Decline in COVID-19 cases in A&N Islands

Compulsory RT-PCR test for fully vaccinated asymptomatic passengers exempted

RT-PCR testing of passengers travelling to Nicobar to continue

Port Blair, April 20 In view of decline in the COVID-19 cases across the country and in these Islands too, it has been decided to wave off compulsory RT-PCR test for all the asymptomatic passengers who are fully vaccinated (i.e. taken 2 doses) with COVID-19 vaccine travelling to all the places in South Andaman District and in N&M Andaman District. However, those who are unvaccinated/ partially vaccinated / symptomatic passengers above 5 years of age will have to undergo Rapid Antigen Test before undertaking such journey. RT-PCR testing of all passengers travelling to Nicobar District will continue till further order irrespective of their COVID - 19 vaccination status. No test is required for asymptomatic children below five years of age who are undertaking journey within A&N Islands, a press release from DHS said.

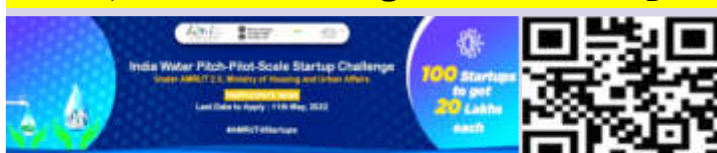

Implementation of National Family Benefit Scheme by Social Welfare Deptt.

Eligible beneficiaries can obtain form from Directorate of Social Welfare or Offices of CDPOs and other out stations

Port Blair, April 20

The Directorate of Social Welfare is implementing the National Family Benefit Scheme (NFBS) under the National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP). Under this scheme, an amount of Rs.20000/- will be given as a lump sum assistance to the bereaved household in the event of death of the breadwinner.

It is clarified that in the event of death (natural or otherwise) would make the family eligible for assistance. A woman in the family, who is a homemaker, is also considered a 'bread-winner' for this purpose.

The family benefit will be paid to such surviving member of the household of the deceased poor, who after local enquiry, is found to be the head of the household. For the purpose of the scheme, the term 'household' would include spouses, minor children, unmarried daughters, and dependent parents. In case of death of an unmarried adult, the term household would include minor brothers/sisters and dependent parents.

The death of such breadwinner should have occurred while he/ she is

more than 18 years of age and less than 59 years of age. The assistance would be given to every case of death of a breadwinner in a family.

The eligibility criteria for availing the Scheme is that the family should belong to the BPL category. The eligible beneficiaries may obtain the form from the Directorate of Social Welfare or Offices of the CDPOs at Urban Project, Ferrargunj, Rangat, Diglipur, Car Nicobar and other out stations, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.

UGC eases norms for dual and joint degrees with foreign varsities

New Delhi, April 20

University Grants Commission has taken decision on a regulation for academic collaboration between Indian and foreign higher educational institutions to offer training, joint and dual degree programmes. This was announced by UGC Chairman, Prof. M. Jagadeesh Kumar in a virtual meeting with the media yesterday.

The UGC Chairmen said, this regulation deals with three different kinds of programmes such as training, joint and dual degree. He said, these kinds of training arrangements between Indian and Foreign higher educational institutions will provide a great opportunity to Indian students. Prof. Kumar said, Indian and Foreign higher educational institutions

need to sign an MoU to establish collaboration for joint and dual degree programmes.

In the case of joint degree programmes, degree will be provided by the Indian higher educational institute, however, degree can be provided by both Indian and Foreign educational institutions in the case of dual degree programme. (Source: india.gov.in)

entitled for 5 kg foodgrains in the scale of 3.5 kg rice and 1.5 kg wheat per person per month free of cost. Since, the tribal population is habitual rice eater and as per their request, PHH & AAY beneficiary of Car Nicobar and Nancowire group of Islands will be entitled for 5 kg Rice only per person per month free of cost under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY). This is in addition to their regular entitlement under NFSA.

All such ration card holders have been informed to draw the foodgrains as per their entitlement for 2 months in one go between 1st April, 2022 to 31st May, 2022 in addition to their regular PDS foodgrains. However, the Ration Card holders who are not able to lift ration in the month of April, 2022 can also lift their foodgrains in the month of May, 2022.

Further, the migrants of other States presently residing in this UT and are covered under NFSA (PHH & AAY) in their respective States/UTs can also receive foodgrains from any FPS of this UT under the One Nation One Ration Card Scheme. For any clarification, they can contact Toll Free No. 14445/18003453197. The Department has appealed to all beneficiaries to abide by COVID appropriate behaviour without fail, a press release from Directorate of CS & CA said.
