New Delhi, Sept. 27 (PIB)

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today launched the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission through a video conference. Speaking on the occasion, the Prime Minister said that the campaign of strengthening health facilities that have been going for the last seven years is entering a new phase today. "Today we are launching a mission that has the potential of bringing a revolutionary change in India's health facilities", said the Prime Minister.



The Prime Minister underlined the fact that with 130 crore Aadhaar numbers, 118 crore mobile subscribers, about 80 crore internet users, about 43 crore Jan Dhan bank accounts, there is no such big c o n n e c t e d

infrastructure anywhere in the world. This digital infrastructure is bringing everything from ration to administration (Ration to Prashasan) to the common Indian in a fast and transparent

manner. "The way technology is being deployed in governance reforms today is unprecedented", said the Prime Minister. The Prime Minister remarked that the Arogya Setu app helped a lot in preventing the

Rabies is 99.9% fatal, but is also 100% preventable. Eliminating the disease by vaccinating dogs protects them and stops transmission to people. It is significant here to mention that Andaman and Nicobar Islands is the only region in the India which is still free from the disease. We can continue to maintain this position in future by maintaining strict quarantine and disease surveillance. It is essential for the veterinary professionals to increase awareness of rabies prevention and control in communities including education and information on responsible pet ownership, about the benefits of rabies vaccination for animals, humans, and public health.

The Ministry of Labour & Employment, New Delhi has launched a registration module/portal i.e. e-SHRAM on 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 for creation of a comprehensive National Database of Unorganised Workers (NDUW) for all types of Unorganised Workers such as Construction Workers, Migrant Workers, Domestic Workers, Agricultural Labourers, MGNREGA Workers, Gig Workers, Self-employed Workers, Street Vendors, Small Shopkeeper, ASHA Workers, Anganwadi Workers, Fishermen, Unorganised Plantation Workers, Milkmen and similar other sub-group of Unorganised Workers.

Any worker who is working in Unorganised Sector and aged between 16 - 59 is eligible to register on the e-SHRAM portal. "Unorganised Worker"



means a home-based worker, self-employed worker, self-employed worker or a wage worker in the unorganised sector and it also includes a worker in the organized Sector who is not a member of

ESIC/EPFO/Govt. Employees. An Unorganised worker shall be required to have their Aadhaar Number, Mobile Number and Bank Account Number along with IFSC Code

while registering on the e-SHRAM portal.

Port Blair, Sept. 27 The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 581 passengers who arrived here yesterday, one positive case has been detected. Today, 8 flights with 1146 passengers arrived and

the RT-PCR test was conducted on 653 and the reports are awaited. He further said that RAT was conducted on 151 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and all were found negative. Apart from this, 180 passengers travelling to & fro to Shaheed/Swaraj Dweep were tested at Phoenix Bay Jetty and all were

found negative. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 160 passengers and all were found negative. At helipad, test was conducted on 4 passengers and all were found negative. (Contd. on last page)

## POCSO Court Mayabunder convicts one for life imprisonment

Mayabunder, Sept. 27 The Hon'ble Special Court under POCSO Act, Mayabunder has convicted one accused person namely Basudev Ram, R/o Radhanagar, PS Diglipur and sentenced him to undergo rigorous imprisonment for life for the offence punishable under section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 and also to pay fine of Rs.2,00,000/-, out of which, 90 percent amount is to be paid to

the victim girl as compensation u/s. 357 of Cr.P.C, in default of payment, the convict will have to undergo rigorous imprisonment for one more year. The judgement was passed by Shri. Jimut Bahan Biswas, Hon'ble Additional Sessions Judge -cum- Special Judge under POCSO Act, North & Middle Andaman District, Mayabunder.


## Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 4,37,706 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far

Port Blair, Sept.27 The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, 4,37,706 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands. Meanwhile, a total of 1636 people were vaccinated today in Isles.

1116 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 304 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 264 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 33 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44.

256 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 13 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. A total of 1,69,979 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

## Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

### Time to utilize the local Kau phal (Garcinia cowa)

Cowa mangosteen or kau phal is a member of mangosteen family distributed naturally in our islands besides its natural distribution in North East India. It is a tropical tree species bearing attractive orange fruits with furrowed peel. Pulp is also orange in colour and is relished by the local masses during summer season to combat the heat. Fruits have laxative property and young leaves are sometimes eaten as vegetables by some ethnic groups in the islands. Trees grow straight and bear profusely under island conditions. Fruits are source of pharmaceutically valued hydroxycitric acid apart from vitamin A and C. Studies at ICAR-CIARI have suggested that rind could be easily dehydrated and used for flavouring of curries. Trees of kau phal are commonly seen in the backyards and under semi-wild condition in the North and Middle Andaman islands. Unfortunately, the trees being straight are among the locally preferred species for construction of huts etc. and hence, their conservation is desirable. Planting material of kau phal is available at Horticultural Plants Propagation Unit of ICAR-CIARI and the interested farmers could procure and conserve this multipurpose tree in their farm.

**Benefit:** Seasonal produce, which is presently underutilized, could be pooled and processed at farm level, thereby serving as an additional source of income for the island farmers.

theme of the use of technology in health, the Prime Minister said that there has also been an unprecedented expansion of telemedicine during the Corona period, so far about 125 crores, remote consultations have been completed through e-Sanjeevani. This facility is connecting thousands of countrymen living in far-flung parts of the country every day with doctors of big hospitals of cities while sitting at home, said the Prime Minister.

The Prime Minister remarked that Ayushman Bharat-PMJAY has addressed a key headache in the lives of the poor. So far more than 2 crore countrymen have availed the facility of free treatment under this scheme, half of which are women. The Prime Minister emphasized that diseases are one of the key reasons to push families into the vicious cycle of poverty and women of the families are the worst sufferers as they always relegate their health issues to the background. Shri Modi said that he has made it a point to personally meet some beneficiaries of Ayushman and he has experienced the benefits of the scheme during the interactions. He said, "these healthcare solutions are a big investment in the present and future of the country."

The Prime Minister said Ayushman Bharat - Digital Mission, will now connect the digital health solutions of hospitals across the country with each other. The Mission will not only make the processes of hospitals simplified but also will increase ease of living, he added. Under this, every citizen will now get a digital health ID and their health record will be digitally protected.

The Prime Minister informed that India is working on a health model that is holistic and inclusive. A model which stresses preventive healthcare and, in case of disease, easy, affordable and accessible treatment. He also discussed unprecedented reforms in health education and said a much larger number of doctors and para medical manpower is being created in India now as compared to 7-8 years ago. A comprehensive network of AIIMS and other modern health institutions is being established in the country and work on establishing one medical college in every three Lok Sabha constituencies is going on. He also talked about strengthening health facilities in villages and informed that in the villages, primary health centre networks and wellness centres are being strengthened. More than 80 thousand such centres have already been operationalized, said the Prime Minister.

Noting that today's program is being organized on World Tourism Day, the Prime Minister remarked that health has a very strong relationship with tourism. Because when our health infrastructure is integrated, strengthened, it also improves the tourism sector.

POCSO Act was registered in the Police Station, Diglipur vide FIR No. 39 of 2020 on the basis of written complaint lodged by the victim girl. This is a custodial trial case wherein the prosecution has sufficiently proved that the accused person who was already married with four children has committed the offence under section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 for committing aggravated sexual assault upon an innocent unfortunate minor girl aged about sixteen years.

For the rehabilitation of victim girl, an amount of Rs.5,00,000/- has been awarded as compensation as per provision of 357A of Cr.P.C from Victim Compensation Fund. The entire case was investigated by SI Tamil Arasan under the guidance of Inspector Pritam Behari, former SHO, PS Diglipur for which the Hon'ble Court has appreciated them for the investigation. The prosecution case was conducted by Shri. Keshab Chandra Mondal, learned Special Public Prosecutor (POCSO Act), Mayabunder, a press release received here said.

Rule 130 of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Land Revenue and Land Reforms Rules, 1968 (hereinafter called Principal Rules) shall be substituted as under: "The village field map shall be prepared by the Settlement Officer during revenue survey operations using Chain/Electronic Total Station/Drone or such other devices as may be specified by Settlement Commissioner".

3. (i) Rule 132 of the Principal Rules shall be substituted as under:

"The Record of Rights shall be prepared in Form F for each village both urban and non-urban and shall be issued alongwith corresponding map, QR Code capturing village name, survey numbers, total area and name of the tenants."

- The Form 'F' prescribed under Rule 132 of the Principal Rules shall be substituted as appended herewith.






