#### CPI (M) Expresses **Concern Over Increase** in Frequency and **Duration of Power** Disruption

Port Blair, Oct 28: CPI (M) has expressed concern over the sudden increase in the frequency and duration of power disruption occurring at Port Blair and rural South Andaman during the last few days. In a letter sent to the Chief Secretary, Andaman & Nicobar Administration, Mr. D. Ayyappan, Secretary, CPI (M) A & N State Organising Committee drew the attention of the Chief Secretary to the frequent disruption in the power supply occurring at Port Blair and South Andaman areas since last more than one year.

However, it has been noticed that the frequency and duration of power disruption have suddenly increased during the last few days, he said in the letter. Half of the day time, there is no electricity in the Port Blair town and rural South Andaman areas. People from all walks of lives are suffering due to this increased power disruption particularly during day time.

## As Elon Musk takes over Twitter, minister says: 'Our rules remain the same'

Rules for social media plat- Reuters. forms won't change even as Elon Musk takes over Twitter in a \$44 billion deal after months of uncertainty, Rajeev Chandrasekhar, minister of state for electronics and information technology, has suggested. "Our rules and laws for intermediaries remain the same regardless of who owns the platforms. So, the expectation of compliance with Indian laws and rules remains," he was quoted as saying by news agency

As Elon Musk - the world's richest person - completes the acquisition in one of the biggest deals that the tech industry has seen in recent times, he is expected to do away with permanent bans on users among other key decisions, reports said.


When asked what the government thought about the ban on Twitter for individuals such as Bollywood actor Kangana Ranaut, the minister just said the country's new

amended IT rules would be released soon.

Ranaut, who was banned from Twitter last year for violating the platform's rules, has applauded the Twitter takeover and urged Musk to restore her account.

## Kerala court sentences man to 20-year jail term for sexual assaulting minor girl

A 48-year-old man has been sentenced to 20 years imprisonment by a Kerala court for sexually assaulting a minor girl at his residence in Nattukal area of Palakkad district of the state.

Special Court Judge Satish Kumar also imposed a fine of ?one lakh on the convict and directed that the amount, if recovered, be paid to the victim who was seven years old at the time of the sexual assault in 2020, special public prosecutor Nisha Vijayakumar said.

The prosecutor said Pattambi Fast Track that the accused had taken the minor girl to his home on the pretext of playing with her. On reaching home, he sexually assaulted the girl, the prosecutor said.

She also said 15 witnesses were examined and 17 documents were perused by the special court before finding the accused guilty.



# 'Yai akhiri mulakat hogi': Ladakh man overwhelmed after meeting Rajnath Singh

Defence minister Rajnath Singh was thanked by a Ladakh man Friday after he inaugurated a 120-metre bridge over the Shyok river to provide armed forces round-the-clock access to the union territory's Daulat Beg Oldi sector, which lies along the Line of Actual Control (LAC). Singh was presiding over the inauguration of a bridge over the river; the my heart for launching develbridge was built at an altitude of 14,000 feet.

The defence minister also inaugurated 74 other strategically important infrastructure projects, for which also he received thanks from the elderly Ladakhi native. In a video shared by news agency ANI, the man is overwhelmed with emotion after meeting Rajnath Singh and expresses his gratitude for development initiatives in the UT. He also recalls issues local people had to deal with as a result of the lack of development."I want to thank you from the bottom of



opment projects for our benefit. We have previously suffered a lot of challenges owing to the same," he said. "Maybe this is the last time I am meeting you, but I do feel extremely special." To this Rajnath Singh replies, "You have to live more..."

Other projects inaugurated include two helipads and a carbon-neutral habitat. Twenty of these are Border Roads Organisation (BRO) projects in Jammu and Kashmir. Another 18 are in Ladakh and Arunachal Pradesh, with 14 in Sikkim, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab and

Rajasthan, and five in Uttarakhand. They have been constructed at a cost of Rs 2,180 cr.

After inaugurating the project, Singh asserted the lack of infrastructure development in decades post-independence was a big reason behind the rise of terrorism in

Singh appreciated BRO's determination in achieving the feat despite challenging weather conditions. He said the projects will bolster the country's defence readiness and also ensure economic development of border areas.

#### 'BJP not involved in poaching TRS MLAs': Leader's oath at shrine amid row

shared a video of himself taking an oath at the Yadagirigutta Lakshminarasimha Swamy Temple in Telangana as he stressed that his party was not involved in the alleged poaching of the MLAs of the ruling Telangana Rashtra Samithi (TRS). "In the holy abode of Yadadri Lakshmi Narasimha Swamy, swore that BJP is not involved in the alleged poaching of 4TRS MLAs," tweeted Bandi Sanjay Kumar, the BJP's Telangana chief, along with the video. His party colleague - Vishnu Vardhan Reddy, BJP state general secretary, Andhra Pradesh - also tweeted the clip. And in the post was a dare for the ruling party in the state. "Telangana BJP President Shri bandisanjay\_bjp mgaru swore to Yadadri Lakshmi Narasimha Swamy that BJP is not involved in the poaching of TRS MLAs. I dare Telangana CMO KTRTRS family to do the same in their "alleged" involvement in Delhi liquor scam (sic)," he

A BJP leader on Friday wrote. The tweets come amid a row over the claims of the poaching attempts. Earlier this week, the Cyberabad Police had held three men with "large amount of cash" that was allegedly meant to lure the legislators. "We took three people -Nanda Kumar, owner of Deccan Pride Hotel in Hyderabad, Swami Ramachandra Bharati alias S Satish Sharma from Faridabad near Delhi and Simha Yajulu from Tirupati – into custody. We also seized huge amount of cash from them,' Cyberabad police commissioner Stephen Raveendra said, HT had reported. "It was the four MLAs who gave us information about the covert operation. They told us that they were contacted by certain people who asked them to defect from the TRS and join the BJP. In return, they were offered prominent posts, contracts and huge cash," he further added. Amid the controversy, Congress leader Rahul Gandhi alleged a collusion on Thursday. "Both these parties are involved in toppling of governments. They only help each other," he told a brief-
