

Cabinet approves establishment of WHO Global Centre for Traditional Medicine in India

Traditional medicine is a key pillar of health care delivery systems and plays a crucial role in maintaining good health and well-being

New Delhi, Mar. 9 (PIB) The Union Cabinet, chaired by Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has approved the establishment of the WHO Global Centre for Traditional Medicine (WHO GCTM) in Jamnagar, Gujarat by signing a Host Country agreement between the Government of India and the World Health Organization (WHO). The WHO

GCTM will be established in 13th November, 2020 in the august presence of the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India. The Hon'ble Prime Minister praised this initiative of WHO and mentioned that WHO GCTM would emerge as a centre of global wellness, bolster evidence-based research, establishment of training and awareness for Traditional

Medicine. A Joint Task Force (JTF) has been constituted for coordination, execution and monitoring of activities for the establishment of this Centre. JTF comprises representatives from the Government of India, Permanent Mission of India, Geneva and the World Health Organization. Under the ambit of this, an interim office is being established at the ITRA, Jamnagar, Gujarat to execute the identified technical activities and planning of WHO GCTM. The interim office is intended to deliver broadly on generation of evidence and innovation, artificial intelligence based solutions for traditional medicine, systematic reviews in collaboration with Cochrane, Global survey on traditional medicine data across WHO GPW 13 (Thirteenth General Programme of Work 2019-2023) and sustainable development goals, the identified

This year amid COVID-19 pandemic, National De-worming Programme, 2022 (February Round) will be implemented from March 10 to April 15, 2022 in A&N Islands.

PWM Rules 2016 (as amended) prohibits production, stocking, distribution, sale & use of single use plastic items

- ❖ Ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice cream sticks, polystyrene (Thermocol) for decoration, plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers will be prohibited from 1st July, 2022
- ❖ Selling as well as display/advertisement of Single Use Plastic (SUP) items on all E-Commerce website will also be prohibited with effect from June 30, 2022

Port Blair, Mar. 9 The Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change has issued notification G. S. R No.571 (E) dated 12th August, 2021 as Plastic Waste Management (Amendment) Rules-2021.As per Rule 4(2) of PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended), the manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of following single use plastic (SUP), including polystyrene and expanded polystyrene, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers will also be prohibited. As per Rule 4(1) of PWM rules, 2016 (as amended), carry bag made of virgin or recycled plastic shall not be less than seventy-five (75) microns in thickness with effect from 30th September, 2021 and one hundred twenty (120) microns in thickness with effect from 31st December, 2022. Further, as per the A&N Administration vide Notification No.186 dated 05.09.2019, condiments, etc.), <15 mL (or equivalent in weight) and single use, plastic bodied transportation, use & throw pens. Similarly, as per the A&N Administration vide Notification No.225 dated 24.09.2019, the use, manufacture and sale of plastic carry bags irrespective of its thickness, size, color and nature is banned in A&N Islands. All Producers, Stockiest, Retailers, Shopkeepers, E-conditioners and similar personal care items, mouth-fresheners, pickle/jam/sauces, spices, (Contd. on last page)

The WHO GCTM would provide leadership on all global health matters related to traditional medicine as well as extend support to member countries in shaping various policies related to traditional medicine research, practices and public health.

The Ministry of AYUSH has collaborated with WHO on many fronts including developing benchmarks documents on training and practice of Ayurveda and Unani System, introducing a second module in the Traditional Medicine Chapter of the International Classification of Diseases-11, developing apps like M-yoga, supporting the work of International Pharmacopeia of Herbal Medicine (IPHM) and other research studies etc.

commerce Companies, Street Vendors, Commercial Establishments (Malls/ Marketplace/ Shopping Centers/ Cinema Houses/ Tourist Locations/ Schools/ Colleges/ Office Complexes/ Hospitals & other Institutions) and general public have been informed to stop production, stocking, distribution, sale and usage of identified SUP items as per the timelines specified in the said MoEF&CC Notification. Further, necessary action is to be taken by the concerned entities to ensure zero inventories of the aforementioned SUP items by June 30, 2022.

Selling as well as display/advertisement of Single Use Plastic (SUP) items on all E-Commerce website will also be prohibited with effect from June 30, 2022.

Action, as deemed fit under Environment Protection Act, 1986 including seizure of goods, closure of operations of Industries/Commercial Establishments and in case of non-compliance of above Environmental Compensation as per the Guidelines issued by Central Pollution Control Board of Rs.5,000/- per ton shall be levied against the violators of the said Notification, a press release from Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee said.

Coast Guard rescues private vessel off Little Andaman

Port Blair, Mar. 9

The Coast Guard component of HQ Andaman and Nicobar Command undertook Search and Rescue operation of MFV Sri Lalitha, which was drifting 18 NM from Little Andaman Island due to a defective engine. The boat had sailed out from Junglighat on March 2 with 6 crew onboard for fishing. MFV Sri Lalitha reported the distress to Coast Guard on March 5 using Distress Alert Transmitter (DAT). On receipt of DAT alert, HQ A&N Command directed Coast Guard Ship C-146 for assistance. As the defect could not be rectified at sea due to non availability of spares on board the fishing boat, the boat was towed by Coast Guard Ship to Hutbay harbour on March 6. All the crew returned safely due to timely and swift action by Coast Guard. HQ Andaman and Nicobar Command is committed towards ensuring safety of life and property at sea around A&N Islands, a press release from HQ ANC said.

Scientists develop energy-efficient hydrogen production by urea electrolysis

New Delhi, Mar. 9

Indian Scientists have designed an electrocatalyst system for energy-efficient hydrogen production with the help of electrolysis of urea. The urea electrolysis is helpful towards urea-based waste treatment with low-cost hydrogen production. This can be utilized for energy production towards our country's benefits.

The energy requirement for production of hydrogen through water electrolysis can be reduced by 70 %

through urea electrolysis. The energy-intensive counterpart of water splitting, oxygen evolution, can be replaced with urea oxidation in urea electrolysis.

The low-cost, earth-abundant Ni-based catalysts are widely applied for this process. The main challenge associated with urea oxidation is retaining the prolonged activity of the catalyst as the strong adsorption of the reactive intermediate (COx) on the active site, referred to as

catalyst poisoning, causes activity loss. The urea electrolysis is helpful towards urea-based waste treatment with low-cost hydrogen production. India is one of the top countries by urea production, and it produced 244.55 LMT of urea during 2019-20.

The nitrogenous fertilizer industries generate a high concentration of ammonia and urea as effluents. This can be utilized for energy production towards our country's benefits.

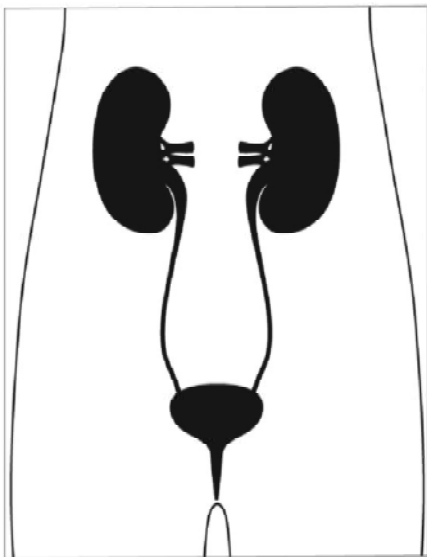

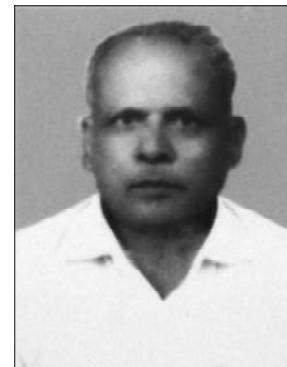
