Impressive performance by A&N Islands; adjudged 2nd among UTs based on five parameters of food safety

Food Safety Department committed to ensure availability of safe & wholesome food to all Islanders

Port Blair, Sept. 20

The A&N Islands has been adjudged with 2nd position in the State Food Safety Index Rank among the Union Territories in the 3rd All India State Food Safety Index 2020-21 unveiled by the Hon'ble Health Minister, Shri Mansukh Mandaviya at FSSAI, New Delhi today. The prestigious award was received from the Hon'ble Minister by the representative of A&N Administration.

This year, the FSSAI divided States/UTs into three categories large States, small States and Union Territories. The State Food Safety Index ranks States on five parameters viz. human resources and institutional data, compliance, food testing facility, training & capacity building and consumer empowerment. Scores were allotted on parameter wise



performances. This achievement is a result of the dedicated efforts of Food Safety Department for effective enforcement of Food Safety Laws under the overall supervision and expert guidance of Commissioner Food Safety (Deputy Commissioner/SA), Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

The Commissioner Food Safety, Andaman & Nicobar Islands/ Deputy Commissioner (SA) has made special emphasis on improvement in the overall performance of the Department in

providing inputs for maintaining food safety in the Islands. In spite of COVID-19 pandemic, the A&N Food Safety Department has put forth tremendous efforts to achieve the targets set by FSSAI.

Under the UT category, Jammu & Kashmir was adjudged first rank whereas Andaman & Nicobar Islands secured second rank while Delhi stood third in the ranking. The Hon'ble Minister for Health & Family Welfare gave away the awards on the occasion which consisted of a certificate and a memento.

The SHG Market is first of its kind in Mayabunder Block and is providing a handholding support to the Rural SHGs during this time of on-going COVID-19 pandemic situation

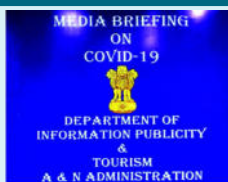

Media briefed on COVID-19

Two positive cases detected during test conducted on incoming flight passengers: Secretary (IP&T)

Port Blair, Sept. 20

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening disclosed that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 1257 passengers who arrived here yesterday, two positive cases were detected. Today, 8 flights with 1105 passengers arrived and the RT-PCR test was conducted on



passengers and the reports are awaited. He further disclosed that RAT was conducted on 222 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and all were found negative. Apart from this, 305 passengers travelling to different destinations were tested

at Phoenix Bay Jetty and all were found negative. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 207 passengers and one positive case was detected.

The Secretary further said that today till 3 pm, 213 beneficiaries were administered vaccines, out of which, 132 were in the age group of 18-44.

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Dragon fruit (Hylocereuspp)- Production technology

Concrete support structures are highly suitable for successful dragon fruit cultivation in A & N Islands. One year old rooted cuttings about 12 inches in length are selected for planting in structures like



unused tyres or concrete square structures with spacing of 3x3 m in open condition. Four cuttings are planted per pillar. Once the planted cuttings start growing, the stems are tied with these columns. It is recommended to have round/circular metal frame or concrete square structure at the top of the pillar to maintain the balanced dragon fruit shoots in drooping form. Organic matter plays key role in dragon fruit cultivation. Each plant should be applied with 10 to 15 kg of organic compost/ organic fertilizers. Thereafter, increase the organic fertilizer amount by 5 kg per year per pole. Dragon fruit require less water as it belongs to the cacti family. During prolonged summer watering may be done. The flowering will initiate in the second year after planting during March and fruiting continues upto November. Pollination is by honey bees and bats. Yield gets stabilized from third year after planting. Once the crop is established in trellis system, the longevity of the crop is upto twenty years. On an average 8 to 10 Kg of fruits can be harvested from a single pole from 4th year after planting. Fruits are harvested 25 to 30 days after flowering and the suitable stage of harvesting is when colour changes completely from green to pink/ red colour.

Benefit: It has huge potential for industrial exploitation and can emerge as a commercial venture for more economic returns. The crop is easy to cultivate with less managerial care. The crop can also be established in a small area and hence is a boon to landless farmers' for their sustainable livelihood.

Promoting cultivation of Spices for better profit & health

Demo on 'Scientific Spices Cultivation' for SHGs conducted by ICAR-CIARI

Port Blair, Sept. 20

A demonstration programme on 'Cultivation of Spices as Profitable Inter Crops' was organized under All India Coordinated Research Project on Palms Project on Sept. 18. Spices are amongst the most suitable crops for commercial scale cultivation in the islands. However, technological interventions are required to get the produce of desirable quality.

Inaugurating the programme, Dr. E.B. Chakurkar, Director, ICAR-CIARI, emphasized upon adoption of scientific practices for reaping maximum benefits from spices cultivation. He advised the participants to undertake value addition of produce for improving the profitability of the



sector. Considering the issues faced in marketing, he urged the youth to play pivotal role by utilizing the digital tools and platforms.

Dr. Ajit Arun Waman, Scientist in Charge of the Project, explained about potential of various herbal, rhizomatous and tree spices as intercrops and sole crops in the islands. During the programme, participants were educated about scientific practices for production and processing of cinnamon, lemon grass, long pepper, Indian bay leaf, woody pepper, black

pepper and bush pepper. Field visits in the experimental gardens of coconut and arecanut based cropping systems involving spices were also made for the benefit of the stakeholders.

Planting materials of various spices were distributed for encouraging participants to take up spices cultivation. The programme was attended by participants from three Self Help Groups from South Andaman along with youth of the Islands, a press release from CIARI said.

Under the guidance of Deputy Commissioner, N & M Andaman, SHG Sunday Markets shall be organized by C D Block Mayabunder on regular basis in 4 different locations which will comprise of SHGs of all 8 Gram Panchayats under the jurisdiction of CD Block Mayabunder to promote and strengthen the network of SHGs following COVID-19 protocols issued by the Administration from time to time. Subsequently, the vaccination for 45 and above was initiated followed by 18 to 44 years which is currently underway.

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, 4,15,889 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands. Meanwhile, a total of 4107 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 2852 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which 339 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 726 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 52 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 529 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 7 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. A total of 1,63,151 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

One Seventh of the total vacancies are reserved for ST Candidates. If ST Candidates are not available, these reserved vacancies will be filled up by candidates from General Category as per rules in force.

A. Conditions of Eligibility:

- Candidates who possess Degree or Diploma in **Electrical/ Mechanical/ Electrical & Electronics Engineering** from a recognized institute are eligible for Graduate / Diploma Apprenticeship Training.

- The engagement as apprentice will be purely for training for the period as specified above and will be terminated on completion. The engagement as apprentice is only temporary and shall not lead to absorption. The Electricity Department does not give any commitment on providing permanent/temporary employment to apprentices on successful completion of training period.
- During the period under apprenticeship training the trainee will be attached to any of the Power House/T&D Sub-Division/Workshop at different island of the Electricity Department and will be under Administrative control of the Superintending Engineer, Electricity Department.
