In a recent memorandum, the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, has approved grant of Non-Productivity Linked Bonus (Ad-hoc Bonus) equivalent to 30 days emoluments for the accounting year 2010-17 to the Central Governmentemployees in Group °C and all non-gazetted employees in Group °C who control to the Central Covernmentemployees in Group °C and all non-gazetted employees in Group °C who control to the Central Covernment of the Central Covernmen are not covered by any Productivity Linked

Bonus Scheme.

Only those employees who were in service as on March 31, 2021 and have rendered at least six months of continuous service during the year 2020-21 will be eligible for pay ment of the ad-hoc bonus. The service during the year 2020-21 will be eligible for pay ment of the ad-hoc bonus. The quantum of ad-hoc bonus will be worked out on the basis of a verage emoluments/ calculation ceiling whichever is low er, the order said. "Pro-rata payment will be order said. "Pro-rata payment will be detained by the foliable postored by the official by the offic admissible to the eligible employees for a period of continuous service during the year from six months to a full year, the eligibility period being taken in terms of the number of months of service (rounded off to the nearest number of months). be extended to the employees of Union Territory Administration which follow the Central Government pattern of emoluments and are not covered by any other bonus or ex-gratia scheme. INDIA CONTINUES TO BE HIGH-COST ENVIRONMENT FOR AIRLINES: IATA OFFICIAL

India continues to remain a highcost environment for airlines to ope cost environment or anines to operate in and it is critical to empow er the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority (AERA) further to safeguard the interest of passengers, said Phillip Goh, Regional Vice President for Asia Pacific region of global airlines body IATA.

AERA decides w hattariffs—such AERA decides whattaritis—such as base a import charges, landing charges, parking charges and passenger service fee—major Indian airports can charge an airline or a passenger for a padicular period after considering the airports' expenditure and revenue projections for hatperiod. Goh told PTI in a statement, "Over the nast year with the third

"Over the past year, with the third control period tariff reviews for India's majorairports, AERA has demonstrated its effectiveness as an independent

"At a time when the government is planning on a big thrust on monetisation of airport assets under its National Monetisation Pipeline, it is critical that AERA is empowered further to safeguard the consumer interest," he added.

Since the beginning of the pandemic in February last year, AERA has rejected the demands of operators of major airports such as Delhi and

Mumbai for a majorincrease in tariffs for the third control period, which began

in April 2019 and ends in March 2024.
For example, AERA had in
December 2020 rejected the Delhi
Airport operator DIAL's demand to
increase base airport charges by 424

2021 rejected Mumbai Airport operato MIAL's demand to impose an ad-hoc user dev elopment fee (UDF) of Rs 200 on domestic outbound passengers and Rs 500 on international outbound

passengers.

If the demand for ad-hoc UDF at the Mumbai Airport was permitted, it would be unfair and an additional

would be unfair and an additional burden to passengers who should instead be getting the benefit of "reduced tarriff" as they have "dready or epiadin theprory sears", the AERA order hadsaid.

Lastmonth, AERA had issued an order stating that the UDF at the Bengaluru Airport will remain unchanned fill March 20/22 and vill

unchanged till March 2022 and will be increased every financial year m April 2022 to March 2025.

Similarly, India's Aviation Security Fee (ASF)—which was introduced in July 2019 to replace the Passenger Service Fee (Security Component)-has been increased for Component)—ras been increased tor international passengers by 370 per centanddomestic passengers by 54 per cent in a shorts pan of over two years, without much transparency and consultation, he noted.

India on alert over new highly mobile COVID-19 variant 'AY. 4.2'

New Delhi, 24th Oct, 2021: India's Covid genomic surveillance project is on high alert after the detection of a sublineage of SARS CoV2's delta variant in the UK and COV2's deta vanantinme UKand the USA. The scientists have indicated that the new variant may be even more transmissible than the delta strain. The new variant, called AY. 4.2, has now been declared as the 'variant under Investigation' in the UK. Sofar. this variant has not been detected in India inover 68,000 samples from SARS CoV 2 infected patients that have undergone whole genome sequencing under the INSACOG project. "However, we will raise surveillance and more samples will

be tested from among the international passengers in the

coming days—so that we don't miss the possible infections caused due to AY 4. 2 and those infected are quickly identified," said a senior official attached with the National



Centre for Disease Control which is leading INSACOG. Lastweek, the UK Health Security Agency had announced that a new subty pe of delta had been spreading in the country. The UK now reports the highest daily Covid19 cases after the USA globally, Ithad said thatthe new ly detected variant accounted for

SARS CoV2 in the week beginning September 27, the latest week for which complete sequencing data was available, "The variant is on an increasing trajectory," the agency had said while the scientists said the strain could be nearly 10 per cent more transmissible than the original delta variant. The variant has also been detected in the USA. A senior scientist associated with a CSIR laboratory in the capital meanwhile radicatory in the capital meanwhile explained that a variant being more infectious, may not necessarily bea greater cause for concern. "If a strain is more trans missible, it does naturally suggest that it is more dangerous or capable of causing more virulent disease," said the

Centre has given a nod to 157 new medical colleges in the country since 2014: Health Ministry

Tweeted by @ARCentre has given a nod to 157 new medical colleges in the country since 2014 and has invested a total of over 17,691 crore rupees on these projects. Union Health Ministry said, on completion of these medical colleges nearly 16,000 undergraduate medical seats will be added. Of these, 6,500 seats have already been created with

the functioning of 64 new Medical

Colleges.
The Ministry said, under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes, the Central Gov ernment has also provided about over 2,451 crore rupees for upgradation of existing state government or central government medical colleges to increase MBBS seats in the country.

The Ministry said, under the Scheme, medical colleges are established in Districts which do not have either a government or private medical college. It said, preference is given to underserved, backward and aspirational districts. Under three phases of the scheme, 157 new medical colleges have been approved, out of which 64 medical

colleges are already functional. Health Ministry said, out of 157 new medical colleges, 39 are being set up in Aspirational Districts. This Central Sector Scheme was envisaged to bridge the shortfall in manpower in the Medical Secbr as also to bridge the geographical imbalance in availability of trained medical manpower across the country.

FACEBOOK HASN'T ACTED AGAINST RSS DUE TO POLITICAL SENSITIVITIES: REPORTS

Facebook has been facing criticism over the years for its alleged tardiness in combating widespread disinformation and

comparing widespread dismormation and externist information on the platform.

One country where these criticisms have frequently been raised is its largest market: India. Last year, a senior Facebook executive based in India, Ankhii Das, stepped counted the subsection of the subsection. down after reports claimed she allegedly blocked action against leaders associated with the BJP and other Hindutva groups.

The disclosures referred to internal The disclosures referred to internal memos by Facebook employees that exposed how Facebook's own "algorithms or default settings" played a part in spurring malcontent. This included automated recommendations of groups "inundated with fake news, anti-Pakistan rhetoric and Islamophobic content", Associated Press

The disclosures cited a Facebook report titled Adversarial Harmful Networks: India Case Study. This study claimed that " much of the content posted by users, groups and pages from the Hindu nationalist Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh group, or RSS, is never flagged", The Wall Street

"Researchers also found pro-RSS users on Facebook were posting a high volume of content about 'Love Jihad', a conspiracy theory that is spreading online and has gained traction in recent years," The Wall Street Journal added.

However, the study noted, "Facebook

hasn't designated the RSS for removal 'given political sensitivities'," The Wall Street Journal reported. The New York Times reported these political sensitivities were

disclosures that claimed Facebook had hesitated to act against the Bajrang Dal despite allegations the group had used

The discbsures claimed Facebook was unable to flag hate content published in Hindi and Bengali due to lack of "sufficient technical systems".
