The day marks the anniversary of Louis Pasteur's death, the French chemist and microbiologist, who developed the first rabies vaccine. This day is celebrated to raise awareness about the impact of rabies on humans and animals, provide information and advice on how to prevent the disease and take efforts to control rabies. The theme for World Rabies Day 2021 is "Rabies: Facts, not Fear". World Rabies Day is a day of activism



and awareness. It is an opportunity for us to join the global movement to put an end to suffering caused due to rabies by organizing or taking part in a World Rabies Day event.

Rabies is 99.9% fatal, but is also 100% preventable. Eliminating the disease by vaccinating dogs protects them and stops transmission to people. We can continue to maintain this position in future by maintaining strict quarantine and disease surveillance. It is essential for the veterinary professionals to increase awareness of rabies prevention and control in communities including education and information on responsible pet ownership, about the benefits of rabies vaccination for animals, humans, and public health.





theme of the use of technology in health, the Prime Minister said that there has also been an unprecedented expansion of telemedicine during the Corona period, so far about 125 crores, remote consultations have been completed through e-Sanjeevani. This facility is connecting thousands of countrymen living in far-flung parts of the country every day with doctors of big hospitals of cities while sitting at home, said the Prime Minister.

The Prime Minister remarked that Avushman Bharat-PMJAY has addressed a key headache in the lives of the poor. So far more than 2 crore countrymen have availed the facility of free treatment under this scheme, half of which are women. The Prime Minister emphasized that diseases are one of the key reasons to push families into the vicious cycle of poverty and women of the families are the worst sufferers as they always relegate their health issues to the background. POCSO Court Mayabunder convicts ...

POCSO Act was registered in the Police Station, Diglipur vide FIR No. 39 of 2020 on the basis of written complaint lodged by the victim girl. This is a custodial trial case wherein the prosecution has sufficiently proved that the accused person who was already married with four children has committed the offence under section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 for committing aggravated sexual assault upon an innocent unfortunate minor girl aged about sixteen years.

For the rehabilitation of victim girl, an amount of Rs.5,00,000/- has been awarded as compensation as per provision of 357A of Cr.P.C from Victim Compensation Fund. The entire case was investigated by SI Tamil Arasan under the guidance of Inspector Pritam Behari, former SHO, PS Diglipur for which the Hon'ble Court has appreciated them for the investigation. The prosecution case was conducted by Shri. Keshab Chandra Mondal, learned Special Public Prosecutor (POCSO Act), Mayabunder, a press release received here said.
