

PM to attend 14th BRICS Summit to be held virtually from today

New Delhi, June 22

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will attend two-day 14th BRICS Summit hosted by China beginning tomorrow. The summit will be held in virtual format under the theme 'Foster High-quality BRICS Partnership, Usher in a New Era for Global Development'. Chinese President, Mr Xi Jinping will also chair a High-Level Dialogue on Global Development with guest countries on 24th of June.

BRICS leaders and leaders of relevant emerging markets and developing countries will attend the High-Level Dialogue on



Global Development on 24th June. Ministry of External Affairs said, BRICS has become a platform for discussing and deliberating on issues of common concern for all developing countries. BRICS countries have regularly called for reform of the multilateral system in order to make it more representative and inclusive.

During the 14th BRICS Summit, deliberations are expected to be held in areas like terrorism, trade, health, traditional medicine, environment, Science & Technology, innovation, agriculture, technical and vocational education & training and Micro Small and Medium Enterprises. Discussions are also likely to be held on

issues like reform of the multilateral system, combating COVID-19 pandemic and global economic recovery. Prior to the summit on Thursday, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi also delivered a keynote speech virtually in the opening ceremony of the BRICS Business Forum today.

14th BRICS Summit this year assumes importance as this will be the first BRICS Summit amid geopolitical tectonic shifts taking place due to Russia-Ukraine war and Russia - one of the BRICS members coming under severe economic sanctions by

The Government has stressed that selection process for the recruitment of Agniveers under the newly launched Agnipath Scheme will be transparent, fair and objective. Registration process for recruitment of first batch in Indian Air Force will start from 24th of this month. Army and Navy will start the registration process from 1st of next month.

Briefing media in New Delhi today, Lieutenant General and Additional Secretary in Department of Military Affairs, Anil Puri said, no change



will be made in the recruitment process and regimentation will remain unchanged. He said, Agnipath Scheme lay emphasis on youthful profile of the armed forces, recruitment of tech-savvy and adaptable people and making individuals

future-ready. He said, Agniveers will be eligible for gallantry awards. He said, a helpline number 23013865 has been started to help the candidates.

Air Marshal Suraj Kumar Jha said that there is no change in the process of

induction, entry-level qualification and examination syllabus. He said, all enrollments in Air Force will take place only through Agniveer Vayu. He said, online exam will be conducted in 250 centres across the

Quarterly review meeting of Child Welfare Committee, South Andaman held DC (SA) reviews pendency of cases and functioning of CWC; directs to dispose pending cases related to children in need of care & protection in priority

Port Blair, June 22

The quarterly review meeting of Child Welfare Committee, South Andaman was conducted under the Chairmanship of District Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner (SA), Shri Sunee Anchipakka on June 16 to review the pendency of cases and the issues pertaining to the welfare of children of South Andaman which was attended by the Members of the Child Welfare Committee, South Andaman.



The District Magistrate / Deputy Commissioner is conferred the powers as per the Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act U/s 27 (8) and the Rule 20 (3) A&N Islands Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Rules 2017.

The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman reviewed the pendency of cases and functioning of the Child Welfare Committee wherein he directed to dispose the pending cases related to children in need of care and protection at the

earliest and emphasized that no child should be neglected and help should reach the child in distress without delay. He directed to dispose the cases of South Andaman District on priority and also emphasized on regular inspection of Child Care Institutions to monitor the well being of the children and facilities available to them as per Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act 2015, a press release from DCPU (SA) said.

Registration of PIBOs and PWPs in Centralized EPR Portal for Plastic Packaging

Port Blair, June 22

Extended Producers Responsibility (EPR) regime is under implementation in Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016, according to which, it is the responsibility of Producers, Importers and Brand-owners including producers and manufacturers of compostable plastics to ensure processing of their plastic packaging waste through recycling, re-use or end of life disposal (such as co-processing/Waste-to-energy/Plastic to oil/road making/industrial-composting).

In order to streamline implementation process of EPR, the

Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India, in its fourth Amendment to the Plastic Waste Management Rules, dated February 16, 2022, notified 'Guidelines on Extended Producer Responsibility for Plastic Packaging' in the Schedule II of the Rules.

Accordingly, the Centralized EPR Portal has been developed to register PIBOs who are operating in more than two States with CPCB and those operating in one or two States/UTs shall be registered with the concerned State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs). Plastic Waste Processors shall also have to register with the

concerned SPCB/PCC in accordance with the provisions of Section 13(3) of the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 on this centralized portal. The EPR Portal for Plastic Packaging provides provision for registration of PIBOs/ PWPs in accordance with the notified EPR Guidelines.

All the Producers, Importers and Brand Owners (PIBOs) and Plastic Waste Processors (PWPs) have been directed to register through the Centralized EPR Portal developed by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) within 30 days. Action, as deemed fit under Environment Protection

Act, 1986 including levying of Environmental Compensation as per the Guidelines shall be taken against the defaulter.

Indian communication satellite to be launched by Arianespace

New Delhi, June 22

The European Space Agency, Arianespace, will put into orbit two communication satellites belonging to India and Malaysia in the geostationary orbit. The two satellites cumulatively

weighing over 10 thousand kilograms will be flown by Ariane-5 rocket from the spaceport in Kourou, French Guiana.

The Indian Satellite, GSAT-24 has been developed by the New Space India Limited (NSIL), ISRO's

commercial arm, for television service provider Tata Sky. The GSAT-24 is a 24-Ku band communication satellite weighing over four thousand kilograms with Pan-India coverage for meeting DTH application needs. Moreover, the

satellite has been configured to have a mission life of 15 years. In an official release, Arianespace CEO, Mr Stéphane Israël expressed his excitement about partnering again with ISRO since NSIL's creation in 2019. (Source: india.gov.in)

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 13,218 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years vaccinated so far

Over 196 crore 45 lakh COVID vaccine doses administered in country so far

New Delhi, June 22

Over 196 crore 45 lakh COVID vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far under the Nationwide Vaccination Drive. The Union Health Ministry said, over 12 lakh 28 thousand vaccine doses were administered to the beneficiaries yesterday.

A total of 12 thousand 249 new COVID cases were recorded in the last 24



hours as several States and UTs are witnessing surge in the cases. With the increase in the cases, India's active caseload increased to 81 thousand 687 and recovery rate declined to 98.60 per cent. The Health Ministry said, a total of nine thousand 862 COVID patients recovered in the last 24 hours. According to the Health Ministry, 13 deaths were reported in last 24 hours. Major edible oil brands have cut prices by 10-15 rupees: Food Secretary

New Delhi, June 22 (PIB)

The wholesale prices and retail prices of vanaspati, soyabean oil, sunflower oil and RBD palmolein have decreased over the week. With the edible oil prices beginning to show a downward trend and are set to decline further, the Indian consumers can expect to pay less for their edible oils. The falling edible oil prices will help in

cooling the inflation as well, said Secretary Department of Food and Public Distribution, Shri Sudhanshu Pandey here today.

"All major edible oil brands have cut prices by 10-15 rupees," Shri Pandey said. He added that this has been possible due to constant monitoring by the Department, constant engagement with all stakeholders and m u l t i p l e

interventions by the Government. According to sources, the MRP of Fortune Refined Sunflower Oil 1 litre pack has been decreased to Rs. 210 from Rs. 220. The MRP of Soyabean (Fortune) and Kachi Ghani oil 1 litre pack from Rs. 205 to Rs. 195. The reduction in oil prices comes in the wake of Central Government reducing the import duty on edible oils making them cheaper.

Nukkad Natak on Road Safety organized at Flag Point by Traffic Police

Port Blair, June 22

The A&N Traffic Police conducted a Nukkad Natak in collaboration with Port Blair Guru Ki Rasoi at Flag Point to create road safety awareness amongst the general public on June 18. Around 10 participants from Port Blair Guru Ki Rasoi performed in the Natak. They performed two different acts, one of which highlighted the case of a bus driver who was driving the bus in a dangerous manner while using his mobile phone and getting into an accident. The other act highlighted the case of a youngster who



did not wear helmet while riding a motorcycle and drove rashly resulting in a fatal accident. Around 200 people witnessed the act.

Japan had to be content with the runners-up trophy with 143 points and Mongolia finished third with 138 points. Bouts in 5 weight categories of women wrestling were held. Indian women



including Ritika won gold in 43 kilogram, Ahilaya Shinde got gold in 49 kilogram, Siksha lifted gold medal in 57 kilogram, Priya received gold in 73 kilogram while Pulkit secured a Silver medal in 65 kilogram.

In addition, the competitions in three weight categories of Free Style were also held and Parwinder Singh won Gold in 80 kilogram while Narender secured Silver in 71 kilogram.

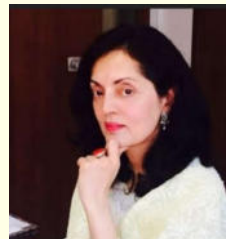

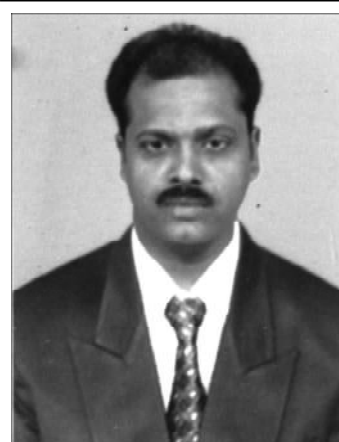
