Over 195 crore 35 lakh vaccine doses have been administered so far under Nationwide Vaccination Drive. The Health Ministry said, the recovery rate is currently at 98.67 per cent. Four thousand and 35 people recovered in the last 24 hours. Total recoveries have reached four crore 26 lakh 61 thousand 370. Six thousand 594 new cases were recorded in

the last 24 hours. India's Active caseload currently stands at 50 thousand 548. Active cases stand at 0.12 per cent. Daily positivity rate is at 2.05 per cent and Weekly positivity rate is at 2.32 per cent. Over 85 crore 54 lakh tests have been conducted so far. ## Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 13,129 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs vaccinated till date

Port Blair, June 14

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,82,747 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,556 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs and 13,129 in the age group of

12-15 years, 5 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 26349.

A total of 217 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 138 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 12 were in the age group of 12-15 years, 5 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 26349.

## In a transformative reform, Cabinet clears 'AGNIPATH' scheme for recruitment of youth in Armed Forces

### Agniveers to be enrolled under respective Service Acts for four years

New Delhi, June 14

The Centre today cleared the AGNIPATH Scheme for recruitment of youth in the Armed Forces. Briefing media in New Delhi with three Service Chiefs, Defence Minister, Shri Rajnath Singh said, the youth selected under this scheme will be known as Agniveers. He said, the Agniveers will be getting attractive monthly package with Risk and Hardship Allowances as applicable in the three services. Shri Singh said Agniveers will be also paid one-time Seva Nidhi package upon completion of engagement period of four years. The AGNIPATH Scheme cleared by Cabinet Committee on Security allows patriotic and motivated youth to serve in the Armed Forces for a period of four years.

Over forty six thousand Agniveers to be recruited this year. This is a major defence policy reform introduced by the Government to usher in a new era in the Human Resource policy of the three services. The policy, which comes into immediate effect, will govern the enrollment for the three services.

Chief of Air Staff Air Chief



Marshal V. R. Chaudhary said, the scheme gives Air Force an opportunity to draw from vast pool of talent available in the country so that they can serve in the Armed Forces with pride.

Air Chief Marshal Chaudhary said, the IAF shall be imparting a wide range of training and exposure to the Agniveers in aviation, weapons and sophisticated ground systems.

Navy Chief Admiral R. Hari Kumar said, Agnipath Scheme is a new era of

new thinking and it will positively impact the Human Resources Management of the Armed Forces. Admiral Hari Kumar said right now, Navy has women officers. With Agniveer scheme, women sailors would also be inducted and it is a major step.

Army Chief General Manoj Pande said, Agnipath Scheme is a transformational reform for the Army and the Nation and it aims to bring a paradigm shift in self-disciplined realization to become better version of himself or herself both

maintain the balance between youth and experienced personnel.

Agniveers will get a salary of 30,000 rupees to 40,000 rupees per month and allowance as applicable. The Seva Nidhi will be exempted from Income Tax. There shall be no entitlement to gratuity and pensionary benefits. Agniveers will be provided non-contributory Life Insurance Cover of 48 lakh rupees for the duration of their engagement period in the Indian Armed Forces.

During this period of service to the nation, the Agniveers will be imparted with various military skills and experience, discipline, physical fitness, leadership qualities, courage and patriotism. Post this stint of four years, the Agniveers will be infused into the civil society where they can contribute immensely towards the nation building process. The skills gained by each Agniveer will be recognised in a certificate to form part of his unique resume. Agniveers, on completion of the four year tenure in the prime of their youth, will be mature and self-disciplined with the realization to become better version of himself or herself both

## COVID-19 status in A & N Islands One positive case detected during RT-PCR test conducted on incoming flight passengers

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 181 incoming flight passengers who arrived here yesterday, one positive case has been detected. Today, 13 flights with 1841 passengers arrived, out of which, 1624 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR

test was conducted on 182 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 47 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 61 passengers were tested with RAT, no

positive case has been detected. RAT was conducted on 42 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus, no positive case has been detected. At Helipad, 4 passengers were tested with RAT and the reports were negative, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

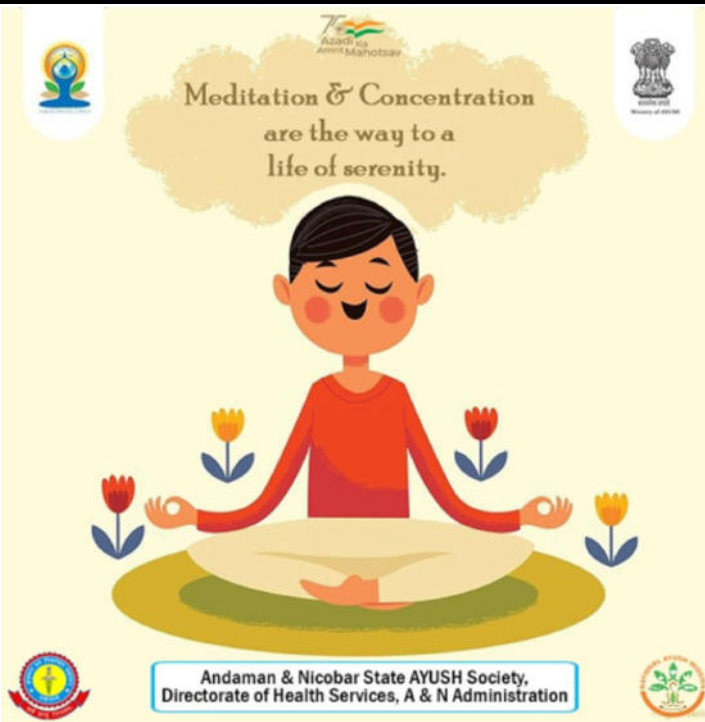

professionally as also personally. Moreover, the Seva Nidhi of approximately 10.4 lakh rupees would aid the Agniveer to pursue his or her future dreams without the financial pressure.

Upto 25 per cent of Agniveers are selected for enrolment in the Armed Forces as regular cadre. They would be required to serve for a further engagement period of minimum 15 years and would be governed by the existing terms and conditions of service of Junior Commissioned Officers or Other Ranks in Indian Army and their equivalent in Indian Navy and Indian Air Force and that of Non-Combatant enrolled in the Indian Air Force, as amended from time to time. The selection will be the exclusive jurisdiction of the Armed Forces.

Enrollment will be undertaken through an online centralised system for all three services with specialised rallies and campus interviews from recognised technical institutes such as Industrial Training Institutes and National Skills Qualifications Framework, among others. Enrolment will be based on All India All Class basis and the eligible age will be in range from 17.5 to 21 years. For entry into General Duty soldier, the educational qualification is Class 10.

In a transformative reform, the AGNIPATH Scheme has been designed to enable a youthful profile of the Armed Forces. It will be a unique opportunity to the youth to serve the country and contribute to Nation Building. As for the Armed Forces, it will enhance the youthful profile of the Armed Forces and provide a fresh lease of Josh and Jazba. It is envisaged that average age profile of Indian Armed forces would come down by about four to five years by implementation of this scheme. The dividends of a short military service to the nation, society and the youth of the nation are immense. This includes inculcation of patriotism, team work, enhancement of physical fitness, ingrained loyalty for the country and availability of trained personnel to boost national security in times of external threats, internal threats and natural disasters. The Indian Men's Football Team qualified for the AFC Asian Cup 2023 for the second successive time today following Palestine's 4-0 win over the Philippines. The men in blue have secured two consecutive qualifications for the first time in history. India, which is second behind Hong Kong on goal difference, has qualified ahead of its final round group D clash. Overall, India has qualified for the continental showpiece for the fifth time.

## Common Yoga Protocol of International Day of Yoga: Day 1

## YOGĀSĀNAS

## A. STANDING POSTURES

## TĀDĀSĀNA (Palm Tree Posture)

Tāḍa means palm tree or mountain. This asana teaches one to attain stability and firmness and forms the base for all the standing asana.

## Technique

- Stand with feet 2 inches apart.
- Inhale, lift your arms up to the shoulder level in the front.
- Interlock the fingers, and turn the wrist outwards. Now inhale, raise the arms up above your head.
- Raise the heels off the floor and balance on the toes as you raise your arms. Stay in this position for 10-30 seconds.
- Bring the heels down.
- Exhale, release the interlock of the fingers and bring the arms down and come back to standing posture.

## Benefits

- This āsana brings stability in the body, helps to clear up congestion of the spinal nerves and corrects faulty posture.

## Caution

- Avoid lifting the heels in case of arthritis, varicose veins and vertigo.

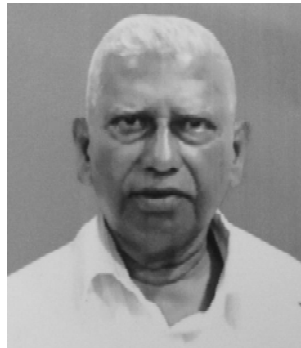

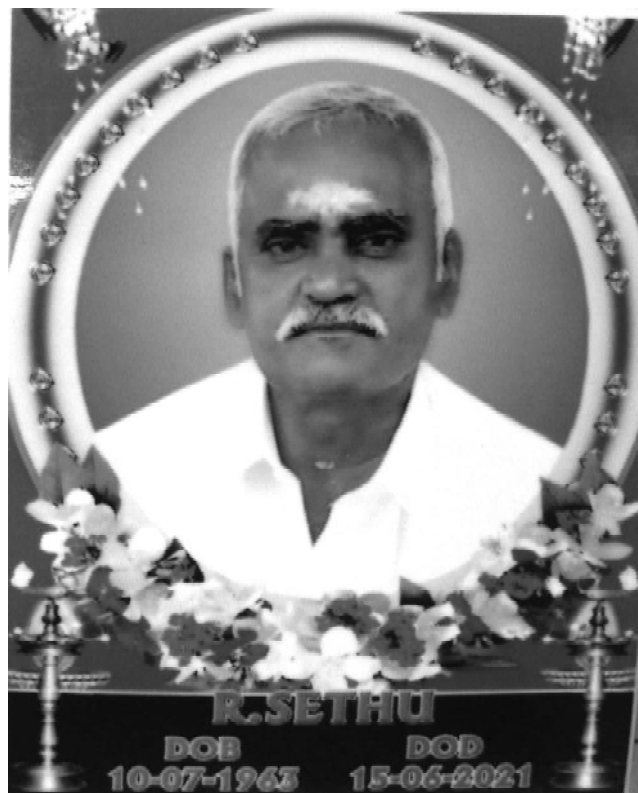
