He suggested that to save time, such bigger and better vehicle ferry vessels can be brought to Andaman on wet lease for next four to five years.

The Member of Parliament mentioned that bigger vehicle ferry vessels will

Extension of Shibpur Airport at Diglipur to be completed in a time bound manner:

To boost the connectivity of North and Middle Andaman, they mentioned it is extremely important to extend the runway of the airport at Shibpur, in Diglipur. The extension of these runways is important for

Training on Organic Vegetable Production and Seed Distribution in NICRA-Adopted Areas

Port Blair, Jan 05: ICAR-KVK, CIARI, Port Blair organized training on organic vegetable production on 04.01.2023 at chouldari panchayat. Dr. Y Ramakrishna, Principal Scientist and Head, briefed on the negative impacts of indiscriminate use of agrochemicals in farming systems, which create bad effects on soil diversity, depletion of soil organic matter, physiological disturbance, poor water use efficiency, and contamination of soil, food and water bodies in our fragile ecosystem. Dr. N.Bommayasamy, SMS (Agro./Agrl.Extn.) emphasizes the significance of organic farming and its long-term fertility of soil by maintaining organic carbon lev-



els, ways of enhancing soil biological activities, achieving nitrogen self-sufficiency through intercropping of leguminous vegetables, biological nitrogen fixation, and effectively utilizing cow urine and cow dung for the preparation of liquid organic manure and supplementary nutrients through the use of bio-fertilizers. Dr. B.K. Nanda, SMS (Agrl.Engg.), and Dr. Pooja Kapoor, SMS (Home Science) also spoke on efficient water management

methods in post-rainy season vegetables, as well as the value of vegetable consumption in daily life. As part of the programme, fifteen farmers and farm women from NICRA adopted villages received vegetable seeds, including tomato (Arkasamrat, ArkaRakshak), chili (Arkatejasri, ArkaKyatiri), French bean (Arka Komal, Arka Sharath), bottle gourd (Co-1), long yard bean (Arka Mangala), and cucumber (Arka Veera).

Ukraine military says killed 800 Russian soldiers in past day

Ukraine's military estimated on Thursday that 800 Russian soldiers were killed in the past day, mostly in fighting in the eastern Donetsk region, while Western allies pledged supplies of armoured battle vehicles but not the tanks Ukraine wants. Giving its regular morning roundup of the fighting, Ukraine's military said Russian forces were focused on an offensive in the Bakhmut sector and its attacks in the Avdiivka and Kupiansk sectors were unsuccessful.

It said more than 800 Russian soldiers, one aircraft, a helicopter and three tanks were destroyed over the past day.

It also reported an unspecified number of civilian casualties as a result of Russian air, missile and rocket attacks on the largely ruined, Ukrainian-held city of Bakhmut and two other cities in the Donetsk region - Kostiantynivka and Kurakhove. Russia denies targeting civilians in what



it calls its "special military operation" in Ukraine.

Reuters could not independently verify battlefield accounts. A senior U.S. administration official on Wednesday gave a sobering assessment of fighting in the Donetsk region, especially around Bakhmut.

"The fighting is still quite hot ... what we're seeing in Bakhmut we should expect to see elsewhere along the front that there will be continued fighting in the coming months," the official said.

In his evening video address, President Volodymyr Zelenskiy said Ukrainian troops outside Bakhmut

were inflicting numerous losses on their adversaries and Russia was building up its forces in the region.

Ukrainian Deputy Defence Minister Hanna Malyar, citing his ministry's main intelligence directorate, wrote on the Telegram app that significant losses for Russia meant it would likely have to announce a another partial mobilisation in the first quarter of the year. According to Yegeny Balitsky, the governor of the Russian held Zaporizhzhia region, Ukrainian artillery killed five people and wounded 15 including four emergency workers, Russia's TASS news agency reported.

Germany to require rapid Covid test for travelers from China



Germany is changing its entry rules for travellers from China and will in future require at least a rapid coronavirus test to enter the country, Health Minister Karl Lauterbach said on Thursday. There will also be random checks upon entry for any coronavirus variants as well as expanded monitoring of wastewater, he said in a statement.

The steps are in line with recommendations by European Union government officials released on Wednesday evening.

"Europe has found a joint response to the pandemic situation in China. This is precisely what we as the federal government have been working towards," said Lauterbach.

China plans to ease travel restrictions on Sunday, despite a wave of new infections which has left Chinese hospitals and funeral houses overwhelmed. Officials at the Frankfurt airport have already been monitoring wastewater, a health ministry spokesperson said on Wednesday.

Vaccine for honeybees approved for use in US, a world's first: Report



World's first vaccine for honeybees was approved for use by the United States, a report said. The vaccines helps to protect bees from the American Foulbrood disease, a report by the Business Wire said adding that a conditional license by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has been granted to American biotech company Dalan Animal Health Inc for making the vaccine. The American Foulbrood disease, for which the vaccine has been made, is caused by the bacterium *Paenibacillus larvae* which can weaken and kill hives. The deadly disease originated in the US but has now spread globally. The vaccine contains killed whole-cell *Paenibacillus larvae* bacteria and will be administered

by mixing it into the queen feed which is consumed by the worker bees, the report said adding that the vaccine is incorporated into the royal jelly by the worker bees. They will then feed it to the queen completing the process while the queen ingests it and fragments of the vaccine are deposited in her ovaries. Chief executive officer of Dalan Animal Health Dr Anette Kleiser called the vaccine a breakthrough saying, "We are committed to providing innovative solutions to protect our pollinators and promote sustainable agriculture. Global population growth and changing climates will increase the importance of honeybee pollination to secure our food supply," Dr Kleiser added.

not only save precious time for residents of South Andaman but also make life easy for commuters of Bambooflat and Port Blair route.

In a letter addressed to the Lt. Governor of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, he pointed out that everyday more than 20,000 people from South Andaman region viz Port Blair, Bambooflat, Wimberlygunj, Shorepoint, Stewardgunj, Mathura, Mannarghat, Wright Myo, Shoal Bay etc commute through vehicle ferry vessels.

He mentioned that to handle the rush, time and again we have seen many

restrictions on people and vehicles in Vehicle Ferry Vessels.

He added that such restrictions are not the right solution to the actual problem, which is shortage of sufficient number of vehicle ferry vessels and absence of bigger vehicle ferry vessels.

He pointed out that although there is a move from the side of the Government of India to construct a bridge between Chatham and Bambooflat but the date of starting of the project and completion of the bridge is yet not known.

Hence, he mentioned that in the next four to five years commuters of Bambooflat and Chatham

have to rely solely on the present fleet of vehicle ferry vessels for reaching either side for job, school, medical etc other purposes, even if the said bridge construction works begin anywhere soon.

He pointed out that the present fleet of vehicle ferry vessels are not only unbelievably old but also are very small in size and are terribly slow.

The Member of Parliament added that in this modern age we have multi-level vehicle ferry vessels, which can accommodate a large number of two wheelers, four wheelers and heavy vehicles along with hundreds of passengers.

farmers of the village as well as for the reptile itself.

As per report, a crocodile was spotted in the nallah in Madhupur village about two months ago and which is still there posing threat to the village farmers and the residents.

Talking to Andaman Sheekha, Mr. Kamal Halder, a farmer of the village said that, since they need to irrigate their crops during this dry season, they have to set pumps in the nallah. But, it is dangerous to set the pump & hose pipe in the nallah as the croc may pounce on them at any time thereby taking their life. Besides, the vegetables like radish, sweet potato etc. are washed before taking them to bazaar for sale, but these farmers are in trepidation if the croc attack them while cleaning them in the nallah water, they rued.

When Andaman Sheekha team contacted the Forest Officials to know more details on the matter, the concerned Officials of the Forest Dept. said that they are seized of the situation thrown by crocodile's presence in some pocket of a nallah in Madhupur village. Taking a precautionary measure, the staffs of the Forest Dept. placed two cages in



the water bodies to catch the reptile and relocate it to its natural habitat.

However, the Forest Dept. hasn't been successful in capturing the croc as yet, and as a result concerns are growing in the region; while offering suggestions, the villagers said that a live bait in the cage will reportedly work and the reptile may be easily trapped in the cage placed by Forest Staff. The residents also urged the Forest Dept. to capture and relocate the crocodile as soon as possible thereby safeguarding their lives.

Elaborating on the crocodile's behavior, the Forest Officials further said that during mating season, these ancient animals can be vicious fighters as they compete to secure available females and territory. They may come away from the

battle with missing legs or blinded eyes. And during this period, the defeated males take shelter to places away from their natural habitat; and this may be one of the reasons why because this crocodile has taken shelter in the nallah which flows through human habitation. On the other hand, the croc has been compromising with its food/prey as well since the day it deserted its territory, and it is not also a healthy sign for the displaced croc, the officials disclosed.

However, since the crocodile's presence in a nallah in human habitation is undesirable, they are trying their level best to capture the croc and relocate the reptile to its natural habitat so as to eliminate the impending danger being posed by the croc, they further said.

Britain at a halt amid worst day of train strikes, no service at some stations

Some of London's biggest railway stations will be shut on Thursday while airports such as Gatwick are also deprived of any train services, as strikes on the network reach a critical peak.

Commuter services into the capital run by Thameslink, Southern and Southeastern will come to a complete halt. Train drivers represented by the Aslef union are walking out following a long dispute over pay.

The walkout comes in the middle of four days of separate strikes held by the RMT, another labor group. While the RMT is not technically on strike Thursday, services will be crippled by Aslef's industrial action.

The effect will be more severe than on the days affected by the RMT's strikes. London Bridge, Victoria and City Thameslink will have no services at all. There will be no services on the West Coast main line which connects London to

Birmingham, Manchester and Glasgow.

Some rail operators will run a heavily reduced service, such as Great Western Rail which will provide one hourly train into Paddington. That is compared with four hourly trains on previous RMT strike days. Travelers to and from Gatwick airport will have to make their way by coach or car. However, most of the hub's coach services run by National Express Group Plc have already sold out. Neither will there be any trains to Luton airport.

Bus services in west and south London will be disrupted as a strike by Abellio workers continues into its second day.

Aslef recently re-baloted members and now has a mandate to take further strike action up until June. Talks between union bosses, ministers and train company executives are expected to resume at the start of next week.
