

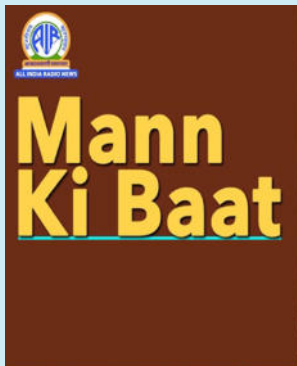
## Mann Ki Baat

New Delhi, Feb. 27

### 'National Immunization Day for Polio' successfully conducted in Isles

## Around 23859 children (0-5 years) administered polio vaccine; coverage percentage on first day stood at 97.10

Port Blair, Feb.27

The 'National Immunization Day for Polio' was successfully conducted in Isles. Elaborate arrangements were made by the Health Department to cover maximum children in the age group of 0-5 years for administration of polio drops at healthcare institutions and designated booths. As per the data received from DHS, around 23859 children (0-5 years) were administered polio vaccine on first day in 559 booths across Isles, the percentage of which stood at 97.10. In South Andaman alone, a total of 15670 (95.96%)



children were covered while polio drops were administered to 5818 children (98.29%) in North & Middle Andaman and 2371 (102.07%) children in Nicobar District.

To cater to children commuting to other parts of the Islands and mainland, Polio Booths were set up in all exit points of airport, seaport and bus stand for coverage of all

eligible children. Mobile booth/van were also stationed in various outreach areas to reach out to the eligible children. Parents were seen taking their children to the nearest Polio Booth for the administration of polio drops to ensure that their children are safeguarded against polio.

Meanwhile, the

booth activities will be followed by house-to-house surveillance over the next two days to identify and vaccinate children who have not taken vaccination today.

It may be recalled here that, the UT of A&N Islands received 37320 doses of bivalent Oral Polio Vaccine for 1<sup>st</sup> round of immunization from the Ministry of Health

& Family Welfare and the vaccines were distributed to all health institutions based on the number of estimated children for the smooth conduct of the 'National Immunization Day for Polio'. Private practitioners of these Islands also actively participated in making the National Immunization Day for Polio a grand success.

### Notification issued for compensation of victims of Hit and Run motor accidents

New Delhi, Feb. 27 (PIB)

The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has notified a new scheme for compensation of victims of Hit & Run motor accidents vide notification dated 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 to cater to enhanced compensation (from Rs 12,500 to Rs 50,000 for grievous hurt and from Rs 25,000 to Rs 2,00,000 for death) .The process of

application for compensation and the release of payment to victims has also been made time bound . This scheme will supersede the Solatium Scheme, 1989 from 01<sup>st</sup> April, 2022 onwards.

Ministry has also published rules on 25.2.2022 regarding creation, operation, sources of fund etc. of the Motor Vehicles Accident Fund . This

This act of misconduct on the part of Home Guard personnel tantamount to gross indiscipline and violation of laid down rules and guidelines. No such act of indiscipline and

misconduct can be tolerated in uniformed and disciplined force.

Taking a serious view, delinquent Home Guard Volunteer has been discharged with immediate effect from the roll of A&N Home Guard Organisation in accordance with provision under A&N Home Guard Regulation, 1964 & A&N Home Guard

## Nationwide COVID vaccination drive touches 177 crore 44 lakh mark

New Delhi, Feb. 27

Over 177 crore 44 lakh vaccine doses have been administered so far under Nationwide Vaccination Drive. Health Ministry said, over 24 lakh five thousand doses were administered yesterday. The recovery rate is currently at 98.54 percent. Nearly 20 thousand recoveries in the last 24 hours increased total recoveries to 4 crore 22 lakh 90 thousand 921. Over 10 thousand new

cases were recorded in the last 24 hours. India's active caseload currently stands at 1 lakh 11 thousand 472. Active cases stand at 0.26 percent. The daily positivity rate is at 1 percent and Weekly positivity rate is at 1.26 percent.

243 deaths were reported in last 24 hours. Over 76 crore 67 lakh tests have been conducted so far. Over 10 lakh 22 thousand tests were conducted in the last 24 hours. (Source: india.gov.in)

Under the ABDM, citizens will be able to create their ABHA (Ayushman Bharat Health Account) numbers, to which their digital health records can be linked. This will enable creation of longitudinal health records for individuals across various healthcare providers, and improve clinical decision-making by healthcare providers. The mission will improve equitable access to quality healthcare by encouraging use of technologies such as telemedicine and enabling national portability of health services.

The pilot of ABDM was completed in the six Union Territories of Ladakh, Chandigarh, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu, Puducherry, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep with successful demonstration of technology platform developed by the NHA. (Source: india.gov.in)

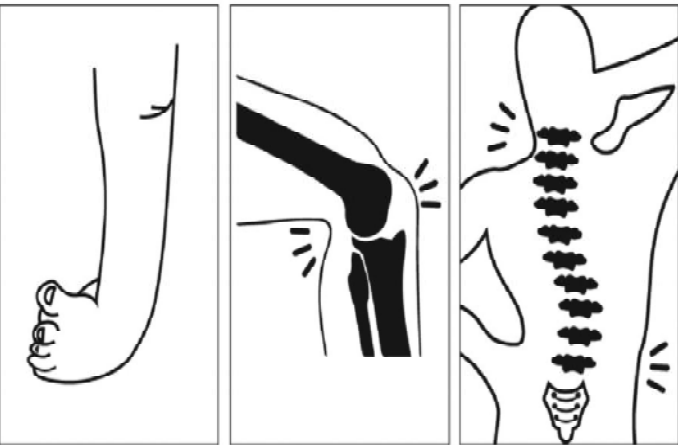
