts to expedite hearings in after-notice matters, which keep getting backlogged, by listing more of them on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoons. Also, more fresh admission matters are being listed on Mondays and Fridays.

While one two-judge bench confessed its inability to hear all the afternoon matters listed, another bench last week had critiqued a lawyer for seeking adjournment despite judges working longer hours preparing for cases since the new listing system began. Promptly filling four vacancies in SC – by November, there will be seven vacancies if these four are not filled – can reduce pressure on judges. SC should also be choosier when admitting matters. Many PILs admitted by SC end up in unhelpful court interventions in policy, political and socio-cultural issues.

SC's urgency in whittling down pendency must also rub off on high courts where 59 lakh cases are pending. 2019 was a rare year where HCs recorded more case disposals than fresh cases. But the pandemic increased the backlog again. Like SC, around 70% of HC pendency involves admission stage matters. So similar reforms in listing must be pursued in HCs too. Central and state governments, the biggest litigants, must help in upgrading judicial infrastructure, promptly filling judicial vacancies and weeding out frivolous litigation. Why not a one-year action plan to reduce pendency from present levels by 25% in HCs and by 50% in SC?

NEW MOBILE BANKING VIRUS PROWLING IN INDIAN CYBERSPACE

A new mobile banking 'Trojan' virus -- SOVA -- which can stealthily encrypt an Android phone for ransom and is hard to uninstall is targeting Indian customers, the country's federal cyber security agency said in its latest advisory.

The virus has upgraded to its fifth version after it was first detected in the Indian cyberspace in July, it said.

"It has been reported to CERT-In that Indian banking customers are being targeted by a new type of mobile banking malware campaign using SOVA Android Trojan. The first version of this malware appeared for sale in underground markets in September 2021 with the ability to harvest user names and passwords via key logging, stealing cookies and adding false overlays to a range of apps," the advisory said.

SOVA, it said, was earlier focusing on countries like the US, Russia and Spain, but in July 2022 it added several other countries, including India, to its list of targets.

The latest version of this malware, according to the advisory, hides itself within fake Android applications that show up with the logo of a few famous legitimate apps like Chrome, Amazon, NFT (non-fungible token linked to crypto currency) platform to deceive users

into installing them.

"This malware captures the credentials when users log into their net banking apps and access bank accounts. The new version of SOVA seems to be targeting more than 200 mobile applications, including banking apps and crypto exchanges/wallets," the advisory said.

The Indian Computer Emergency Response Team or CERT-In is the federal technology arm to combat cyber attacks and guards the Internet space against phishing and hacking assaults and similar online attacks.

The agency said the malware is distributed via smishing (phishing via SMS) attacks, like most Android banking Trojans.

"Once the fake android application is installed on the phone, it sends the list of all applications installed on the device to the C2 (command and control server) controlled by the threat actor in order to obtain the list of targeted applications."

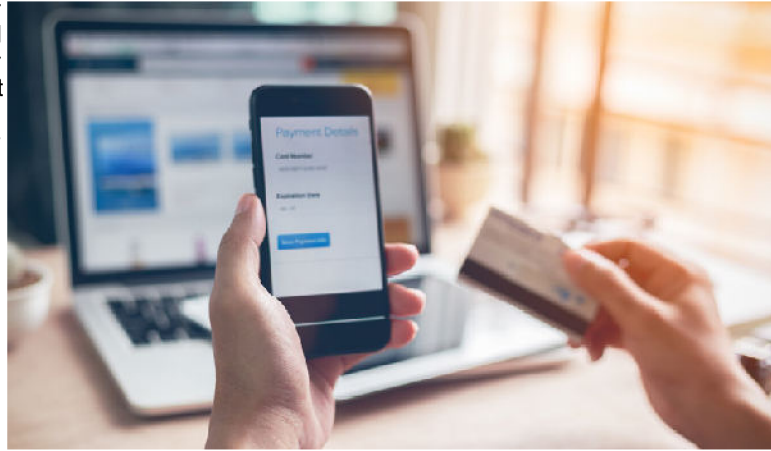
"At this point, the C2 sends back to the malware the list of addresses for each targeted application and stores this information inside an XML file. These targeted applications are then

managed through the communications between the malware and the C2," it said.

The lethality of the virus can be gauged from the fact that it can collect keystrokes, steal cookies, intercept multi-factor authentication (MFA) tokens, take screenshots and record video from a webcam and can

"It has been discovered that the makers of SOVA recently upgraded it to its fifth version since its inception, and this version has the capability to encrypt all data on an Android phone and hold it to ransom," it said.

Another key feature of the virus, according to the advisory, is the



perform gestures like screen click, swipe etc. using android accessibility service.

It can also add false overlays to a range of apps and "mimic" over 200 banking and payment applications in order to con the Android user.

refactoring of its "protections" module, which aims to protect itself from different victim actions.

For example, it said, if the user tries to uninstall the malware from the settings or pressing the icon, SOVA is able to intercept these actions and prevent them by

returning to the home screen and showing a toast (small popup) displaying "This app is secured".

These attack campaigns can effectively jeopardise the privacy and security of sensitive customer data and result in "large-scale" attacks and financial frauds, it said.

The agency also suggested some counter-measures and best practices that can be put into action by the users to keep safe from the virus.

Users should reduce the risk of downloading potentially harmful apps by limiting their download sources to official app stores, such as your device's manufacturer or operating system app store, they should always review the app details, number of downloads, user reviews, comments and "ADDITIONAL INFORMATION" section, it said.

One should also verify app permissions and grant only those which have relevant context for the app's purpose.

They should install regular Android updates and patches and not browse un-trusted websites or follow un-trusted links and exercise caution while clicking on the link provided in any unsolicited emails and SMSs. - Source : The week

that the Environment Ministry's panel has cleared project to construct a Greenfield International Airport, an International Container Transshipment Terminal, a Township and Power plant in Great Nicobar Island. The Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC) consisting of few government officials, mostly subject experts and eminent scientists from various fields of Environment, Pollution control, Ground water, Road research, ocean technology, infrastructure, Power amongst others, after extensive rounds of deliberations and meetings recommended grant of Environmental and Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) Clearance for the project in its meeting held on 22.08.2022 – 23.08.2022. A series of meetings and deliberations including for Terms of Reference (ToR) for Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and EAC were held from March 2021 and finally concluded in August 2022 before the recommendation for grant of Environmental and CRZ clearance by the EAC for GNI project. The ET and BS report further said, "The Indian Ocean Region (IOR) in general and the Indian Ocean in particular has turned into a strategic hotspot in recent years. In response to the increasing strategic value of this IOR, a critical mass of development in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands is necessary for strengthening India's regional presence". The Great Nicobar Island also represents a significant economic development opportunity as the main east-west shipping route that links East Asian exports with the Indian Ocean, Suez Canal and Europe runs just to the south of this island, it said. "By building a container port in this location, India can participate more fully in the global shipping trade" and generate lakhs of new job, the report said. Other countries like Myanmar, China and Sri Lanka were gearing up to develop deep water facilities for taking a major share of trade by developing suitable harbour facilities and it is therefore imperative that India

should do the same, the report contended. Great Nicobar Island is considered perfect as a site as it is equidistant from Colombo, Port Klang and Singapore and is also very close to the East-West International corridor. Out of 910 sq. km of Great Nicobar Island, only 166.10 sq. km of area is proposed for development which is approximately 18% of the total area. Remaining area of 82% will stay covered under Protected Forest, two National Parks, Eco Sensitive Zones and Biosphere Reserve and managed for conservation of biodiversity at ecosystem, species and genetic levels. The total forest area to be diverted out of 166.10 Sq. Km. including deemed forests 130.75 Sq. Km. Remaining project area of 35.35 Sq. Km. lies in the Revenue area. About 50 % of the total forest area to be diverted forming 65.99 Sq. Km. will be reserved as green area and no tree felling is envisaged here. In the remaining forest area to be diverted, felling of trees is proposed in a phased manner over a period of 30 years. Further, Compensatory Afforestation is proposed to be carried out as per the guidelines of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) for diversion of forest land. ET report further said, "EAC has mandated specific conservation and management plan and high funding for the endemic species, Mangroves and Coral and other fauna besides several other caveats". EAC said three independent committees will be set up: one to oversee pollution related matters, another on biodiversity and the third to oversee welfare and issues related to Shopmen and Nicobarese tribes. Accordingly, an EIA has been undertaken for preparation of conservation and management plan to have minimal environmental and social impact due to the project. The exhaustive Environmental Management plan will be put in place and monitored on a regular basis. Accordingly, Wildlife Institute of India (WII), Salim Ali Centre for Ornithology & Natural History (SACON), Zoological Survey of India (ZSI), Botanical

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Survey of India (BSI) have been entrusted by A&N Administration for preparation of conservation/mitigation plans for bio-diversity including leatherback turtles, megapode, crocodile, etc. Conservation and protection of Nicobar macaque, robber crabs, endemic birds, mangroves, giant clams and other endemic flora and fauna have been given due consideration. Additionally, the UT Administration is in the process of notification of three Wildlife Sanctuaries for Leatherback Turtles in Little Nicobar (13.75 sq.km), Megapode in Menchal (1.29 sq.km) and Corals in Meroe Island (2.73 sq.km), for conservation of these species. The EAC in its deliberations and recommendations has ensured that conservation of different Flora and Fauna is taken up in a scientific manner. Experts have been roped in and entrusted for preparation of effective plans and conservation measures. Substantial financial provision has been earmarked upfront towards Environmental Management Plan (EMP). All construction activity to be taken up in the project will be ensured as per the highest environmental standards. Special studies relating to Fauna and Flora in GNI are proposed relating to various species, landscape, Biodiversity etc. The Andaman & Nicobar Administration, in line with its Shompen policy is committed to recognize the social, ecological, economic diversity of the Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups of the Islands, preserve and protect their cultural heritage and ensure their well being. The tribal reserve measuring 743.96 sq. Km after de-notification will remain protected as tribal reserve. The project will not displace any Shompen tribals. The tribal communities will continue to have unfettered right of meeting their day-to-day requirement for their sustenance. The project will not only ensure a significant presence of the country in the Malacca Strait but also enhance socio-economic growth and usher in a new era for all round development of Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Great Nicobar Island in particular. - Source : uniindia

Congress President or not...

Asked whether consensus or elections would be better for the post of AICC president, Chidambaram said while election is the default option, "the better course and all parties follow this is to elect a national president by consensus".

"If my recollection is correct, Mr Nadda, and before him Mr Amit Shah, Mr Rajnath Singh and Mr Gadkari, were all elected by consensus," he said.

On whether Gandhi will heed appeals of party workers and leaders, Chidambaram said he does not know the answer to that question.

"Rahul Gandhi is the acknowledged leader of the rank and file of the party. They want him to be the President of the party also. So far, he has declined. He may change his mind," the senior Congress leader told PTI.

Asked whether the Gandhi family will continue to occupy a place of pre-eminence in the party if a non-Congress president is elected, Chidambaram cited the history of the Congress and pointed out that between 1921 and 1948 Mahatma Gandhi was the acknowledged leader of the Congress, and afterwards, Jawaharlal Nehru and Indira Gandhi, one following the other, was the acknowledged leader of the party.

"Apart from the Leader, there were several persons who held the office of president of the party for one or two or three years. There have been periods in Congress' history when the

Leader and the president was the same person, there have been long periods when the Leader and the president were different persons," he said.

The Rajya Sabha MP said that if Rahul Gandhi is elected Congress president, he will be both leader and president, but if he is not, he will remain the acknowledged leader of the party and there will be another person holding the office of president.

"Rahul Gandhi will always have a pre-eminent place in the party," Chidambaram asserted.

Asked if a non-Gandhi family person will command the same respect and authority, the senior leader said the office of Congress president carries with it a great tradition and history, vast powers and huge responsibilities.

"I am certain whoever is elected Congress president will rise to the occasion and command respect among the leaders and the rank and file of the party," he added.

The notification for the Congress president's election will be out on September 22 and the process for filing nominations will be held from September 24 to 30.

The last date for the withdrawal of nominations is October 8 and the election, if required, will be held on October 17. The results will be out on October 19. Talking about the party's Bharat Jodo Yatra that began on September 7 from Kanyakumari, Chidambaram said that from what he saw in Tamil Nadu on the first two days, and from what he has gathered from

his colleagues in Kerala, a large number of dormant Congressmen and women and sympathisers came out of their homes and joined the padayatra for short or long distances. Many hundreds more stood on the roadside and welcomed and cheered Rahul Gandhi and the yatri, he said.

"It means that the elephant has been awakened. Thousands of people are hearing an ancient yet new, message: that this country cannot be allowed to be divided by hate or anger or communal conflict, that love and tolerance and fraternity will unite the people of the country, and that such unity alone can lay the basis for economic and social progress," Chidambaram said.

This message is very different from the divisive and hate-filled messages that we have heard over the last seven years, he said.

Chidambaram cited the lines from a poem written a hundred years ago by Tamil poet Subramania Bharati which translate to, "So that this country may arise as one, come forward to do a great deed! Come! Come!"

"As this message resonates throughout the country, it will certainly rejuvenate and revive the Congress," he asserted.

On the BJP's criticism of the yatra, Chidambaram said the ruling party was not prepared for the kind of response that the yatra has evoked and alleged that its leaders were resorting to misinformation, lies, mocking and abuse.

CBDT makes some offenses under Income Tax Act compoundable

CBDT has issued Revised Guidelines for compounding of offences under the Income-tax Act, 1961. CBDT has taken this step in conformity with the Government's policy of facilitating Ease of Doing Business and decriminalisation of offences.

Some of the major changes made for the benefit of taxpayers include making offence punishable under Section 276 of the Act as compoundable.

The scope of eligibility for compounding of cases has been relaxed where case of an applicant who has been convicted with imprisonment for less than 2 years being previously non-compoundable, has now been made compoundable. The discretion available with the competent authority has also been suitably restricted.

The time limit for acceptance of compounding applications has been relaxed from the earlier limit of 24 months to 36 months now, from the date of filing of complaint. Procedural complexities have also been simplified.

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

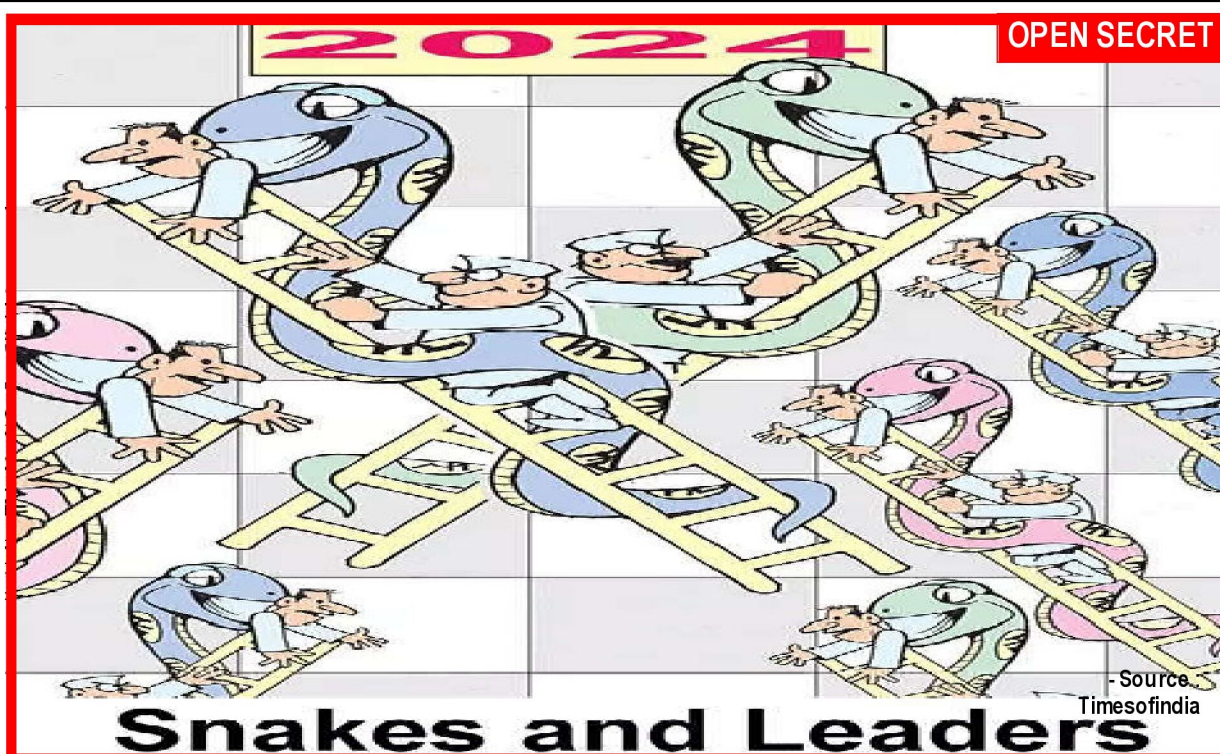

'Crime scripts' to unravel illegal trade of marine species

An analysis of the illegal trade of marine species in India between 2015 and 2021 pointed out that sea cucumbers were the most frequently seized marine species group. Tamil Nadu

species group. Tamil Nadu recorded the highest enforcement action with 126 seizure incidents of the marine species. The study conducted by the Counter Wildlife Trafficking team of the WCS-India (Wildlife Conservation Society-India) recorded 187 media reports citing marine wildlife seizures by various enforcement agencies in India from 2015 to 2021.

"A total of 187 incidents of illegal trade of marine species were collated between January 2015 and December 2021. Data collected for seven groups of marine wildlife species were analysed within the report, which includes sea cucumber, coral, Syngnathidae (seahorse and pipefish), Elasmobranch (shark and ray), seashell, sea fan and sea turtle," stated the recently released report titled *Illegal Trade of Marine Species in India: 2015-2021*.

The report pointed out that collectively, 64,172 kg plus 988 individuals (un-weighed) sea cucumbers were seized by the enforcement agencies in Tamil

Nadu, Lakshadweep Islands and the Andaman Islands. Of the 187 incidents of the illegal trade of marine species, 122 incidents involved the seizure of sea cucumber.

The document not only provided insights into the nature, the volume and the extent of the illegal marine trade across the country but also analysed the incidents involving the illegal sea cucumber trade. They were further researched using 'crime scripts', to understand how the smuggling networks operated. The crime script had been prepared on the basis of the 122 incidents of seizure bringing out what went into the preparation.

pre activity, activity and post activity phase of the smuggling of the marine group of species. The report pointed out that due to the legalised trade of sea cucumbers in countries with close proximity to India, the sea cucumber consignments were often smuggled through those countries, to be laundered and then re-exported to the Southeast Asia markets.

Patankar said that the illegal marine trade, although common, often went unreported due to the nature of the trade and as a result, the civil society, the policymakers and the local communities were left in the dark about the instances

and the scale of the problem, making it hard to investigate the report and analyse.

While the sea cucumbers recorded the maximum incidents of seizure (122 incidents), it was followed by sea fan (20 incidents), seahorse and pipefish (18 incidents), seashell (18 incidents), shark and rays (15 incidents), sea coral (12 incidents) and sea turtle (5 incidents).


Similarly in terms of state-wise seizures, Tamil Nadu (with 126 seizures) was followed by Maharashtra (13 incidents), Lakshadweep (12 incidents) and Karnataka (eight incidents). Marine wildlife incidents were reported across 18 states, including the eight coastal states and the two island territories, the report stated. The document also cautioned that a high number of seizure incidents alone "does not always indicate a high frequency of wildlife crime, and it may be a result of effective enforcement or more media interest".

"Harvested as incidental catch"

Aaron Savio Lobo, senior adviser of the marine programme at WCS-India, said that when it came to illegally traded marine wildlife, the largest volumes were harvested as an incidental catch in unselective fisheries such as trawling and gillnetting. "This includes the likes of seahorses, sharks, manta and devil rays. This is unlike the most terrestrial traded wildlife species which are directly harvested. Countering marine wildlife trade thereby requires paradigm changes in fisheries management as a whole to reduce their capture in the first place," he added.

The report also threw light on the international illegal marine trade routes. "Out of the 122 sea cucumber incidents recorded between 2015 and 2021, 34 incidents either mentioned attempts to illicitly export sea cucumbers to neighbouring countries or countries with established markets for trade. Sri Lanka (26 incidents), China (six incidents) and Malaysia (two incidents) were recorded as countries that are either transit locations or destinations of the intended trade," the report said. The publication also shed light on the international trade routes for seahorse and pipefish and sharks and rays. - Source: thehindu


