New Delhi, June 19 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi launched the historic torch relay for the 44th Chess Olympiad today at Indira Gandhi Stadium, New Delhi. FIDE President, Mr. Arkady Dvorkovich handed over the torch to the Prime Minister, who in turn handed it over to Grandmaster Vishwanathan Anand. This torch will be taken to 75 cities in a span of 40 days before the final culmination at Mahabalipuram near Chennai. At every location, chess grandmasters of the state will receive the torch. Prime Minister,



Shri Modi also made the Khelo Chess Ceremonial move followed by Ms Koneru Humpy making a move. Union Ministers Shri Anurag Singh Thakur and Shri Nisith Pramanik, Chess Officials were among those present on the occasion.

He thanked the Government of India for taking the initiative in the start of the new tradition of torch relay which will popularise and galvanise the game all over the world. "FIDE is grateful to Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi for his presence and honouring us" he said and recalled the Prime Minister's speech on the

occasion of most players playing chess in one place in 2010 on the significance of the game of Chess in building new capabilities and role of combination of education and sports in

leading to success. The FIDE President hoped that Chess would become part of all schools across India and all over the world. He said "India today is the fastest growing Chess country today and you have all grounds to be proud of that. We are grateful for your leadership for all the fantastic work that you are doing in the interest of Chess."

Government of India has announced several beneficial and supporting measures in the last few days to allay apprehensions surrounding the Agnipath recruitment scheme into armed forces and to ensure support to Agniveers. Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India and several state Governments have announced that Agniveers, after serving the armed forces for 4 years, will be given preference in filling of vacancies in police

forces. Several other Departments have also announced support to the Agnipath scheme to enhance the capabilities of the Agniveers and ensures a bright future for them. Also, by augmenting their skills, Agniveers will be a well-trained and highly disciplined youth force that can be harnessed for nation building and will be an asset to the society.

Reservation in posts of Coast Guard and Defence PSUs: Raksha Mantri, Shri Rajnath Singh has approved reservation of 10% of the job vacancies in

Ministry of Defence for Agniveers. The 10% reservation will be implemented in the Indian Coast Guard and defence posts, and all the 16 Defence Public Sector Undertakings (HAL, BEL, BEMIL, BDL, GRSE, GSL, HSL, MDL, MIDHANI, AVNL, AWEIL, MIL, YIL, GIL, IOL, TCL). 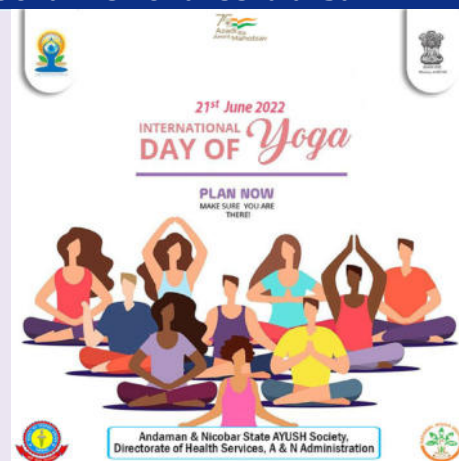
International Yoga Day on the theme 'Yoga for Humanity' to be observed on June 21

the first torch relay for Chess Olympiad games is starting from India. For the first time, this year, India is also going to host Chess Olympiad games. We are proud that a sport, starting from its birthplace and leaving its mark all over the world, has become a passion for many countries." He continued "Centuries ago, the torch of this sport went to the whole world in the form of Chaturanga from India. Today the first Olympiad torch of chess is also coming out of India. Today, when India is celebrating its 75th year of independence, Amrit Mahotsav, this Chess Olympiad torch will also go to 75 cities of the country." He said "FIDE has decided that the torch relay for each Chess Olympiad game will start from India itself. This honour is not only the honour of India, but also the honour of this glorious heritage of chess. I congratulate FIDE and all its members for this".

The Prime Minister dwelled on the India heritage in Chess. He said "our ancestors invented games like Chaturanga or Chess for analytical and problem solving brains. Chess, via India, reached many countries of the world and became very popular. Today, chess is being used in schools as an education tool for young people, for children." He noted that in recent years, India is consistently improving its performance in Chess. This year, India's contingent in the Chess Olympiad is the biggest so far. The Prime Minister expressed the hope that India will create a new record of medals this year.

The Prime Minister talked about many lessons that Chess gives us in our lives. Underlining the need for right support for everyone irrespective of their place in life, the Prime Minister said "Just like every piece of chess has its own unique strength and a unique ability. If you make the right move with a piece and use its power properly, then it becomes the most powerful. This speciality of Chessboard gives us the big message of life. If given the right support and the right environment, no goal is impossible even for the weakest."

recruitment rules. Necessary age relaxation provision will also be made to enable recruitment of Agniveers to the above posts.

Age relaxation for first year recruitment: Government has announced that it has decided to increase the upper age limit for the recruitment of Agniveers from 21 years to 23 years for the recruitment cycle of 2022.

Recruitment in CAPFs: Ministry of Home Affairs has decided to reserve 10 percent vacancies for recruitment in Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) and Assam Rifles for Agniveers. Home Ministry has further announced that it will give three years age relaxation to Agniveers beyond prescribed upper age limit to recruitments in CAPFs and Assam Rifles. For the first batch of Agniveers, the age relaxation will be of 5 years, MHA has announced.

Recruitment in Merchant Navy: Directorate General of Shipping under Ministry of Ports Shipping and Waterways (MoPSW) along with Indian Navy has announced a system for the smooth induction of the Agniveers into the Merchant Navy. Under this, MoPSW announced six attractive service avenues for smooth transition of Agniveers in various roles of the Merchant navy, post their stint with the Indian Navy. **NIOS to facilitate 12th pass certificate for 10th pass Agniveers:** The Department of School Education & Literacy through its autonomous institution, the National Institute of Open Schooling, has announced that it will institute a special programme in consultation with the Defence Authorities to enable those Agniveers who are 10th class pass to further their education and obtain a 12th class pass Certificate by developing customized courses that are not only current but very relevant to their area of service. This certificate is recognised for both employment and higher education purposes in the whole country.

Degree programme by Education Ministry: In order to enhance the future career prospects of Agniveers and to equip them for various job roles in the civilian sector, the Ministry of Education has decided to launch a special, three year skill based bachelor degree programme for serving defence personnel that will recognize the skill training received by them during their tenure in the defence establishments. Under this programme that has been designed by IGNOU and will also be executed by them, 50 % of the credits required for a graduate degree will come from the skill training - both technical and non-technical - received by the Agniveer, and the remaining 50 % will come from a basket of courses that cover a wide variety of subjects like languages, Economics, History, Political Science, Public Administration, Sociology, Mathematics, Education, Commerce, Tourism, Vocational Studies, Agriculture and Jyotish, as also Ability Enhancement Courses on Environmental Studies and Communication Skills in English. This programme is aligned with UGC norms and with the National Credit Framework / National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) as mandated under the National Education Policy 2020. It also has a provision for multiple exit points - Undergraduate Certificate on successful completion of the first year courses, Undergraduate Diploma on successful completion of the first and second year courses, and Degree on completion of all the courses in three year time frame.

Skill development for entrepreneurship and jobs: Skill India and the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) will work collaboratively with various wings of the Armed Forces to train the students in additional skills to make them better suited for civilian jobs. Agniveers will get Skill India certification while in service, which will enable them to pursue many diverse opportunities in entrepreneurship and job roles that are being created in our economy after completion of their tenure. All organisations of Skill India-Directorate General of Training (DGT), National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), various Sector Skill Councils, entrepreneurship institutes NIESBUD and IIE, as well as skills regulator NCVET, will be connected with this exercise to ensure that Agniveers get the required skill certifications related to their job roles while in service. Some skills learnt on the job may have direct equivalence with NSQF syllabus. For some, complimenting their on-the-job experience with additional online or offline, theory or hands-on skills may be required.

Credit facilities for Agniveers: In order to identify ways in which the Banks and Financial Institutions can support the Agniveers on completion of their tenure of duty, the Secretary, Department of Financial Services (DFS) held a meeting with Chief Executives of Public Sector Banks (PSBs), Public Sector Insurance Companies (PSICs) and Financial Institutions (FIs). In the meeting, it was decided that PSBs, PSICs and FIs would explore employment opportunities for Agniveers in suitable capacities based on their educational qualifications and skills through suitable benefits/relaxations, etc. It was also decided that Banks would explore possibilities of supporting Agniveers through suitable credit facilities for skill upgradation, education for setting up businesses and to take up self-employment.

Preferential recruitment in state police forces: Several State Governments have announced that Agniveers, after serving the armed forces for 4 years, will be given preference in filling of vacancies in state police forces. BHADRĀSANA (The Firm/Auspicious Posture)

Bhadra means firm or auspicious.

Sthiti: Long sitting posture (Viśrāmāsana)

- Sit erect with both the legs stretched forward.
- Support the back with hands. Body should be relaxed totally. This is Viśrāmāsana.

Technique

- Sit straight with legs stretched out in the front.
- Keep the hands beside the hips and palms resting on the floor. This is **Daṇḍāsana**.
- Now put the soles of your feet together.
- Exhale and clasp your hands together over your toes. Inhale, pull your heels as close as possible up to perineum region. If your thighs are not touching or are not close to the floor, place a soft cushion underneath the knees for support.

- This is the final position.
- Stay in this position for some time with normal breathing.

Benefits

- Helps to keep the body firm and stabilizes the mind.
- Helps during pregnancy and relieves abdominal pain often experienced during menstruation.

Caution

- Avoid this practice in case of severe arthritis and sciatica.
- Do not try beyond limits and overdo the lateral stretch.
- If one cannot touch the feet, one can reach for the knees instead.
