

## If we have to achieve inclusive ideals of our constitution, then role of women in judiciary also has to be increased: President

New Delhi, Sept. 11 (PIB) If we have to achieve the inclusive ideals of our constitution, then the role of women in the judiciary also has to be increased, said the President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind. He was speaking at the foundation stone laying ceremony of Uttar Pradesh National Law University and new building complex of Allahabad High Court at Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh today.

Referring to the Allahabad High Court's historic decision to enroll India's first woman lawyer, Ms. Cornelia Sorabji in 1921, the

President termed that decision a forward-looking decision in the direction of women empowerment. He said that last month, a new history was created of the women's participation in the judiciary with the appointment of nine judges, including three women judges, in the Supreme Court. He noted that the presence of four women judges out of the total 33 judges appointed in the Supreme Court is the highest ever in the history of the judiciary. He said that these appointments have paved the way for a woman Chief Justice of India in future.

He emphasized that establishment of a truly just society would be possible only when the participation of women increases in all areas including the judiciary. He noted that at present the total strength of women judges in the Supreme Court and High Courts together is less than 12 per cent. He said that if we have to achieve the inclusive ideals of our Constitution, then the role of women in the judiciary also has to be increased.

The President said that he had seen closely, struggle of the poor for getting justice. Everyone

has expectations from the judiciary, yet, generally people hesitate in taking the help of the courts. This situation needs to be changed in order to further increase the confidence of the people in the judiciary. He said that it is the responsibility of all of us that - everyone gets justice in time, justice system should be less expensive, decisions should be in the language understood by the common man, and especially women and weaker sections should get justice in the judicial process. This would be possible only when all stakeholders associated with the judicial system bring

## 'Voter Helpline App' developed by ECI

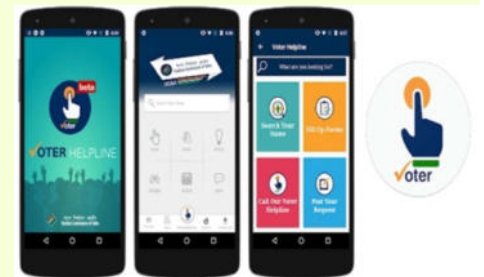
### App aims to provide a single point of service and information delivery to voters

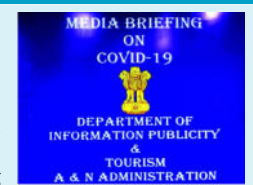

Giving details about the test being conducted to track COVID-19, the

**Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub**

**Tamaloo Tall - A promising coconut cultivar**

It is a tall coconut cultivar of Car Nicobar Island. Generally, the palms are morphologically similar to Andaman Ordinary Tall but with differences in nut characteristics. An accession collected and evaluated at World Coconut Germplasm Centre, ICAR-CIARI, Port Blair has shown that the palms of this cultivar are robust, high yielding with higher copra content. The palms of this variety take about 5-7 years for first flowering. The kernel is thick and recorded higher milk recovery under VCO production process. The fruits are green yellow, husk thickness is thin (2 .47cm), dehusked fruits are oblong, good tender nut water quantity (459 ml per fruit), average fruit weight over 1809g with average copra content of about 246g. Under the natural habitat of rainfed conditions in Car Nicobar, the palms exhibited large bole, stout stem, good fruit setting with estimated fruit yield of over 140 nuts per palm per year, regular production of bunches and dense crown. There are no major pests recorded in this population. Careful mother palm selection followed by seedling selection is important to establish good plantation of Tamaloo Tall considering the variability observed in the natural and conserved population. Benefit: The cultivar has good tender nut water quantity (about 450ml per fruit) hence used for tender coconut purpose, copra making, processed coconut kernel products and VCO production. The kernel oil content is about 66%.

**Vaccination- shield against the virus**

**3, 83, 785 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries in Isles**

Port Blair, Sept. 11

The safety of the citizens is the foremost priority of the Administration, especially during this pandemic time. To shield its citizens from the corona virus, the vaccination of eligible beneficiaries is being initiated by the Administration in different parts of the Islands. Accordingly, the vaccination began with administering of COVISHIELD vaccine for Health Care Workers followed by frontline

workers and vulnerable population with community. Subsequently, the vaccination for 45 and above was initiated followed by 18 to 44 years which is currently underway.

Meanwhile, the vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 3, 83, 785 doses of vaccines were administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2, 81, 603 (approx.). A total of 2154 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands

1388 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which 670 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 392 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 260 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 374 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which 39 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. A total of 1, 56, 028 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

BLOs/BLO Supervisors shall not proceed on leave without obtaining permission and making over his election related charge.
