

## PM's 'Mann Ki Baat' prog. over AIR PM exudes pride over Indian youth setting new records from Start-Ups to Sports World

New Delhi, June 26

Addressing the nation in his Mann Ki Baat programme on All India Radio, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi highlighted that in the past few years, many big feats related to the space sector have been accomplished in the country. One of these achievements has been the creation of an agency named In-Space. He said, this agency is promoting new opportunities in the space sector for the private sector of India. He pointed out that this beginning has especially attracted the youth of the country.

The Prime Minister took pride in the fact that the number of startups in the space sector amounts to more than a hundred. Until a few years ago in the country, no

one even thought about startups in the space sector. He said, all these start-ups are working on ideas, which were either not thought about earlier, or were considered impossible for the private sector. Shri Modi cited the example of two startups in Chennai and Hyderabad - Agnikul and

Skyroot! These start-ups are developing launch vehicles that will take small payloads into space. Through this, the cost of Space Launching is estimated to come down significantly. Similarly, he took the name of Dhruva Space, another Start-Up of Hyderabad. It is working on

High Technology Solar Panels for Satellite Deployer and Satellites. He spoke about Tanveer Ahmed of Digantara, which is another space start-up who is trying to map waste in space. Both Digantara and Dhruva Space are going to make their first launch from ISRO's launch vehicle on the 30<sup>th</sup> of June.

The Prime Minister mentioned Neha, the founder of Astrome, a space start-up based in Bangalore. This start-up is making flat antennas which will not only be small, but their cost will also be very low. He said, demand for this technology can be all over the world. Shri Modi also gave the example of Tanvi Patel, who is a school student of Mehsana. She is

Union Health Minister, Dr Mansukh Mandavia said, the Centre will roll out the "One Nation, One Dialysis" programme to help patients undergoing dialysis get the procedure done anywhere in the country at any time. Dr Mansukh Mandavia participated in the cycle rally organised by the National Health Mission on the iconic Marina Beach this morning. Later, he inspected the Tamil Nadu Government Multi-Specialty Hospital in the city.



He inspected the robotic surgery facility and the early pregnancy anomalies screening centre in the hospital. He also laid the foundation stone for the Central Government Health Scheme wellness centre at Avadi, a Chennai suburb, through video conferencing. During his

interaction with the Central and State health officials, the Minister said, the Centre is aiming at making the nation malaria-free by the year 2030.

The Health Minister also visited the Indian Council for Medical Research laboratory called the National Institute of

Tuberculosis in Chennai. He said around fifty thousand people suffer from the disease in the State, and added that the TB patient/village adoption scheme called Nikshay Mitra Abhiyan has evoked only partial response. He appealed to all to join hands to overcome TB which he said is a hurdle against the nation's progress. The Ministry of Home Affairs under the guidance of the Union Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah is committed to achieving the conviction rate of up to 90% and providing a citizen friendly and effective criminal justice system in the country.

Shri Amit Shah stressed on the need for investigating agencies to be one step ahead of criminals in view of the use of technology by them and said that the Modi Government in collaboration with the State Governments is working on a three pronged approach to reforms in Police Investigation, Prosecution and Forensics. He said that this is the right time to focus on technology based and evidence based investigation to achieve the targeted conviction rate.

Shri Shah emphasized on capacity building of constables upto high level police personnel in use of advanced testing techniques. He called for the establishment of an independent Directorate of Prosecution and an independent Directorate of Forensic Science in each State/UT through the proposed comprehensive amendments to the Indian Penal Code, Criminal Procedure Code and the Indian Evidence Act. Shri Shah said that the Modi Government is also working towards making forensic investigation mandatory in all cases of offenses punishable with imprisonment for more than 6 years.

The Union Home Minister briefed the members of the Committee about the steps taken by the Central Government towards capacity building required to implement the proposed reforms. He said that the National Defense University has been established for training manpower of law enforcement agencies to train them in the use of new technology to combat crime, especially cyber crime, dark-net etc. Apart from this, hackathons are also being organized to attract the expertise and innovation of the youth in new technologies. The National Forensic Science University has been established to provide trained manpower for the forensic sector and the Central Government has requested the States to affiliate at least one college in each State with NFSU. Shri Shah said that a Modus Operandi Bureau has also been set up to identify the pattern of crime for prevention of crime.

Shri Amit Shah informed the members that the Central Government is providing funds to strengthen the forensic infrastructure across the country including setting up of Mobile Forensic Science Units in each district, and these units will serve at least three blocks in a district. He said that steps are also being taken to standardize forensic equipment, instrument calibration, Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) in all FSLs in the country for high quality forensic results.

COVID cases have been recorded in the last 24 hours. Currently, India's active caseload stands at over 92 thousand and recovery at 98.58 per cent. 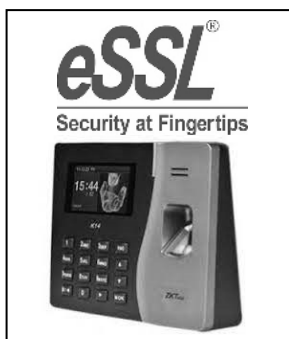
