

Home Ministry extends COVID-19 guidelines till Dec. 31

New Delhi, Nov. 30

Home Ministry has extended the COVID-19 guidelines issued under the Disaster Management Act, till 31st December, 2021. In an order, the Ministry asked the States and UTs to go for rigorous screening and testing of all international arrivals. It said, these international travellers must also be closely

tracked and tested as per Health Ministry's guidelines and the samples of travellers turning positive are sent to the designated Indian SARS-CoV-2 Genomics Consortium INSACOG Genome Sequencing Laboratories promptly, as per the INSACOG Guidance Document.

The Ministry said, State Surveillance

Officers must establish a close coordination with the designated or tagged genome sequencing laboratories for expediting the results of genomic analysis and the States and UTs should immediately undertake necessary public health measures in case presence of variants of concern or variants of interest. India's GDP grows at 8.4% in second quarter of current fiscal

New Delhi, Nov. 30

India's Gross domestic product, GDP, for the second quarter of the current fiscal logged fastest growth among major economies in the world. According to the Government data released today, GDP of the country grew by 8.4 percent from a year ago. As per the National Statistics Office, NSO, data, Manufacturing output increased 5.5 percent during the period while



construction segment grew 7.5 percent in the second quarter.

The NSO data suggest that household consumption rose in the second quarter, July-September, of FY22 despite the second wave of the Covid-19 pandemic, boosting hopes of a quicker

146 food samples tested since last three months

Port Blair, Nov. 30

The Mobile Food Testing Laboratory (MFTL) of Food Safety Department conducts regular visits at various areas of South Andaman District for carrying out analysis of food samples at the door step of general public. During the past three months about 146 food samples including milk and milk products, drinking water, fishes & other food samples were tested through MFTL and Rs.10350/- has been collected as



analysis fee.

In addition to this, the MFTL also conducted awareness programmes and training programmes on safe & hygienic food, good hygiene



practices and good manufacturing practices etc. During the past three months, 51 awareness programmes were organized and altogether 536 Food

Business Operators (FBOs) and general public attended these programmes. Similarly, 6 training programmes for food manufacturers were conducted with the participation of 94 food business employees. Every month, the MFTL visits various places as per the monthly schedule programme to carry out the above activities.

Mock exercise on Natural Disaster conducted at National Memorial Cellular Jail by District Administration

Port Blair, Nov. 30

The District Administration, South Andaman with the assistance of State Authority, NDRF & other Line Department organized a multi agency Mock Drill Exercise on theme of 'Building collapse due to earthquake' at National Memorial Cellular Jail as part of celebration of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' today.

In the exercise, a scenario was created wherein portion of Cellular Jail collapsed due to earthquake. On receiving a distress call from Cellular Jail Authorities at 1030 hrs, the District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) Control Room, (Toll free No. 1077) Pant Hospital for



informed all the stakeholders including NDRF. All the line agencies rushed to the incident site and carried out the rescue operations. During the mock relief and rescue operation, NDRF rescued 4 victims from under the collapsed structure and conducted evacuation drill wherein 25 tourists (10 male +15 females) were evacuated from the Cellular Jail. The rescued victims were dispatched and transported to G.B. Pant Hospital for

necessary emergency medical care and evacuated victims were provided medical assistance/care on the spot. The entire exercise was monitored by Shri Dilkush Meena, Assistant Commissioner (Relief & Disaster Management) as Incident Commander under the close supervision of Shri. Suneel Anchipaka, District Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman.

doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 397 passengers and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 189 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 68 passengers and all were found negative. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 42 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative. During RAT conducted on 13 passengers at Helipad, no positive case has been detected. Today, till 3pm, 549 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 513 were of 18 plus age group.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 5,53,514 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far Percentage of target beneficiaries fully vaccinated reaches 89.75 %

Port Blair, Nov.30

The safety of the citizens is the foremost priority of the Administration, especially during this pandemic time. To shield its citizens from the corona virus, the vaccination of eligible beneficiaries is being initiated by the Administration in different parts of the Islands.

Accordingly, the vaccination began with administering of COVISHIELD vaccine for Health Care Workers followed by frontline workers and vulnerable population with co-morbidities. Subsequently, the vaccination for 45 and above was initiated followed by 18 to 44 years which is currently underway.

Meanwhile, the vaccination drive is



continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 5,53,514 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2,86,600 (approx.). With this, percentage of target beneficiaries fully vaccinated has gone upto 89.75 %.

Today, a total of 2347 people were vaccinated today. 1932 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which,

121 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 395 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 9 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 20 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District out of which 3 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. A total of 1,75,770 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

Rigorous imprisonment for life for gruesome murder of wife

Mayabunder, Nov. 30

Shri Jimut Bahan Biswas, Hon'ble Additional Sessions Judge, North & Middle Andaman District, Mayabunder has convicted one person namely Suranjan Roy, R/o Nabagram, Diglipur yesterday for committing gruesome murder of his wife in daylight and Hon'ble Judge has sent him to judicial custody for reflection of mind for hearing of quantum of sentence. On that fateful day, the lady victim who was living separately from her husband/accused went out for her livelihood in a construction site situated at R.K Gram, near CHC Diglipur, the culprit with pre-planned

motive suddenly appeared with sharp knife and stabbed her with multiple injuries till she succumbed to her injuries. Thereafter, on 30/11 /2021 after hearing the convict as well as prosecution and defence side by the Hon'ble Additional Sessions Judge, the convict was sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for life for committing the gruesome murder.

The Hon'ble Additional Sessions Judge, North & Middle Andaman District, Mayabunder also functioning as Special Judge under POC SO Act has disposed a fair number of criminal cases after trials in a noticeably short period of time, which have

certainly generated a growing faith & believe among the general people towards the criminal justice system and rule of law of the land.

This day-light gruesome murder case was registered as FIR No. 49 of 2018 dated 11/04/2018 of PS Diglipur which was investigated by former SHO, PS Diglipur and the entire prosecution case was conducted by Shri Uttam Kirtonia, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, North & Middle Andaman District, Mayabunder, a press release from Additional Public Prosecutor, North & Middle Andaman District, Mayabunder said.
