## Vaccination-shield against the virus 9,471 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs vaccinated so far

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,10,244 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,330 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs and 9,471 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs. tandem with all the Departments to ensure the required doses are administered to the eligible beneficiaries have resulted in Isles achieving the status of 'Zero COVID Cases' as on March 31, 2022. This has been solely possible due to the consistent & humongous efforts of the Health Department and the stakeholders in the fight against the pandemic.

As per the data provided by the Health Department, it is heartening to note that no death case has been reported during the third wave. The total samples tested so far stands at 712684 and the rate of testing per million is 1781710.

Though the Islands have achieved the status of zero cases, there should not be any complacency in adhering to COVID Appropriate Behaviour and citizens must continue to strictly ensure wearing of mask and maintain social distancing.

## South Andaman District Police solves burglary case; 6 arrested

Port Blair, Mar. 31

In continuation of the zero tolerance policy against any kind of crime, PS Aberdeen staff have cracked the Aberdeen Bazaar Hotel burglary case and recovered 2 I-Phones worth Rs. 1.17 Lakhs and Rs. 20,700/- cash.

On 21/03/2022, a case vide FIR No. 67/ 22 U/s 457/380 IPC was registered at PS Aberdeen and investigation was entrusted to SI Regan Isaac of PS Aberdeen. The case was initially a blind case of theft of Rs. 2 Lakhs of cash from the Hotel Beach Castle, Aberdeen Bazaar. However, working professionally, the team collected technical evidences in the form of CCTV footages, CDRs and identified the accused person. Based on the investigation, total 6 persons have been

arrested for their involvement in the crime. The team of PS Aberdeen was led by SI Regan Isaac (Investigating Officer), HC/Sunil Singh Yadav, PC/S.N Rao, PC/Sandeep Lakra, PC/Sonu Yadav, PC/Ashish Kumar and PC/Shiv Kumar under the supervision of Insp. R.K Mazumder, I/c PS Aberdeen cracked the case and recovered 2 Nos. I-Phones worth Rs. 1.17 Lakhs and Rs. 20,700/- cash.

As per Rule-5 of Allotment of Accommodation of Andaman and Nicobar Administrative Residences (General Pool) Rules, 1991, allotment to such regular Government Servants of the Administration will be made on the basis of seniority as determined from the date of their entry into Government service under the A&N Administration. Ad-hoc/Contract employees are not eligible for allotment of Government Residential Accommodation under General Pool and as such their applications will not be entertained.

Applications from the Government servants who are on fresh appointment or on transfer from out station or on deputation and 'Out of Turn' allotment on medical ground shall be received throughout the year through online and their placement in the seniority list shall be made accordingly.

The allottee/ occupant who desired to apply for change of their present quarter to Same Type on repair/medical/mutual/transferal/other grounds etc. and Higher Type shall also register their applications on online portal only.

No hard copy of application is required to be submitted or forwarded to Assistant Secretary (H&E), Secretariat and such applications will not be entertained. The applicants, who intends to apply for allotment of Government Accommodation on seniority basis, should upload recent passport size photo, signature, copy of initial appointment order, pay slip, transfer order/deputation order (in case of transfer/ deputation from out station) in the online portal for verification of concerned DDOs and Assistant Secretary (H&E). Photo & Signature should be in jpg/jpeg. format (size 20-50 kbs) and documents should be in complete shape & in jpg/jpeg/pdf. format (size 20-200 kbs) only.

The applicants those who desire to apply for change of quarter for Same Type should upload copy of quarter allotment order/occupation report in the online portal alongwith the documents mentioned above.

The applicants those who desire to apply for 'Out of Turn' allotment on medical ground should upload copies of latest medical certificates in the online portal for verification of Medical Board alongwith the documents mentioned.
