## Assembly Elections results in five States

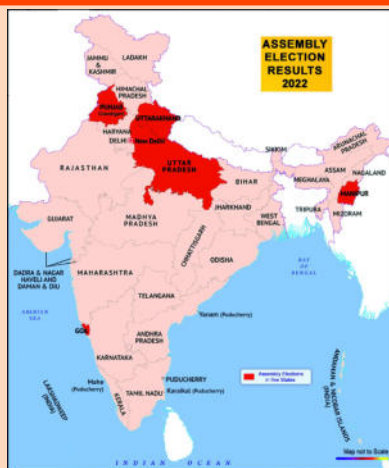
### BJP storms back to power in Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand & Manipur; Set to retain power in Goa; AAP wins Punjab

New Delhi, Mar. 10

In the Assembly Election held for five States, BJP has stormed back to power in Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Manipur and is set to retain power in Goa. Aam Aadmi Party has wrested power from incumbent Congress Party in Punjab.

In Uttar Pradesh, counting for the 403 State Assembly seats is still underway. BJP and its alliance have won and is leading in 274 seats while Samajwadi Party and alliance have won and leading in 125 seats at the time of going to Press.

In Uttarakhand, counting for the State Assembly elections is still underway and out of the 70 assembly seats, BJP has won 47. Congress bagged 18 and is leading in one. Others have won three seats and leading in one seat. In Manipur, results have



been declared for all 60 seats. BJP has won 32 seats. NPEP has won seven and NPF and Congress have won five each and Independents and others in 11.

In Goa, results have been declared for all the 40 seats, out of which, 20 have gone in favour of BJP, eleven for Congress, Independents three and others two.

## Towards providing seamless & hassle free ferry services between Port Blair-Bambooflat

### Department conducts surprise checking of tickets onboard vessels & entry & exit points to keep tab on unethical practices by few commuters

### Additional teams deployed at Jetties to regulate orderly movement of passengers & vehicles

Port Blair, Mar. 10

The Harbour ferry service provided by the ferry and vehicle ferry vessels of the Directorate of Shipping Services (DSS) between Port Blair-Bambooflat and its adjoining areas plays a pivotal role towards transshipment of commuters and their vehicle on daily basis. In order to provide seamless and hassle free services in the above harbour ferry route, the Directorate of Shipping Services therefore leaves no stone unturned and initiates various proactive reformative actions time to time, in this sector.

As there is involvement of heavy movement of passengers and vehicles in the above harbour ferry route, the probability of fraudulent travelling

or travelling without valid ticket or pass, by few commuters could not be ignored or dismissed either. To combat the menace of above fraudulent travelling, the Directorate therefore by exercising a robust mechanism, is now carrying out surprise checking of tickets both onboard vessels, as well as at the entry and exit points of vessels. The outcome

of the above surprise checking of tickets is so overwhelming, that the Revenue collection in the above Harbour Ferry sector, in the recent past has almost doubled.

In addition to checking of tickets, to regulate orderly movement of passengers and vehicles, the Directorate has also deployed additional

teams at the Jetties, to coordinate between the vessels and Afloat Communication Centre.

The Directorate of Shipping Services is fully committed to provide smooth and regular services in the harbour ferry sector and to achieve the above task on daily basis, all possible efforts are always been made. It is however,

## Upper age limit for appearing in NEET-UG examination removed

New Delhi, Mar. 10

The National Medical Commission (NMC) has removed the upper age limit for appearing in the medical undergraduate entrance examination - NEET-UG examination. In a letter addressed to the National Testing Agency (NTA), the Commission asked the agency to remove the maximum age criteria from the information bulletin of National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) Undergraduate (UG)



examination. The letter said, it has been decided in the 4<sup>th</sup> NMC meeting that there should not be any fixed upper age limit for appearing in the NEET-UG examination. Therefore, the information bulletin may be modified accordingly. It said, the process for official notification to suitably amend the regulations on

Graduate Medical Education 1997 to this effect has been initiated. The National Medical Commission is the top regulatory body of medical education in the country.

Earlier, the age limit was 25 years for general category candidates and 30 years in the case of reserved category candidates. (Source: india.gov.in)

India's Active caseload currently stands at 44 thousand 488 and it is at 0.10 percent. The recovery rate is currently at 98.70 percent. A total of 6 thousand 544 people recovered in the last 24 hours and total recoveries touched over 4 crore 24 lakh and 20 thousand.

The weekly positivity rate currently stands at 0.58 percent while the Daily positivity rate is at 0.48 percent. A total of 77 crore 60 lakh COVID tests have been conducted in the country so far. In the last 24 hours, more than 8 lakh 73 thousand tests were conducted. (Source:india.gov.in)
