

PM to dedicate to the nation PSA Oxygen Plants established under PM CARES today

35 PSA Oxygen Plants across 35 States and UTs including A&N Islands to be dedicated

New Delhi, Oct. 6 (PIB) Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi will dedicate to the nation 35 Pressure Swing Adsorption (PSA) Oxygen Plants established under PM CARES, across 35 States and Union Territories including A&N Islands, in an event to be held at AIIMS Rishikesh,

Uttarakhand tomorrow (Oct. 7) at 11 am. With this, all Districts of the country will now have commissioned PSA Oxygen Plants. Prime Minister will also address the gathering on the occasion. Till now, a total of 1224 PSA Oxygen Plants have been funded under PM CARES all

across the country, out of which, more than 1100 Plants have been commissioned, providing an output of over 1750 MT oxygen per day. It is a testimony of the proactive measures taken by the Government to augment India's medical oxygen

generation capacity since the advent of COVID-19 pandemic. The project to commission a PSA oxygen plant in each district of the country was executed while dealing with complex challenges of hilly areas, islands and territories with difficult terrain.

Operations and maintenance of these plants have been ensured by training more than 7,000 personnel. They come with an embedded Internet of Things (IoT) device for real time monitoring of their functioning and performance through a consolidated web portal.

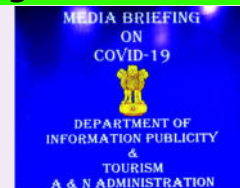

Port Blair, Oct. 6

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain reviewed the procurement of allopathic, ayurvedic, homeopathic medicines & equipments by the Health Department and issued directions to procure good quality medicines, timely, from Govt. sector, GeM portal etc. after following the codal formalities. The Islanders should be provided quality medicines all over the territory. The samples of medicines should be taken and sent for quality test to undisclosed labs. Any shortcomings and deficiencies will be viewed very seriously, the Chief Secretary remarked.

The Chief performing Secretary also reviewed the development and other Departmental projects and issued directions that any non-performing Engineers / Departments, responsible for delay and cost over run in the projects, will be sternly dealt with. He said that the projects will be transferred to the

The road projects including NHIDCL/ PWD will be supervised by Secretary (APWD) and respective DCs. The concerned DCs will lift two samples at multiple places, one to be kept in the Department safely and other will be sent for testing to undisclosed Labs.

The people of the Islands should not suffer due to bad roads constructed by any Govt. Agency, he said. The Chief Secretary has also directed that there should be no endless continuation of contractual employees, year after year. There should be an online / walk-in-interview for such contractual appointment afresh at

the end of the 11 months or the period envisaged and the existing employees can also apply therein. This is in respect to the Ministerial Staff, Teachers, Engineers and Doctors etc. By having fresh appointment periodically, qualified candidates and unemployed youth from the Islands

will get opportunity to get the jobs in the Administration and it will not be monopolized by a few favorites. The Vigilance Department and the Anti Corruption Unit have also been directed to keep strict vigil on any shortcomings / deficiencies in these matters, a press release from A&N Administration said.

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Khattachampa - a local banana cultivar

Khattachampa is a commonly cultivated local cultivar in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. This cultivar belongs to the triploid genomic group AAB. This cultivar is grown as a perennial crop in homesteads. Fruit is slightly acidic, firm and has typical sour-sweet aroma. Fruits turn to attractive golden yellow on ripening. They grow to a height of 2.8 to 3.0 m and is well suited as an intercrop in coconut or arecanut gardens. Bunch weight varies from 12-15 kg and can be harvested in 14-15 months after planting. The cultivar responds to organic manures and shows positive response to yield. Number of hands per bunch ranges from 11-13 with 14-16 fruits per hand. The average weight of fruit ranges from 70-80 g and fruit length ranges from 12-14 cm. The bunches of this cultivar are medium sized, closely packed fruits and tolerant to major pest and diseases. This is a table purpose variety and highly preferred by consumers due to its unique aroma.

Benefit: This cultivar is highly suitable to grow as intercrop in plantation based cropping system with good remuneration and is highly preferred by ethnic groups of the Island.

Workers, Migrant Workers, Domestic Workers, Agricultural Labourers, MGNREGA Workers, Gig Workers, Self-employed Workers, Street Vendors, Small Shopkeeper, ASHA Workers, Anganwadi Workers, Fishermen, Unorganised Plantation Workers, Milkmen and similar other sub-group of Unorganised Workers. Any worker who is working in Unorganised Sector and aged between 16-59 are eligible to register on the e-SHRAM portal.

"Unorganised Worker" means a home-based worker, self-employed worker or a wage worker in the unorganised sector and it also includes a worker in the organized Sector who is not a member of ESIC/EPFO/Govt. Employees. An Unorganised worker shall be required to have their Aadhaar Number, Mobile Number and Bank Account Number along with IFSC Code while registering on the e-SHRAM portal. The Common Service Centres (CSCs) will work as Principal Registering Agency in A&N Islands and the registration on e-SHRAM portal is totally free. The Unorganised Workers will also have facility of Self-registration through visiting the portal or mobile app which will be freely downloadable from the Umang platform/google play store.

The benefits for Unorganised Workers registering on e-SHRAM portal are as under:-

- ◆ e-SHRAM card received after registration will be accepted across the country.
- ◆ Accidental Insurance coverage through PMSBY for a year.
- ◆ Rs. 2.00 lakh in case of accidental death and permanent disability, Rs. 1.00 lakh in case of partial disability.
- ◆ Social Security benefits will be delivered through e-SHRAM portal.
- ◆ Helpful for Central & State Government while providing assistance during calamities/pandemic.

The Labour Commissioner & DET(I/c) has requested all the participants especially Trade Unions to disseminate the process of Registration of Unorganised Workers among all types of Unorganised Workers, so as to enable them to get register on e-SHRAM portal by visiting their nearest CSC or Self-Registration on e-SHRAM portal.

During the programme, e-SHRAM registration cards were handed over to two workers working in unorganized sector, a press release from Labour Commissioner & DET (I/c) said.

Women's cricket: Three match T-20 series between India and Australia to begin today

Queensland, Oct. 6

In the women's cricket, India and Australia are all set to lock horns in the first game of the three-match T20 series tomorrow at the Carrara Oval in Queensland, after the ODIs and the one-off day and night Test.

The match will start at 02.10 pm IST. The last time these two sides met in the shortest version of the game was in the 2020 ICC Women's T20 World Cup final on 8th of March last year.

The Indian Women's cricket team has had a great tour of Australia



so far. Even though they lost the ODI series, India staged a great fightback in the third and final ODI as they successfully chased down a stiff total of 265 to snap hosts' 26-match unbeaten streak.

The Indian team then did an outstanding job

in the one-off pink-ball Test match which also happened to be their first-ever Test match under lights.

Smriti Mandhana scored a stellar 127 as the match ended in a draw after the Indian bowlers made the hosts toil hard with the ball in hand.

75 Science Technology and Innovation Hubs to be set up in different parts of the country

New Delhi, Oct. 6

Union Minister for Science and Technology, Dr. Jitendra Singh on Wednesday said that the Government will set up up 75 Science Technology and Innovation (STI) Hubs in different parts of the country. These hubs will be exclusively for Scheduled Castes (SCs) and Scheduled Tribes (STs) and will not only promote scientific talent, but also contribute to socio-economic development of these communities.

After a high level review meeting with senior officials of Department of Science and Technology (DST) in New Delhi, the Minister

said, in the last two years, 20 STI Hubs have already been established which will directly benefit 20 thousand SC and ST population through various interventions.

Dr Singh said, the decision has been taken in tune with Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi's vision and resolve to handhold the weaker sections and raise them at par with other sections of society.

He said that STI Hubs will develop, nurture and ensure the delivery of appropriate and relevant technologies for creation of sustainable livelihoods for the SC and ST population. (Source: india.gov.in)

Over 92.17 crore COVID vaccine doses administered in the country so far



India marches ahead with another achievement in its fight against COVID-19

Vaccine Doses Administered

New Delhi, Oct. 6

India has administered over 92 crore 17 lakh doses of COVID vaccine so far under the Nationwide Vaccination Drive. The Union Health Ministry said, more than 59 lakh 48 thousand vaccine doses were administered in the last 24 hours. The Ministry said, 24 thousand 770 COVID patients recovered during the last 24 hours and the national recovery rate has reached 97.94 per cent. Till now, more than three crore 31 lakh people have

recovered from COVID-19. The country reported 18 thousand 833 new cases in the last 24 hours. Currently, India's active caseload is around two lakh 46 thousand. The active cases constitute less than one per cent of the total reported cases. The daily positivity rate stands at 1.34 per cent.

The Ministry said, the testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded and more than 57 crore 68 lakh COVID-19 tests have been conducted so far. (Source: india.gov.in)

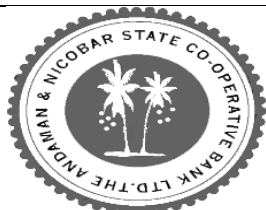

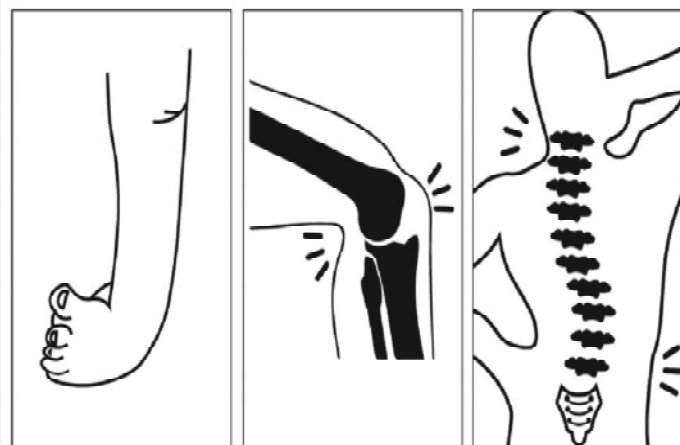

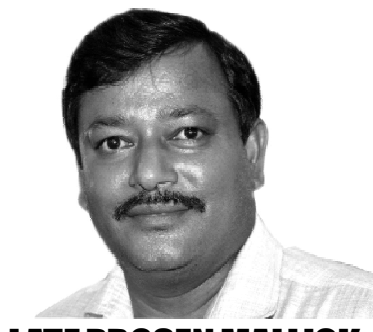
