Continuing his untiring efforts to manage the power situation in the Islands, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri. Jitendra Narain directed teams consisting of senior officers of Revenue, Police and Power Departments to conduct surprise inspections continuously at major energy guzzling establishments which are suspected to have electricity thefts. The task forces inspected few crusher units and hotels in Brichgunj area and other adjoining areas in Port Blair to



ascertain their technical parameters, power demand and to check the connected load, peak demand and consumption. Power theft was reported in one crusher unit & one hotel. The crusher unit was involved in electricity theft of approximately 8000 units per month. The FIR of such thefts will be lodged as per penal provisions of Electricity Act 2003. It is pertinent to mention that A&N Administration provides 70% -90% subsidies to electricity consumers. In view of that, electricity theft must be dealt sternly as it is a serious crime with massive financial implications.

In a continuous endeavour to resolve power disruptions, several teams consisting of officials of Power Department, APWD, Forest and Fire Department have been mobilized. These multi departmental teams with about 243 staffs have fanned in the 21 areas in South Andaman district. These teams have continuously worked on line clearance and pruning of dangerous trees to create safe corridor for electricity feeder lines. On 26th May, over 37 kilometers of feeder lines were provided with safe corridor so that frequent power disruption and electricity faults are prevented.

Electricity feeders in Bambooflat, Ograbraj, Ferrargunj were focused on in the last two days. These safe corridors for electricity will minimize short circuits & trippings of power cables.

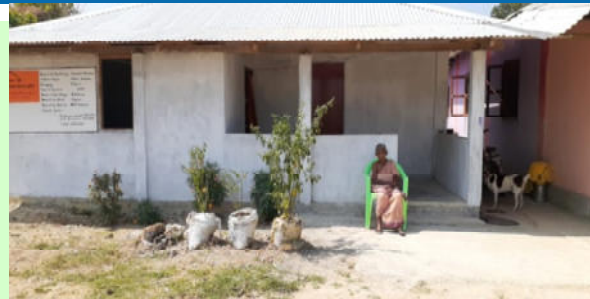
The Power Department, A&N Administration has taken a decision to issue strict warning to all the major electricity consumers to use power judiciously and meet their power requirement during peak hours by using DG Sets to mitigate the power crisis. The incidents of damage to electricity lines and theft of electricity will be viewed seriously

and strict action will be taken as per the penal provisions of the Electricity Act 2003, Electricity Supply Act, and Indian Penal Code.

rural housing program and in view of Government's commitment to providing "Housing for All" by 2022, the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana -Gramin (PMAY-G) was launched w.e.f. 1st April 2016. PMAY-G aims at providing a pucca house, with basic amenities, to all houseless households and those households living in kutcha and dilapidated houses, by 2022. The minimum 25 sq.mt size of the house with a hygienic cooking space is provided under the scheme. The unit assistance of Rs. 1.20 lakh in plain and Rs 1.30 lakh in hilly states, difficult areas and IAP districts is provided for construction of a house. The beneficiary is entitled for 90 to 95 person day of unskilled labour from Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS). The assistance for the construction of the toilet is leveraged through convergence with SBM-G, MGNREGS or any other dedicated source of funding. Convergence for piped drinking water, electricity connection, LPG gas connection etc. different Government programmes are also attempted.

To ensure that assistance is targeted at those who are genuinely deprived and that the selection is objective and verifiable, PMAY-G instead of selecting the beneficiary from among the BPL households, selects beneficiary using housing deprivation parameters in the Socio-Economic and Caste Census (SECC), 2011 which is to be verified by the Gram Sabhas. Using the SECC data, households that are houseless and living in 0, 1 and 2 kutcha wall and kutcha roof houses are segregated as well as targeted and the Permanent Wait List is generated.

In Andaman & Nicobar Islands, a pucca house with basic amenities inclusive of hygienic cooking space for the houseless is provided under PMAY-G with the financial assistance of Rs.1.2 lakh which is released in three (3) instalments of Rs.60000/-, Rs.40000/- and Rs.20000/- .Along with that,90 person days of unskilled labour wage amounting to Rs. 24,030/- through convergence with Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) is also provided. Additionally, an incentive of Rs. 12,000 for the construction of toilets through convergence with Swachh Bharat Mission - Gramin (SBM-G) is also provided to the beneficiaries. Other assistance such as piped drinking water, electricity connection, LPG gas connection, etc is also provided with the support of the Line Departments.

The UT Administration has also provided land measuring 50sqm to 651 landless beneficiaries out of which 463 beneficiaries have completed the construction of their houses.

Against the approved target of 1247 houses, the Department has completed the construction of 1160 houses till now. The remaining 87 beneficiaries who have been provided instalments under PMAY-G, are in various stages of construction of their houses.

It has been noticed that there has been a huge boost in the feeling of social status, self-worth, confidence level, feeling of ownership, feeling of safety & security, self-perceived improvement in health, overall quality of life and satisfaction after the construction of new houses of the beneficiaries. The beneficiaries have expressed their gratitude towards the Administration for helping them construct their dream houses.

The Department of Rural Development is of the firm belief that the housing scheme is playing a critical role in fostering the health and well-being of people in the rural areas while ensuring safe and secure habitats for women and children. To this effect, this drive has been undertaken on a mission mode to expedite the process of construction of houses in a well-planned manner. Setting off a virtuous cycle of economic activity and hygienic dwelling for the underserved in the rural areas, the PMAY-G certainly is a panacea for a bulk of problems in the rural areas of our Union Territory, a press release from Secretary (RD) said.

robust monitoring as well as intervention infrastructure. The target of the Mission is to bring down stunting, wasting, underweight among children in the age group of 0-6 years from 2%.



To tackle the menace of malnutrition, the nutritional status of individual children of age 0-6 years is being tracked every month. The name based report of malnourished children is generated from the ICDS-CAS portal on monthly basis and thereafter, individual tracking is being done for affected children.

The Social Welfare Department is conducting growth monitoring of children below the age of 6 years, pregnant and lactating mothers in Anganwadi Centres by measuring the height, weight of children to ascertain their current nutritional status. To facilitate the same, all Anganwadi Centres are equipped with Growth Monitoring Devices (Infantometer, Stadiometer, Weighing Scale (Mother & Child), Weighing Scale (Infant) etc.

Besides, training is imparted to all Field Functionaries through incremental learning approach in 21 modules to focus the physical and emotional development of children, especially the first thousand days from the birth.

Further, all Anganwadi functionaries are provided with Smart Phones for uploading data of beneficiaries, their nutritional status etc. for online monitoring.

Individual tracking of each malnourished child is done by generating Anganwadi-wise list. Anganwadi workers

Community Based Events such as Anna Prashna, Mundan Ceremony, Poshan Pakhwada, Poshan Maah, Jan Andolan, Healthy baby Show etc. are organized to create awareness about health and hygiene and nutrition with the objective to reduce malnutrition.

change campaign in order to sustain the ODF gains and with an aim to improve the overall cleanliness in village and ensuring that no one is left behind to safe sanitation facilities. The key objectives of SBM (G) Phase II was to sustain the ODF Status of villages and to improve the levels of cleanliness in rural areas through Solid & Liquid Waste Management, making villages ODF Plus. The above objective was to be achieved through continued Behaviour Change Communication and Capacity Strengthening at all levels.

Under the Phase-I of the Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen), 14775 numbers of beneficiaries were identified as part of the Baseline Survey-2012 and were assisted with incentive amount of Rs.12,000/- for construction of Individual Household Latrines. With the GoI's vision of 'No One Left Behind' for sanitation access, the UT additionally provided Individual Household Latrines (IHHLs) to 3828 individuals which are completed in full shape. Further, 296 Community Sanitary Complexes under SBM (G) Phase-I and 39 CSCs sanctioned under SBM(G) Phase-II are also completed.

For effective Solid Waste Management, the Department has set-up 25 Solid Waste Management (SWM) clusters mapped to 70 Gram Panchayats in the Islands. The SWM cluster sites have provision for treatment of organic waste by means of Composting. The SWM Clusters have also been equipped with Bailing and Shredding machine for processing of non-biodegradable Solid Waste. The recyclable plastic, paper/cardboard, Tetrapacks and Multi Layer Plastics (MLPs) are bailed and sent for recycling. The non-recyclable plastic waste are shredded and used in rural road construction. As per the notification issued by the A&N Administration, 8-10 % of shredded plastic usage is mandatory in road construction in the UT. The Department during March, 2021 has also identified one recycler for collection, management, processing and transportation of waste from SWM Clusters to mainland. The waste are now being taken from these clusters for further processing/recycling on approved rates, thereby adding to the revenue of Gram Panchayats. An amount of Rs. 14,48,000/- (Rupees Fourteen Lakh Fourty Eight Thousand Only) has been earned by the Gram Panchayats by selling dry waste to recycler. For Liquid Waste Management, the rural villages in the Islands have been equipped with proper drainage facilities and community and individual soak-pits.

The Department through IEC competitions - (Best CSC) have wall painted all Community Sanitary Complexes (CSCs) in rural areas with motivational and informational IEC messages. Converging with the World Bank Incentive Fund, the Department has also taken up installation of large size hoardings in all Gram Panchayats displaying IEC messages on effective Solid Waste Management and also aided the Gram Panchayats with infrastructures and tools for handling of Solid waste through Door to Door collection. Further, efforts have been made to clear all erstwhile legacy waste dumpsites and recovery of waste for further processing. 
