Shri Modi announced one day of national mourning on 9 July 2022 as a mark of deep respect for Abe Shinzo. The Prime Minister also shared a photograph from their latest meeting in Tokyo.

In a series of tweets, the Prime Minister said; "I am shocked and saddened beyond words at the tragic demise of one of my dearest friends,



Shinzo Abe. He was a towering global statesman, an outstanding leader, and a remarkable administrator. He dedicated his life to make Japan and the world a better place."

"My association with Mr. Abe goes back many years. I had got to know him during my tenure as Gujarat CM and our friendship continued after I became PM. His sharp insights on economy and global affairs always made a deep impression on me."

"During my recent visit to Japan, I had the opportunity to meet Mr. Abe again and discuss

many issues. He was witty and insightful as always. Little did I know that this would be our last meeting. My heartfelt condolences to his family and the Japanese people."

"Mr. Abe made an immense contribution to elevating India-Japan relations to the level of a Special Strategic and Global Partnership. Today, whole India mourns with Japan and we stand in solidarity with our Japanese brothers and sisters in this difficult moment."

"As a mark of our deepest respect for former Prime Minister Abe Shinzo, a one-day national mourning shall be observed on 9 July 2022."

speech. MoEF&CC vide Amendment to Plastic Waste Management Rules dated 12th August, 2021 defined Single Use Plastic as 'Single-Use Plastic Commodity' means the plastic item intended to be used once for some purpose before being disposed or recycled.

Duration between second & precautionary dose reduced; eligible beneficiaries urged to get their doses

The duration between Second dose of COVID-19 vaccine and Precautionary dose has been reduced from the current 9 months (i.e. 39 weeks) to 6 Months (i.e. 26 weeks) by

Therefore, those who have completed 26 weeks can get their precautionary dose of COVID-19 vaccine administered. The

beneficiaries aged between 18-59 years shall continue to get precautionary doses in Private Covid Vaccination Centre on payment basis as practiced earlier, a press release from DHS said.

As per data available, a total of 6,84,014 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,588 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years. 24,624 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years have been

administered both doses of vaccine. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 27,926.

three schemes as per his/her eligibility. "Earlier the proposals were received through Sports Federations/SAI, which used to take considerable time for submission of the proposals. Sometimes it used to take more than 1-2 years to approve the proposal. To ensure timely submission and subsequent approval of cash award, applicant now needs to apply online for cash award scheme within six months from the last date of closing of the particular event", he added.

Union Minister further informed that verification process in all three schemes has been eased to a great extent to reduce the processing time. To ensure that the coach(es) get their cash award in a timely manner, required changes have been made in the scheme. Pension benefits have been extended to the athletes of Deaflympics also. "To implement the above features in these schemes, the Department of Sports has developed web portal dbtyas-sports.gov.in to facilitate sportspersons in applying to seek benefits under the above schemes of Department of Sports", he added.

Shri Thakur said that this online portal will facilitate real time tracking of applications by the sportspersons and authentication through One Time Password (OTP) sent on their registered mobile number. Physical submission of applications by the applicants to the Ministry would now be no longer required. The portal has also been integrated with DBT-MIS which will enable transfer of funds to the sportspersons directly into their bank accounts to fulfil the objectives of DBT Mission of the Government of India.

Union Minister further added that the portal will not only help the Department in quick disposal of all applications in time bound manner but will also be used to generate different types of required reports and data management of the sportspersons. The online portal would be further upgraded from time to time to suit the requirement of the sportspersons and the prevalent scenarios.

Union Minister highlighted that the department has also developed a dedicated interactive website nsdf.yas.gov.in for 'National Sports Development Fund' (NSDF). This Fund is based on CSR contributions from Central & State Governments, PSUs, private companies, and individuals etc. for promotion and development of sports in the country. Union Minister informed that individual, institution and corporate organizations can now directly contribute for players, sports facilities, and sports events through the portal. The NSDF corpus is used for Target Olympic Podium (TOP) scheme, Infrastructure development by eminent sportspersons and sports organizations etc. "This dedicated website will provide easy and transparent access not only to the sportspersons but also to the CSR contributors. This website will help us in making NSDF a great success for the development of sports in the country", he added.

India is committed to 'Ending the AIDS' epidemic as a public health threat by 2030 in line with Sustainable Development Goals (SDG). UNAIDS issued 95-95-95 Fast-Track Strategy to End AIDS by 2030. That is 95% of people living with HIV to know their HIV status; 95% of people who know their HIV status to be put on ART treatment and 95% of people on treatment to have suppressed viral loads.

A virtual meeting was conducted by A&N AIDS Control Society

(ANACS) for newer approaches towards finding new HIV cases. All the 13 ICTCs from Diglipur to Campbell Bay are being involved for this programme. They have been designated in the high footfall CHCs and PHCs which is coordinated by Dr P.K. Sikdar, AD(LSD/BSO) to discuss various parameters and indicators to achieve the target set by UNAIDS. The virtual meeting was attended by the Staff Nurse, Lab Technicians and Counselors of ICTCs, ART Centre, DSRC,

Blood Bank and officials & staff of A&N AIDS Control Society. About 33 participants participated in the virtual meeting. The meeting was conducted under the chairmanship of Dr M. Joy, Project Director, ANACS. In his key note address, the Project Director emphasized on increasing the testing by Community Based Screening, Outreach activities and Index Testing Services/ Contact tracing of the People living with HIV, a press release from

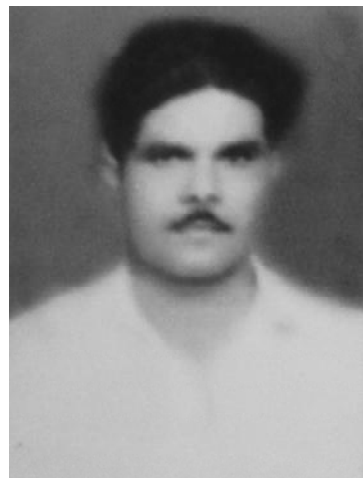
