that, in her view, the development of original talent in science, literature, or the social sciences can be more effective through the mother tongue. It is our mothers who teach us the art of living in our early lives. That is why mother tongue is helpful in developing natural talent. After the mother, the teachers carry forward our education in our lives. If teachers also teach in their mother tongue, then students can develop their talent with ease. That is why in the National Education Policy 2020, emphasis has been laid on the use of Indian languages for school education and higher education.

The President said that it is the responsibility of teachers to generate interest in science and research among their students. Good teachers can make complex principles easy to explain with the help of living examples that exist in nature. She quoted a famous saying about teachers and said "the mediocre teacher tells; the good teacher explains; the superior teacher demonstrates; and the great teacher inspires." She said that an ideal teacher has all four qualities. Such ideal teachers build a nation in the true sense by building the lives of the students.

The President urged teachers to encourage the habit of asking questions and expressing doubts in the students. She said that by answering more and more questions and solving doubts, their knowledge would also increase. A good teacher is always enthusiastic about learning something new.

ICAR-CIARI establishes Pandanus Gene Bank in its campus

ICAR-CIARI has established a Pandanus Gene Bank at its Garacharma Research Farm today under the project funded by National Medicinal Plants Board, New Delhi, to conserve, evaluate and utilize different species of the Pandanus collected from different parts of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. In this regard, 175 seedlings of various species viz. Pandanus lerrum, Pandanus tectorius, Pandanus odorifer and Pandanus amaryllifolius

were planted in 2 acre of terraced land at CIARI campus. Meanwhile, as part of World Coconut Day 2022 celebration, thirty seedlings of five released coconut varieties of CIARI viz. Dweep Haritha, Dweep Sona, CIARI Chandan, CIARI Surya and CIARI Annapurna were also planted in the field gene bank. Dr. E.B. Chakurkar, Director, CIARI inaugurated the planting ceremony which was attended by all Scientists of the Institute. Dr. I. Jaisankar, Senior Scientist and coordinator of the programme welcomed the gathering and briefed the background of research on Pandanus at CIARI and provided the planting material for the gene bank. Dr. B.A. Jerard, Head, Division of Horticulture & Forestry and the convener of the programme also spoke on the occasion.

COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Sept. 5

Two COVID positive cases have been detected today in A&N Islands, of which, one incoming flight passenger who arrived here yesterday was found positive while screening. Today, 8 flights with 1334 passengers arrived, out of which, 1187

passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 115 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 24 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been

detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 16 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. RAT was conducted on 9 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus and no positive case has been detected, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

Country witnesses reduction in pupil-teacher ratio over last one decade: Govt.

New Delhi, Sept. 5

The country has witnessed substantial reduction in pupil-teacher ratio over the last one decade. According to Ministry of Education, in Primary Schools, the pupil teacher ratio which was at 43 in 2010-11 has come down to 26.3 in 2020-21.

While in Upper Primary schools, the pupil-teacher ratio

has reduced from 33 in 2010-11 to 18.9 in 2020-21. The Pupil Teacher Ratio at different levels of education show availability of adequate number of teachers for teaching children enrolled at different grade. The increase in number of teachers in schools is contributing to focused delivery of education. (Source: india.gov.in)

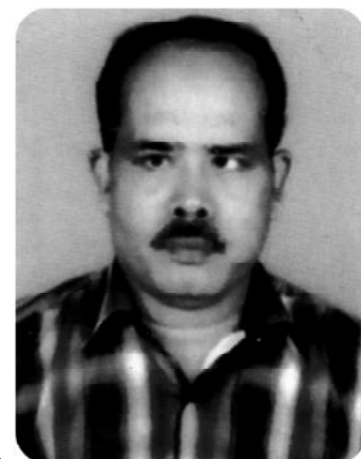

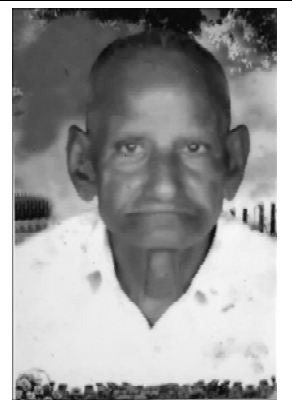
