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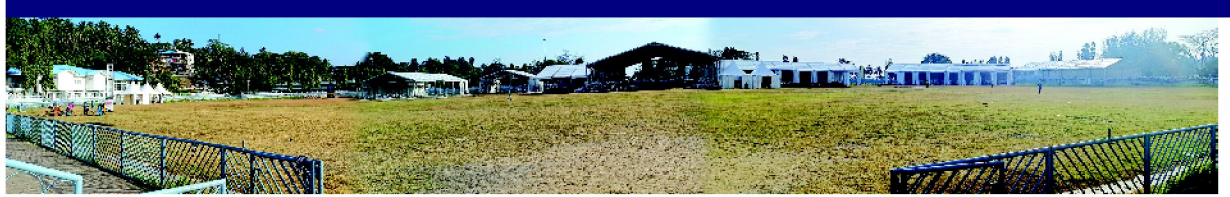

Port Blair, Jan 18: In order to host the culmination function of 'Azadi Ki Amrit Mahotsav' iconic events week from 17th to 23rd January 2023 and to celebrate 75 years of India's Independence and remembering Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose's life and his contribution to the freedom struggle, the Ministry of Home Affairs in association with the UT administration will be organizing a mega event on 23rd January 2023, at Netaji Stadium. Just for a one hour show, several crores of taxpayers' money are paid to an event

management firm. As part of the gala-event, an Event Management firm has been hired for organizing the events at an estimated cost of Rs 23 crores. The event management firm has been preparing for the mega show on 23rd January 2023. As part of this, tents and pandals are being erected at Netaji Stadium by digging the playground rendering it useless for the sports persons to play games for the next few months. But what is more surprising is despite a hefty payment of Rs 23 crores, government machineries, labour forces and department officials

are being used to help the Event Management firm which is charging Rs 23 crores for conducting the show. Now citizens are questioning that despite the private firm charging such a hefty amount for organizing the show, why is the administration providing its resources to the private firm. It is mandatory on the part of the Event Management firm to conduct the event by using its own resources. Is there any understanding between the UT administration and the Event Management firm to use the government resources and also charge such a hefty amount for organizing the show. Only the organizers of the show can tell. As per sources, the Event Management firm has not been able to manage the requirements such as seating arrangements which has been sub-leased to many local event groups who have been paid money. These local groups are knocking the doors of schools, colleges and government offices looking for charity free of cost. The Event Management firm is unable to manage the arrangements of other critical aspects for which

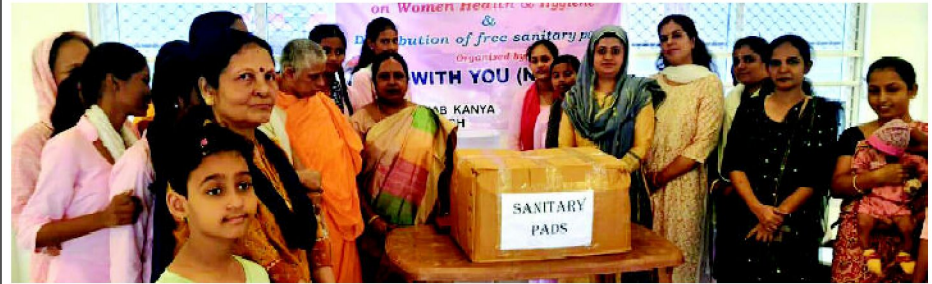

### Share, don't gag

The National Disaster Management Authority has instructed government institutions and officials to avoid interacting with media or share information on social media about land subsidence in Joshimath. The gag order will be in force till the final report of NDMA's expert group is submitted. The immediate trigger for the gag order appears to be a satellite report of Isro that indicates subsidence of about 9 cm in seven months. NDMA should rethink its decision – a gag order won't stop the flow of bad news, if that's NDMA's motive, but it may affect intelligent opinion-building that needs a free flow of authentic information.

The situation in the region is evolving, with cracks in both the ground and buildings being reported daily. Public speculation on probable causes and on fresh incidents of land subsidence is inevitable. The information vacuum left by the government will be filled by sources that may often be dubious. Granted, NDMA's expert committee's conclusion will come after a thorough examination of the situation. However, with Joshimath residents' anxieties running high, periodic communication by scientific bodies is necessary. Also, satellite pictures of the region are not limited to Isro's, and plenty of foreign scientists are working on the Joshimath subsidence.

Global experience of Covid hammered home the lesson that scientific collaboration is the best way to diagnose a problem and find a solution. Stringent restrictions on the information flow is self-defeating. Governments at all levels in India need to encourage their institutions to collaborate with scientists in the private sector and in foreign institutions. A bigger pool of experts analysing a subject is more likely to come up with useful insights.

NDMA's gag order is the second such sarkari instance in the recent past. A few weeks back ICAR issued a similar one for GM mustard. Debates and disagreements are intrinsic to science. They expand the boundaries of knowledge. Official attempts to curb information and debate trigger suspicion. In addition, a culture of doing-little also delays recognition of problems. Joshimath's land subsidence, which even official studies noted decades ago, is an example.

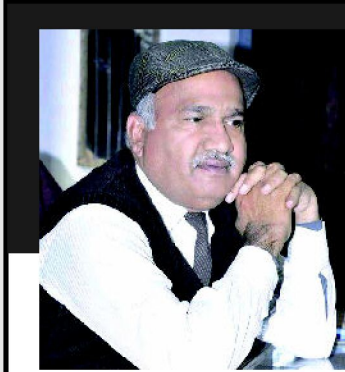

# Make future through NDA

The Maharaja Ranjit Singh Armed Forces Preparatory Institute was established in the year 2010 by the Government of Punjab to prepare the boys of the state for permanent commission in the Defense Forces through the National Defense Academy (NDA) examination conducted by the Union Public Service Commission, New Delhi. The main objective of this institute is to develop officer-like qualities in the students so that they can train for the NDA exam and become eligible to serve in the defense forces. Qualification Candidate should be a resident of Punjab should Age should not be more than 17 years. Candidate must be studying in 10th standard. (Boys studying in 11th class can also apply but such candidates

are given admission only in 11th class). Candidate should be willing to join Defense Forces through NDA. Only boys are eligible for AFPI entrance exam. (By the way girls can also give NDA exam) AFPI Entrance Exam AFPI entrance exam consists of two parts i.e. written test and interview.

Written test: It consists of three subjects i.e. Math, English and Social Studies. The standard of questions is based on CBSE Secondary Class (10th Class) Syllabus. Only objective/multiple

choice questions are asked. There are a total of 200 questions out of which 80 are from Math, 80 from English and 40 from Social Studies. The duration of the paper is three hours. Answers to the questions are to be marked on the given OMR sheet. There is negative marking for wrong answers. Four marks are awarded for each correct answer and each-1 mark is given for wrong answer. The written test for the 13th course is being held on 22 January 2023.

Academic Training: The training imparted to cadets is of two years duration at +1 +2 level. 11th and 12th in non-medical stream (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, and English) with Computer Science/Physical Education from one of the best schools in Mohali.

Physical Fitness:

Cadets are given required physical training in NDA. All important sports like hockey, football, basketball, volleyball, cross country, boxing, lawn tennis, squash, golf and swimming apart from shooting and drill are also trained.

Personality Development: It includes communication skills and soft skills, art of study, information about armed forces, war movies, debates, group discussions, presentations, visits to military units. All the administrative and training expenses are borne by the Punjab Government. Candidates have to pay only the school fee from where they are pursuing academic studies +2.

# RISE IN GOLD PRICES LEADS TO HEALTHY GROWTH IN GOLD LOANS

The steady rise in gold prices is leading to healthy growth in gold loan demand. The biggest beneficiary of this trend is expected to be banks and gold loan fin-tech companies which are offering gold loans at relatively lower interest rates.

A recent report by Motilal Oswal noted that this trend will continue and gold prices will sustain the same momentum in the CY (Calendar Year) 2023 due to the expected deterioration in broader macroeconomic indicators both in India as well across the world.

However, despite the rise in gold prices, there will be no significant changes in gold loan rates.

Gold prices in India increased over the last two months. After a steep increase, prices fell for the second day in a row after hitting a record high earlier this week. On MCX, bullion futures fell 0.3 per cent to Rs 561.63 per 10 grams from its all-time high of Rs 56,562 per ten grams.

As per the Motilal report, companies such as Muthoot Finance and Mannapuram Finance have not made any notable changes to their gold loan schemes in January. This would mean the NBFCs too

are unlikely to re-introduce any teaser-rate loans to accelerate loan growth.

However, there is fierce competition in the market with gold fin-tech companies such as Rupeek and Indigold offering lower pricing in the market. The report

sustain over the next two quarters, an increase in borrowing costs is expected to become more pronounced in FY 2024.

The report said Rupeek and Indigold are still the biggest competition to gold loan NBFCs and banks in metro and Tier 1 cities

because of the finer pricing offered by these companies. The report stated that Rupeek has started focusing on profitability by charging processing fees plus GST on select schemes offered. Bank partners (such as Federal Bank and Indian Bank) who co-lend with Rupeek do not charge any processing fees and hence the entire processing fee goes to Rupeek.

Meanwhile, gold loan NBFCs such as Muthoot

and Mannapuram and Indigold are still not charging any processing fees and pre-closure charges and part-release fees from the customers. The Motilal report said interest rates charged by banks in co-lending with gold loan fin-tech companies are sustainable, suggesting that the competitive landscape will not turn benign in near future.

observed that lenders are unlikely to offer any teaser-rate schemes to accelerate loan growth as they are now prioritising profitability over growth.

Both Muthoot and Mannapuram have not reported any significant increase in borrowing costs until September 2022 aided by the maturity of higher-cost borrowings. Interestingly, according to the report, while some of that advantage could

Despite the negligible contribution of Global South countries in this imbalance, significant efforts are being made by them to deal with these challenges and resolve them, panelists at a 'Round Table on Global South and Global Governance for LiFE' of G-20's special Think 20 event said on Tuesday.

The two-day event concluded with a visit of the participants to world heritage Buddhist stupas of Sanchi.

Moderator and vice chancellor of Rishihood University, Sonapat, Shobhit Mathur said the Global South is the voice of India and the priorities of the Global South are the priorities of India. There should be such simple, straightforward criteria for an environment-friendly lifestyle, moral values, and propitious global good governance that can bring positive changes in our society, he added.

Executive Director, Center for Policy Dialogue, Bangladesh,

Fahmida Khatun said varying aspirations of all nations often pose a challenge for consensus. There is a need to pay attention to it to deal with the environmental challenges. Senior Investigator, National Council for Scientific and Technical Research, Argentina, Gladys Lechini said the need of the hour is to build the voice of the local and southern nations that prioritise local knowledge to address local challenges.

Director, Foreign Policy and International Development Cooperation, Indonesia, Pamela Gopaul said it is important to use existing knowledge systems to provide advisory services to the government. Africa is playing its part as an assertive and responsible voice on global issues, she said.

Speaking on the change in lifestyle after the Covid-19 pandemic, Director, Foreign Policy and International Development Cooperation, Indonesia, Wisnu Ubomo said it has affected the global economic growth. Climate change and environmental imbalance have also increased in the last 20 years. Our policies

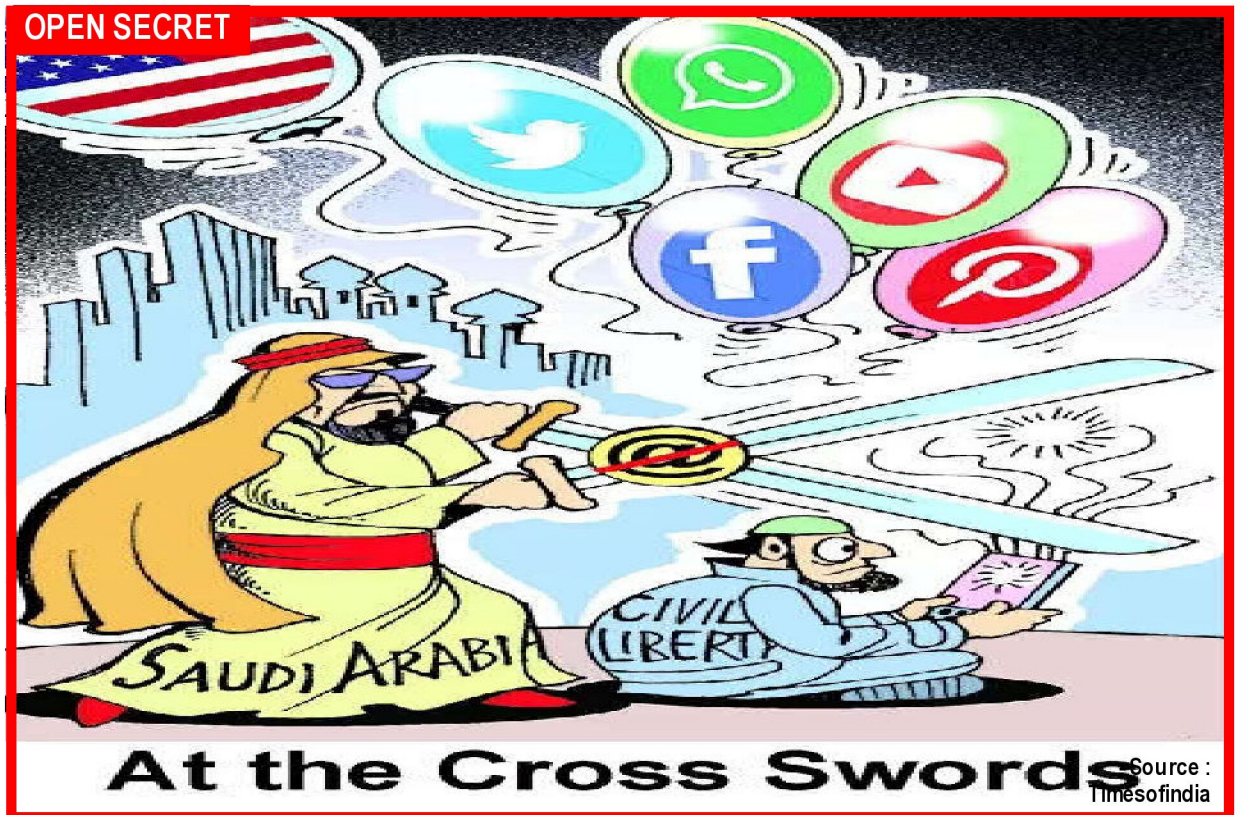
should be formulated incorporating resolutions and preparedness, Ubomo added. Impact on the global value chain during the Covid pandemic has given a severe blow to the global trade and economy. Rahman said that today when we are talking about global development, it is imperative that our model of development is inclusive. To ensure the participation of underdeveloped and developing countries with competitiveness, there should be access to technology and special trade provisions, which help these countries to access the global market. Dr. Posh Raj Pandey, Chairman, SAWTEE, Nepal; Mikatekiso Kubayi Researcher, Institute for Global Dialogue, South Africa; Oluseun Andrew Ishola of Centre for Management

Development (CMD), Nigeria; and Naval K. Paswan, Dean, School of Social Sciences, Sikkim University also spoke. Sait Akman of The Economic Policy Research Foundation, Turkey virtually participated in the session.

Localisation has a key role in meeting the G-20 Sustainable Development Goals and requires a triangular collaboration of government, civil society and private organisations. Through this, the global scenario could be changed. India is doing important work in triangular cooperation and played a pivotal role in resolving Covid pandemic and the Ukraine crisis. India's model in meeting the Sustainable Development Goals is historic. In the year 2018 in Uganda Prime Minister Narendra Modi had emphasised on boosting the local capacity as much as possible and India is moving at a fast pace towards meeting the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. This was highlighted by speakers at the session on 'Triangular Cooperation in Localising the Sustainable Development Goals' at the G-20's special Think-20 event

## BBC apologises for porn prank during FA Cup coverage



The BBC has apologised after pornographic noises were played on air during the broadcaster's live coverage of an FA Cup match, apparently via a mobile phone that a prankster had hidden in the studio.

The noises interrupted the coverage presented by former England striker Gary Lineker before the match between Wolverhampton and Liverpool at Molineux Stadium on Tuesday. Lineker later posted on Twitter a picture of a cell phone that he said was taped to the back of the seat inside the stadium.

"As sabotage goes it was quite amusing," Lineker said. The BBC appeared to be

less amused, and issued a statement saying: "We apologise to any viewers offended during the live coverage of the football this evening."

A self-ascribed YouTube prankster, who calls himself Jarvo, tweeted that he was behind the stunt and posted a video showing him calling the phone to activate the sounds.

Jarvo, whose real name is Daniel Jarvis, was banned in October from all sporting events in England and Wales for two years after running onto the pitch during a Test match between England and India in September 2021 and barging into England batter Jonny Bairstow.

## IndiGo emergency gate opening row: Jyotiraditya Scindia comes to defence of Tejasvi Surya

Coming to the defence of BJP's Bengaluru South MP Tejasvi Surya, who reportedly opened the emergency exit of the IndiGo plane after boarding at Chennai airport last month, Union Civil Aviation Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia, on Wednesday, said Surya did it by mistake.

The minister pointed out that the Surya apologised for the incident.

The opposition had targeted the BJP MP over the incident with Karnataka Congress saying "Tejasvi Surya is an example of what will happen if children playing games are given the proprietorship. An act of children's mischief by trying to open the emergency exit door of the plane has come to light. Why prank with the lives of passengers?"

Congress MLA and KPCC's communications in-charge Priyank Kharge sought to know if the MP used his office to suppress the news. "Why is IndiGo so

hesitant to name the passenger? Why didn't they report to DGCA? Why is No Comments from the MP? BJP's Tejasvi Surya allegedly opened emergency exit of IndiGo flight, flight delayed by 2 hours," he had said in a tweet.

Scindia said he does not want to respond to the claims of the opposition and added that it is important to look at facts. "The door was opened by him by mistake when the flight was on the ground and after all checks, the flight was allowed to take off," the minister was quoted as saying.

In a statement on Tuesday without naming the BJP MP, IndiGo said a passenger travelling on flight 6E 7339 from Chennai to Tiruchirappalli on December 10, 2022, accidentally opened the emergency exit during the boarding process. The statement came after a media report said the MP had opened the emergency exit, leading to a delay in the flight.

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
