India observes the National Ayurveda Day every year on the occasion of Dhanwantari Jayanti or Dhanteras. The theme for Ayurveda Day-2023 was 'Ayurveda for One Health' with the tag line 'Ayurveda for everyone on every day' i.e. 'Har din har kisi ke liye Ayurveda' focusing on human-animal-plant-environment interface'. The initiative was started in 2016 with an aim to further promote Ayurveda into mainstream. Ayurveda is considered as one of the identities of rich Indian culture and tradition. The term



'Ayurveda' means 'the knowledge of life' comprises of two Sanskrit words viz. 'Ayu' meaning 'Life' and 'Veda' meaning 'Knowledge' or 'Science'. Ayurveda with endless potential is a traditional medicinal system that is based on natural elements and works on removing the

disease from its root. Therefore, Government marks the Ayurveda's significance on Dhanteras in order to spread awareness to new generation and promote Ayurvedic principles of healing in society. Government of India has been relentlessly promoting and

supporting the unique medicine system, considering the significance of Ayurveda. So that, the researchers, practitioners and experts can unfold many avenues that are still to be explored in this field. India has a rich

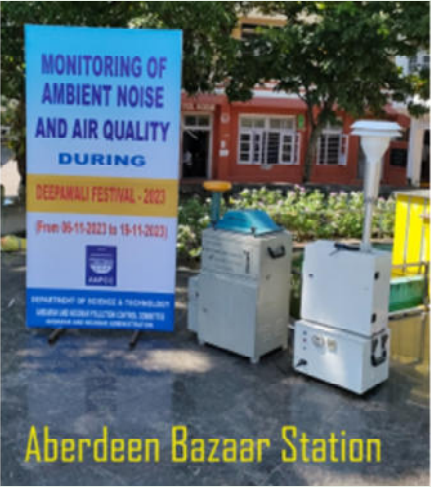

days prior to Diwali (starting from 5th November, 2023) and concluding 7 days after Diwali (ending on 19th November, 2023). The parameters to be closely monitored include Sulfur Dioxide (SO₂), Nitrogen Dioxide (NO₂), Particulate Matter 10 (PM10), Particulate Matter 2.5 (PM2.5), metals such as Lead (Pb), Nickel (Ni), and Arsenic (As) in PM10, as well as selected metals/elements like Aluminum (Al), Barium (Ba), and Iron (Fe) in PM2.5. Additionally, noise levels will be continuously monitored on both pre-Deepawali and Deepawali days.

This year, Deepawali falls on 12th November, 2023 and ANPCC's monitoring program will extend from 5th November, 2023 to 19th November, 2023, ensuring data collection during the crucial 7 days before and after the Diwali festival.

The Ambient Air Quality is calculated by Air Quality Index (AQI). The AQI has six categories from Good to Severe to define Air Quality and to make people understand the severity of the Air Pollution.

AQI	Possible Health Impacts
Good (0-50)	Minimal impact
Satisfactory (51-100)	Minor breathing discomfort to sensitive people
Moderate (101-200)	Breathing discomfort to the people with lung, asthma and heart disease.
Poor (201-300)	Breathing discomfort to most people on prolonged exposure.
Very Poor (301-400)	Respiratory illness on prolonged exposure
Severe (> 400)	Affects healthy people and seriously impacts those with existing diseases.

The Air Quality Index (AQI) will be calculated based on the data recorded during the monitoring. In the previous year (2022), the AQI was assessed as "Good" at Aberdeen Bazaar and Dollygunj Station. The ANPCC's efforts are aimed at maintaining and improving air and noise quality during the festival to ensure a safe and healthy environment for the residents of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, a press release from ANPCC said.

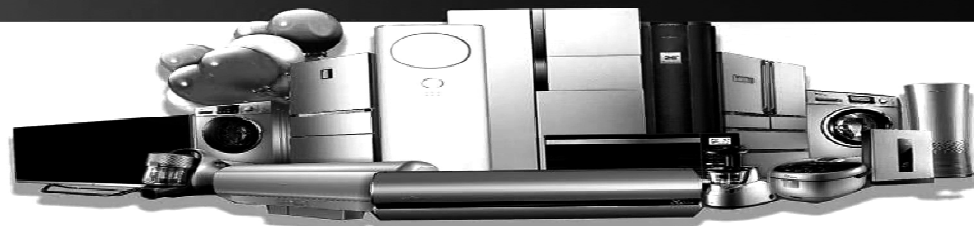

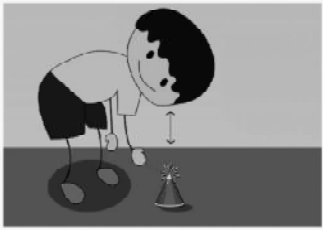

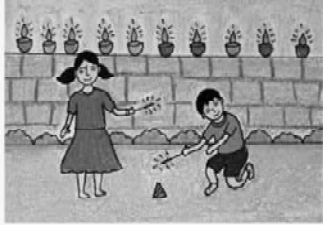

ADVISORY

WHEREAS, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide W.P. (Civil) No. 728 of 2015 dated 23/10/2018 has taken strict cognizance on the issue of burning of firecrackers during Diwali and other festival/occasion etc.

AND WHEREAS, the bursting of fire crackers/fireworks has been identified as one of the sources of air pollution and noise pollution and conditions exist in the air during festive seasons in which pollution level is very high and the bursting of fireworks also effect the ambient air and the lungs, eyes and ears of the people and is one of the causes of pollution in the environment and is harmful for senior citizens, small children and ailing persons.

AND WHEREAS, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has directed that green crackers permitted by PESO (Petroleum & Explosives Safety Organization) are to be sold under valid permission and any manufacturer, sale, purchase/possession or use of crackers (carrying barium or other banned chemicals or mislabeled) is completely prohibited.

NOW THEREFORE, the following advisory is issued for information and strict abidance: -

1. No fire crackers shall be burst in silence zones, that is, an area at least 100 m away from hospitals, nursing homes, primary and district health care centres, educational institutions, courts, religious places or any other are that may be declared as a silence zone by the authorities concerned.
2. All concerned shall strictly adhere to timing in display/bursting of fireworks which shall be between **8.00 pm to 10.00 pm**.
3. All concerned will ensure strict compliance with the Notification GSR No. 64 (E) dated January 27, 1992, regarding the manufacture, possession, use, sale, and importation of any explosive containing sulfur or sulfurate in admixture with any chlorate.
4. Fireworks containing aluminium, sulphur and potassium shall be sold provided the composition already approved by PESO is maintained. It is the responsibility of PESO to ensure compliance with the standards it has formulated.
5. It is made explicit that the sale of fireworks must conform to the directions given above and must be fully in compliance with the Explosive Rules 2008.
6. Keeping in view the adverse effects of air pollution, the human right to breathe clean air and the human right to health, all concerned may consider encouraging display of fireworks through community participation rather than individual bursting of fireworks.
7. The crackers with reduced emissions (improved crackers) and green crackers only would be permitted to be sold.
8. The sale and use of joined firecrackers (series crackers or laris) is banned as the same causes huge air, noise and solid waste problems.
9. The sale shall only be through licenced traders and it shall be ensured that the licenced traders are selling those firecrackers which are permitted by this order.
10. No e-commerce websites, including flipkart, amazon etc shall accept any online orders and effect online sales. Any such e-commerce companies found selling crackers online will be hauled up for contempt of Court and in that eventuality order of monetary penalties as well.
11. Barium salts in the fireworks is also hereby banned.
12. Fireworks with permitted chemicals only to be purchased/possessed/sold/used during diwali and all other religious festivals, of any religion whatsoever, and the occasions like marriages, etc. and should not contain banned chemicals like lithium/arsenal/antimony/lead/mercury.
13. Only those crackers whose decibel (sound) level are within the limits are allowed in the market.
14. UT Pollution Control Committee shall carry out short term monitoring for 14 days (commencing 7 days prior to Diwali and ending 7 days after Diwali) for the parameter namely, aluminium, barium, iron apart from regulatory parameters against the short-term Ambient Air Quality Criteria Values (AAQCVS) proposed by CPCB with regards to bursting of firecrackers.

This advisory shall be promulgated and due publicity through electronic media/ print media/cable services to make the people aware and know the directions with respect to manufacture, use and sale of banned firecrackers may also be ensured in the North & Middle Andaman District for information of the public by announcement through publicity vans and affixing of copies thereof at notice boards of the Office of the District Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates as well as prominent public places and publications in the newspaper having circulation in the district. Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/ Executive Magistrate and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to be vigilant in the matter.

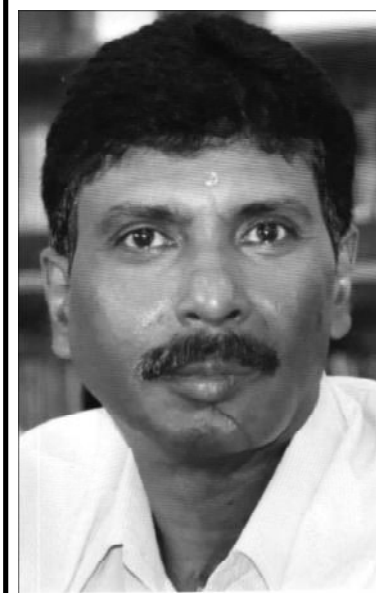
