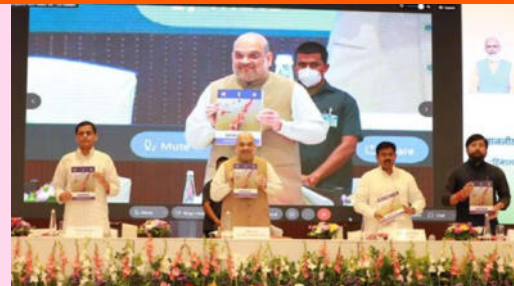
value-additions. The Prime Minister said that the Government is making efforts to get good prices for farmers with many initiatives like access to the market, good quality seeds, soil health cards etc.

**NDRF and SDRF as implementing agencies of NDMA have worked to transform disaster management in the country: HM**

Union Minister of Home Affairs and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah attended the 17th Foundation Day celebrations of National Disaster Management



Authority (NDMA) as the Chief Guest in New Delhi today. The theme of this year's Foundation Day is 'Stopping the Impact of Disaster Incidents in the Himalayan Region'. On this occasion, Shri Amit Shah released the training manual of Aapda Mitra Scheme and plan documents of 130 crore people, where Aapda Mitra and Common Alerting Protocol.

In his address, he said that NDMA and the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) and State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) as its implementing agencies have, in the last 17 years, changed the history of disaster management in the country. The work has been done to link the sensitivity of the country with disaster management and this is a great achievement. He said that in a country of 130 crore people, where every state has different weather, many rivers, mountains, long coastlines, in this situation, if we are not able to see the sensitivity of the public and society, the introduction of scientific systems to avoid disasters and if we are not able to prepare the mindset to percolate these arrangements down, then we have to be prepared for huge loss of life and infrastructure. ## A&N Islands received 2826.1 mm progressive rainfall compared to 1983.5 mm on Sept. 28 last year

**Water level in Dhanikhari Dam reaches 65.95 m of its full reservoir level of 66 m**

The A&N Islands is experiencing moderate to heavy rainfall since last two weeks. The Officer In-Charge Met Office, Shadipur has attributed the current continuous rain due to the excess monsoon this

time while in North & Middle Andaman especially in Diglipur it was due to cyclone circulation in the neighbourhood areas. He further disclosed that weather condition will improve from tomorrow onwards. The Met Office

recorded yesterday's rainfall from 0830 hrs to 1730 hrs at 30 mm in Port Blair. The approximate rainfall recorded yesterday in different islands viz. Mayabunder (13mm), Long Island (7mm), Car Nicobar (7 mm), Nancowry (12mm) and

Hut Bay (18mm).

A&N Islands has so far received a rainfall of 2826.1mm (progressive total from 1st January-2021 upto 0830hrs (Sept. 28). The rainfall received during the same period last year stands at 1983.5 mm (Sept. 28, 2020).

Meanwhile, the

water level in the Dhanikhari Dam has increased. The Dam which has a full reservoir level of 66 m is having 65.95m of water as on 26.09.21 while it was 63.01 m during the same period in the year 2020, APWD sources informed.

## Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

### Malabar tamarind (Garcinia gummi-gutta): A potential commercial crop for the islands

Malabar tamarind is a multipurpose species native to the Western Ghats. To study the performance of crop under island condition, ICAR-CIARI introduced and evaluated it for past 13 years. Results have suggested that the crop could be profitably grown under island conditions, provided scientific crop production and postharvest management is adopted. Malabar tamarind has been valued for the medicinal value of its rind, anti-obesity being the major one. Grafted plants start yielding within 3-4 years of planting and could be planted at a spacing of 6 m x 6 m with suitable canopy management practices. It could also be incorporated as an intercrop in coconut plantations. A well grown plant may yield about 50-70 kg fruits per year. Flowering occurs during February-March, while fruiting occurs during July-August under island conditions. Some early types have been identified at ICAR-CIARI, which start fruiting from May onwards. Fruits could be harvested every 4-5 days during fruiting season. At home or cottage scale, fruit peel could be sun dried or smoke dried for future consumption. Considering the coincidence of fruiting season with rains in the islands, use of mechanical driers is desirable for commercial scale processing. From 100 kg of fruits, about 10-15 kg dry produce could be obtained depending upon the drying method used. Under island condition, no major pest or disease incidence was reported in the experimental fields of the Institute.

**Benefit:** Cultivation of Malabar tamarind, solely or as an intercrop coupled with processing through mechanical means could not only diversify the island agriculture but would also enhance the income of the stakeholders involved.

from Bardez, Goa, how she is cultivating diverse crops and rearing various livestock. He asked about the value-addition of coconut done by the farmer. He expressed happiness that how a woman farmer is flourishing as an entrepreneur.

Interacting with Shri Thoiba Singh from Manipur, the Prime Minister complimented him for taking up farming after a life in the armed forces. The farmer's diversified activities such as agriculture, fishery and other allied activities drew the Prime Minister's interest. The Prime Minister praised him as an example of Jai Jawan-Jai Kisan-Jai Vigyaan.

The Prime Minister enquired from Shri Suresh Rana, Udham Singh Nagar, Uttarakhand about how he started corn cultivation. The Prime Minister complimented the farmers of Uttarakhand for using FPOs efficiently and said that when farmers work collectively they benefit a great deal. The Government is trying to make every resource and infrastructure available to the farmers.

Addressing the occasion, the Prime Minister said in the last 6-7 years, science and technology are being used on a priority basis to solve the challenges related to agriculture. "Our focus is very high on more nutritious seeds, adapted to new conditions, especially in changing climates," said the Prime Minister. The Prime Minister recalled the massive locust attack in various States last year, in the midst of the Corona pandemic. India had tackled this attack by making a lot of efforts, saving farmers from incurring too much damage, he said.

The Prime Minister stressed that whenever farmers and agriculture get a safety net, their growth becomes rapid. He informed that 11 crores Soil Health Cards were issued for the protection of the land. The Prime Minister listed the farmer-friendly initiatives of the Government such as campaigns to complete about 100 pending irrigation projects for providing water security to the farmers, providing new varieties of seeds to farmers to protect crops from diseases thus getting a higher yield. He added that along with increasing the MSP, the procurement process was also improved so that more and more farmers can get the benefit. More than 430 lakh metric tonnes of wheat has been procured in the Rabi season and farmers have been paid more than 85 thousand crore rupees. Wheat procurement centres were increased more than three times during the pandemic.

The Prime Minister said by connecting farmers with technology, we have made it easier for them to get help from banks. Today farmers are getting weather information in a better way. Recently, more than 2 crore farmers have been given Kisan Credit Cards.

The Prime Minister remarked that due to climate change, new types of pests, new diseases, epidemics are emerging, because of this, there is a big threat to the health of humans and livestock and crops are also being affected. Intensive continued research on these aspects is necessary. He remarked that when science, government and society work together, results will be better. Such an alliance of farmers and scientists will strengthen the country in dealing with new challenges.

The Prime Minister said efforts are being made to take the farmer out of the crop-based income system and encourage them for value-addition and other farming options. He stressed the need to further develop millets and other grains with solutions from science and research. He said that the purpose is that they can be grown in different parts of the country according to the local needs. He asked people to be prepared to use the opportunities provided by the UN declaring the coming year as the Year of the Millet.

The Prime Minister said along with our ancient farming traditions, marching towards the future is equally important. He said modern technology and new farming tools are at the core of future farming. "Efforts to promote modern agricultural machines and equipment are showing results today," he added.

Speaking on the occasion, Union Agriculture Minister said that the Prime Minister makes constant efforts for the wellbeing of the small farmer. He is the Pradhan Sevak of the small farmer.

## Home Ministry asks States, UTs to enforce adherence to COVID appropriate behaviour during upcoming festive season

New Delhi, Sept. 28

Home Ministry has asked States and UTs to enforce adherence to COVID appropriate behaviour during the upcoming festive season. In a letter to States and UTs, Home Secretary, Shri Ajay Bhalla said there is a possibility that COVID Appropriate Behaviour will not be adhered to strictly with the decline in cases during the festive season.

He asked them to maintain utmost vigil in respect of mass

gatherings to avoid surge in cases. The letter stated that large scale

gatherings in fairs, festivals and religious events and functions may lead to fresh surge in COVID cases in the country. States and UTs have been asked to closely monitor case positivity, hospital/ICU occupancy of every district on a regular basis. States having high positivity in their districts should take proactive containment measures to effectively arrest the spike in cases

and contain spread of transmission.

Home Ministry asked states and UTs to focus on the five fold strategy of Test-Track-Treat-Vaccination and adherence to COVID appropriate behaviour. They have been asked to continue with their vaccination programme with focus on accelerating vaccination of eligible age groups and prioritisation of second dose to eligible beneficiaries. the Aapda Mitra scheme is very important. He said that NDMA should study the research or good practices to reduce the risk of disaster across the world and take them to the people by adapting them according to the circumstances and challenges of our country and adapting them into a methodology. Shri Shah said that despite several efforts and best facilities provided by the Government, it is difficult to take immediate action by agencies like NDMA, NDRF and SDRF as soon as a disaster strikes.

Shri Amit Shah said that Common Alert Protocol should be well publicized. He said that NDMA has taken many very good initiatives under which we can give alert about the location of lightning 6 minutes in advance and a few hours in advance of a large area. Shri Shah said that we have prepared an action plan for cold wave and severe heat, but these are not implemented. He said that many lives can be saved if early warning agencies and such warnings are implemented.

Shri Amit Shah said that if the work of NDRF and SDRF is reviewed from any point of view, then they have done the most important work of instilling confidence in the minds of the people of the country. Today, any major disaster happens anywhere, as soon as the NDRF personnel arrive, those affected by the disaster feel they will be saved. This credibility is not possible without sacrifice, hard work, discipline and continuous training. NDAF has done a very good job of creating a culture of putting their life in danger for saving others.

Shri Amit Shah said that out of 36 States and Union Territories of the country, 27 are severe disaster prone States and 58 percent of the land area is prone to moderate to very high intensity of earthquakes, 12 percent is flood prone area where river flows through erosion. About 7,516 kms of coastline is marked by cyclone vulnerabilities, 68 percent of the arable area is prone to drought every third year and around 15 percent of the land in mountains is prone to landslides. About 5,161 urban units, be it municipal or municipal corporation, are prone to floods and at such times disaster management in our country is a huge responsibility.

## Government increases income limit of disabled dependents for family pension

New Delhi, Sept. 28

Government has increased the income limit of disabled dependents for family pension. Defence Ministry has taken the decision to enhance the income criteria for grant of family pension to children or siblings suffering from mental or physical disability.

Such child or sibling shall be eligible for family pension for life, if their overall income from sources other than

family pension remains less than the entitled family pension at ordinary rate.

The financial benefit in such cases shall accrue with effect from 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2021. Presently, the disabled child or sibling is eligible for family pension, if overall monthly income from sources other than family pension is not more than 9000 rupees along with dearness relief. 


Meanwhile, a total of 1787 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 1532 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 238 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 164 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which,40 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 91 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 2 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. A total of 1,70,259 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.



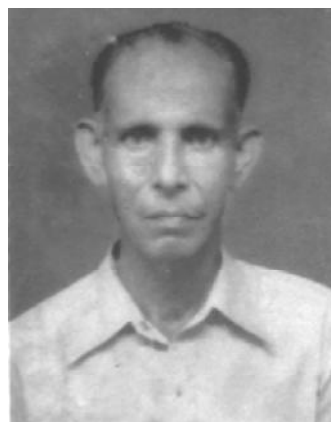
