COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, July 11

Fourteen positive cases have been detected today in A&N Islands, of which, 9 were from incoming flight passengers who arrived here yesterday. Today, 9 flights with 1284 passengers arrived, out of which, 1142 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 104 passengers and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 41 passengers bound for Phoenix Bay Jetty, 26 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. RAT was conducted on 15 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus, no positive case has been detected, a press release from DHS said.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands**24,652 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years administered both doses of vaccine**

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,84,135 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Accordingly, the team followed the bus and intercepted it at Forest Check Post Rangat and carried out thorough search of the bus after which the illegal meat concealed in a bag was recovered from the luggage container of the bus. On further interrogation, the identity of the accused was revealed who happened to be a passenger travelling in the same bus. The AFEVS team arrested the accused under the provisions of Wildlife Protection Act, 1972 and after following all codal formalities handed over the accused along with 20 kg meat of Andaman wild Boar to the Range Officer, Rangat.

The arrested accused person along with the seized meat was produced before the Hon'ble Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mayabunder on July 10, 2022 by the Range Officer, Rangat after which a case has been registered. The Hon'ble Court remanded the accused person to judicial custody till 21st July, 2022. It also directed to safely dispose of the seized meat by burying it, which was duly carried out on 11th July, 2022 after following all formalities at Rangat.

The entire operation was successfully conducted under the close supervision of Shri Satyaprakash Singh, Divisional Forest Officer, Middle Andaman, Rangat. Further, the DFO, Middle Andaman has requested the general public to pass on any credible information related to any wildlife and forest offence on phone nos. 03192-274210 and 03192-275353. The identify of all such informers will not be disclosed, a press release from DFO, MA said.
