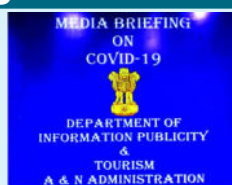

**Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub**

**CIARI- HanGreens: the green curtains of culantro (Burmese coriander)**

Burmese coriander is a popular herb in the Andaman Islands and North Eastern states of India. Apart from the traditional areas, this herb is gaining popularity in other parts of the country. Generally, this herb is sold at premium prices in city markets. Many people in urban areas try to cultivate this herb in small pots to get produce for home consumption. To promote its cultivation in the urban households with limited spaces, a novel hanging structure has been developed and is being popularized in the islands. The developed structure (CIARI- HanGreens) is a hanging model and hence occupies limited space. It could be hung in the balconies and terraces. When used in urban homes, it not only provides produce for daily consumption but also gives aesthetic appeal to the area. Grower can get a good cultivation experience in small premise. Based on space available and family requirement, structure size could be customized and hence, it is user-friendly. It could also be used as green curtains for beautification of areas including government and private establishments, tourist spots, hotels etc. It requires no major maintenance. With limited investment, user can accommodate more number of plants than the conventional pots and hence, get manifold higher produce. **Benefit:** CIARI-HanGreens could be a beautiful hanging curtain of Burmese coriander for your home and commercial establishments. It'll give produce for daily consumption to urban homes, while serving as a unit of attraction in landscaping.

Foundation for Environment Education in Denmark (FEE) which accords the globally recognized eco-label - Blue Flag certification, has also given re-certification for 8 nominated beaches Shivrajpur-Gujarat, Ghoghla-Diu, Kasarkod and Padubidri-Karnataka, Kappad-Kerala, Rushikonda- Andhra Pradesh, Golden Odisha and Radhanagar- Andaman and Nicobar, which were awarded the Blue Flag certificate last year.

A case under POCSO Act was registered in the Billiground Police Station on the basis of fardbayan of victim girl in the year 2020. The prosecution has sufficiently proved that the accused person has committed the offence under section 08 of POCSO Act, 2012 for committing sexual assault upon a minor girl aged about 13 years.

For rehabilitation of the victim girl, an amount of Rs.50,000/- has been awarded as compensation as per provision of 357A of Cr.P.C from Victim Compensation Fund. The entire case was investigated by SI Arthi Roy under the guidance of SI Deben Kumar Roy, former SHO, PS Billiground for which the Hon'ble Court has appreciated her commitment towards her duty. The prosecution case was conducted by Shri Keshab Chandra Mondal, learned Special Public Prosecutor (POCSO Act), Mayabunder, a press release received here said.
