attaches utmost importance to the internal and external security of the country and is committed to public welfare by strengthening the systems for crime detection and prevention and effective law enforcement. The Ministry of Home Affairs under the guidance of the Union Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah is committed to achieving the conviction rate of up to 90% and providing a citizen friendly and effective criminal justice system in the

Shri Amit Shah stressed on the need ahead of criminals in view of the use of technology by them and said that the Modi Government in collaboration with the State Governments is working on a three pronged approach to reforms in Police Investigation, Prosecution and Forensics. He said that this is the right time to focus on technology based and evidence based investigation to achieve the targeted conviction rate.

Shri Shah emphasized on capacity police personnel in use of advanced testing techniques. He called for the establishment Prosecution and an independent Directorate of Forensic Science in each State/UT amendments to the Indian Penal Code, Criminal Procedure Code and the Indian Evidence Act. Shri Shah said that the Modi Government is also working towards making forensic investigation mandatory in all cases of offenses punishable with imprisonment for more than 6 years.

The Union Home Minister briefed the members of the Committee about the steps taken by the Central Government towards capacity building required to implement the proposed reforms. 
