

## Tribal Communities of A&N Islands celebrate 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' week with fanfare in their inimitable style

New Delhi, Nov. 23

As part of the nationwide celebration, the tribal communities of Andaman and Nicobar Islands participated with great enthusiasm to commemorate the glorious history of tribal people, culture and achievements during iconic week of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav'. The Prime Minister launched the programme on 15<sup>th</sup> November, which is the birth Anniversary of Bhagwan Birsa Munda by inaugurating Tribal Freedom Museum at Ranchi, offering floral tributes at the statue of Bhagwan Birsa Munda in Parliament and celebrations of Janjatiya Gaurav Divas in Bhopal.

The Andaman and Nicobar Administration with support of Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India organized week long celebrations in Andaman and Nicobar Islands which have originally been the abode of six aboriginal tribes i.e. the Andamanese, Onges, Jarawas, Sentinelese, Nicobarese and Shompens. Except Nicobarese, the rest of the 5 tribes are Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs). The tribes of the Islands belong to two different races. The Andamanese, Jarawas, Onges and the Sentinelese living in the Andaman group of islands belong to the Negrito group while the Nicobarese and Shompens, living in Nicobar Islands belong to the Mongoloid group. The tribes in the two regions have shown a marked difference in racial, linguistic and cultural terms as also the way of life adapted by them over the centuries. Each day of the week was

### 37<sup>th</sup> edition of India- Indonesia Coordinated Patrol begins; seeks to bolster maritime cooperation between the two Navies

Indian Naval Ship (INS) Khanjar, an indigenously built Missile Corvette along with Dornier Maritime Patrol Aircraft is undertaking Coordinated Patrol (CORPAT) with Indonesian Naval Ship KRI Sultan Thaha Syaifuddin, (376), a Kapitan Patimura Class Corvette from today and will also be held tomorrow. The 37<sup>th</sup> edition of CORPAT between India and Indonesia will also witness participation of Maritime Patrol Aircraft from both Nations. The exercise is

### Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 5,40,356 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far

Port Blair, Nov. 23

Vaccination drive to vaccinate maximum number of eligible beneficiaries of 18 above age group in the entire Island Territory is continuing smoothly. So far, 5,40,356 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries in Isles.

Today, a total of 2685 people were vaccinated in A&N Islands. 2214 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 78 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. 394 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 7 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. 77 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 5 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years.

A total of 1,75,124 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

### Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

#### Mini incubator for small women farmers holdings in A&N Islands

The total poultry population in A&N Islands is 12, 83,746, out of which majority ( 61.03%) is desi(rural) birds. This signifies the dependency and reliability of rural farmers on desi poultry for eggs and chicken meat. The innate nature of rural poultry farming is free range condition with production of chicks through natural hatching under brooding hen. This practice limits production of chicks due to less hatchability. Team of Animal science division, ICAR-CIARI, Port Blair successfully exploited the technology of mini incubator cum hatcher to gear up the desichicken production in the island ecosystem. A total of seven numbers of community based mini incubators (240 eggs capacity) have been established for hatching of desieggs at KVK of South Andaman and North and Middle Andaman and in the farmers' field involving women farmer as a token of woman empowerment at Wandoor, Indiranagar, Nayagaon, Memeyo and Nimbudera of South and N&M Andaman. Through capacity building programmes the farmers were trained to use mini incubator and have started producing ducklings and chickens which were further used by the other farmers of neighbouring villages. Use of this technology increases the hatchability percent to 78.8% from 60%. 15 farmers have established their own mini incubator and started selling desichickon commercial scale and emerged as successful entrepreneurs. Painting competition for children, sensitization on hygiene & health camps were organized for Onge women for creating awareness on health hazard of consumption of tobacco etc.  
Sports and games activities viz., Koko, gymnastics, swimming, archery was also conducted, in which, large part of Onge children participated enthusiastically. Cleanliness drive under Swachh Bharat Mission was also conducted in Dugong Creek involving Onge tribe, as part of the events.  
Health camp was organized for Shompen tribe living in Great Nicobar Island, the southern most part of India.  
A traditional cultural programme of dance and songs was organized for Andamanese tribe in the Andaman Club, Port Blair in association with Directorate of Art & Culture. Essay and painting competition for children of Andamanese tribe was also organized as part of the events followed by prize distribution to the winners and participants. (Source: PIB)

### Rigorous imprisonment for remainder of natural life for committing brutal murder of own daughter by mother & her lover

Maya under, Nov. 23  
Hon'ble Additional Sessions Judge, North and Middle Andaman District, Mayabunder, Shri Jimut Bahan Biswas has sentenced two persons for committing brutal murder of own daughter by Smti. Rita Dhali (mother) and Shri Amrito Halder (lover), both residents of Tugapur village, to undergo rigorous imprisonment for the remainder of their natural life.  
The Hon'ble Judge has found guilty of the offence punishable under section 302/201/34 of IPC against the accused persons and sent them to judicial custody on 17/11/2021 for reflection of mind for hearing of quantum of sentence. Thereafter, on 18/11 / 2021 after hearing the convicts as well as prosecution and defence side by the Hon'ble Additional Sessions Judge, both the convicts were sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for life, which shall mean imprisonment for the remainder of that persons natural life for committing the said heinous crime.  
The case is of brutal murder of own daughter by the culprit mother with the conspiracy of her lover. On the fateful day, an innocent girl just aged about 19 years was murdered in her own house by cutting neck with a sharp weapon. Accordingly, an FIR No. 108/2017 dated 21/08/ 2017 under section 302/ 201/34 of IPC was registered in the Police Station, Mayabunder on the basis of complaint lodged by Shri Hiramona Dhali. It is crystal clear from the evidence of prosecution that the culprit mother and her lover conjointly murdered an innocent young girl. The prosecuting authority has succeeded to substantiate their case against the culprits. The cold blooded murder case was investigated by Inspector Aditya Narayan, former SHO, PS Mayabunder and the entire prosecution case was conducted by Shri Uttam Kirtonia, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, North & Middle Andaman District, Mayabunder.  
Apart from this, the Hon'ble Additional Sessions Judge, North & Middle Andaman District, Mayabunder also functioning as Special Judge under POC SO Act has disposed a fair number of criminal cases after trials in a noticeably short period of time, which have certainly generated a growing faith & believe among the general people towards the criminal justice system and rule of law of the land, a press release from Additional Public Prosecutor, N&M Andaman said.

vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 414 passengers and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 121 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 88 passengers and all were found negative. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 54 passengers were tested with RAT and were found negative. During RAT conducted on 15 passengers at Helipad, no positive case has been detected. Today, 576 beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 531 were in the age group of 18-44.  
The Deputy Director, GB Pant Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De informed that currently no COVID patients are undergoing treatment at GB Pant Hospital and COVID Care Centres.
