## Vaccination drive in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Aug. 17

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,94,857 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,932 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years. 27,788 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years have been administered both doses of vaccine. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 1,80,951.

Today, a total of 2381 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands while the beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of

Local heads of line Departments also joined the team.

The Team inspected the Shopping Complex being built at Tushnabad Junction under Rurban

Scheme. On the suggestion of the local Zilla Parishad Member, the Chief Executive Officer directed the Executive Engineer, Zilla Parishad to incorporate provisions for construction of three open shopping spaces and 7 Nos. shuttered shop. It was also directed to take immediate steps to develop the earmarked parking lot in the area.

## Congestion of roads owing to dumping of construction materials

## Revenue officials conduct inspection; general public advised not to dump construction materials on road sides



Port Blair, Aug. 17

The team of Revenue field functionaries carried out inspection of the road between Bhatubasti and Sippighat, from where several complaints were received regarding

congestion of roads owing to dumping of construction materials and debris resulting in hindrance to free flow of vehicular movement besides inconvenience to the commuters. Roadside dumping of

such building materials is a threat to lives of pedestrians.

Similarly, other locations were also inspected and noticed that same situation is prevailing in those areas also. The general public

have been advised not to dump construction materials on road sides and pedestrian paths. Failure to comply with the prescribed norms shall attract appropriate action forthwith, a press release from DC (SA) said.

## PMEGP scheme - generating employment opportunities in rural & urban areas

## Financial assistance being provided for activities like dairy, poultry, aquaculture, sericulture including bees

Port Blair, Aug. 17

The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MoMSME) has conveyed some modifications in the existing Prime Minister's Employment Generation scheme. The main objective of the PMEGP scheme is to generate employment opportunities in rural as well as urban areas of the country through setting up of new self-

employment ventures/projects/micro enterprises. The maximum cost of the project/unit admissible for margin money subsidy under manufacturing sector has been increased from Rs. 25 lakhs to Rs. 50 lakhs whereas the same has been increased from Rs. 10 lakhs to Rs. 20 lakhs for Services/trading sector with a Govt. Subsidy upto 35% of the

total project cost.

Any individual above 18 years of age is eligible to avail the benefits under the scheme with minimum educational qualification of VIII pass for projects above Rs.10 lakhs under manufacturing and above Rs.5 lakh under services/trading sector.

Along with the other existing activities under the services sector, financial assistance can

also be availed under PMEGP scheme for few more activities like dairy, poultry, aquaculture and sericulture including bees.

An additional component namely expanding/upgrading the existing unit set up under PMEGP/REGP/MUDRA has been added, wherein the units already setup under PMEGP/REGP/MUDRA and performing

## COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Aug. 17

Thirteen positive cases have been detected today in A&N Islands, of which, 2 were from incoming flight passengers who arrived here yesterday. Today, 10 flights with 1340 passengers arrived, out of which, 1176 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 124 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 14 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 12 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. RAT was conducted on 29 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus, no positive case has been detected, a press release from IP&T said.

## Cabinet approves interest subvention of 1.5 percent on Short Term Agriculture Loan upto Rs 3 lakh

New Delhi, Aug. 17

Cabinet has approved interest subvention of 1.5 percent on Short Term Agriculture Loan upto three lakh rupees. Briefing media after the Cabinet meeting in New Delhi this afternoon, Information and Broadcasting Minister, Shri Anurag Thakur said the decision has been taken to ensure adequate

credit flow in agriculture sector. He said, the interest subvention of 1.5 percent will be provided to lending institutions by the Government. A total of 34 thousand 856 crore rupees will be provided to lending institutions by the Government.

Government also approved enhancement of limit of Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme by

50 thousand crore rupees for Travel, Tourism and Hospitality sector. Hospitality and related sectors will get a boost from this decision.

The Minister said Cabinet also approved providing the access of the Traditional Knowledge Digital Library database to users including patent applicants and researcher. (Source: india.gov.in)

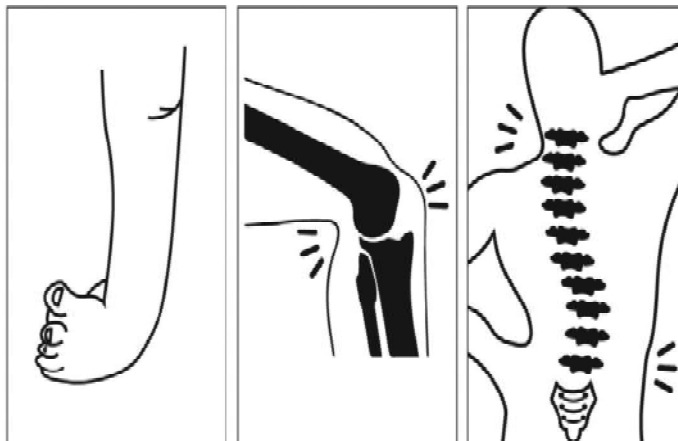
