## CPI (M) Demands Convening of Administrator's Advisory Committee

Port Blair, Dec 16: CPI (M) has demanded immediate convening of the Administrator's Advisory Committee meeting in order to discuss all important policy matters which are currently under process in the Administration. In a letter addressed to the Lt. Governor, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Mr. D. Ayyappan, Secretary, CPI (M) A & N State Organizing Committee said that a body namely Administrator's Advisory Committee was formed ten years back comprising

Heads of Political parties in the islands, a few representatives of Municipal and Panchayat-raj institutions, etc. to ensure some kind of people's participation in the policy matters.

"It was observed that the functioning of the Committee was not satisfactory and only once in a while the meeting of the Committee was convened. However, for the last 3 - 4 years, no meeting of the Committee has been held," he said..

CPI (M) Secretary

stated in the letter that officers are taking important policy decisions concerning the people of these islands at their will and wish without any involvement or consultation with the islanders. He said that most of such decisions go against the interests of the islanders. While the successive central governments have failed to provide any democratically elected body with powers for the governance of this union territory, the authorities in the Administration

tacks the body's immune system. HIV infection can be diagnosed using simple and affordable rapid diagnostic tests, as well as self-tests.

People can lead a healthy life for a long time with appropriate medical care. Antiretroviral therapy (ART) effectively suppresses replication, if taken at the right time. Successful viral suppression restores the immune system and halts onset and progression of disease as well as reduces chances of getting opportunistic infections. Medication thus enhances both quality of life and longevity.

Further, he also informed about HIV/AIDS (Prevention & Control) ACT, 2017 which came into force on September 10, 2018 with the objective to prevent and control the spread of HIV and AIDS and for reinforcing the legal and human rights of persons infected with and affected by HIV and AIDS. It also seeks to protect the rights of healthcare providers. The participants were informed to come forward for 'Knowing their HIV Status' by voluntarily getting themselves tested which will be kept confidential.

## On Rahul Gandhi's 'China prepping for war', BJP says, 'He is so close to them'

Rahul Gandhi on Friday said China is preparing not for any incursion but for a full-fledged war from both Ladakh and Arunachal sides and the BJP government is sleeping. Commenting on this, BJP's Rajyavardhan Rathore said Rahul Gandhi is so close to China that he knows what they will be doing next. Rajiv Gandhi Foundation received a donation of ₹135 crore from the Communist Party of China, the BJP leader said. Criticising Rahul Gandhi's comment on Vijay Diwas, BJP's Amit Malviya said Rahul Gandhi continues to doubt the valour of the Indian soldiers while every proud Indian has seen 'videos' of men in uniform thrashing the Chinese soldiers. "...except of course Rahul Gandhi, who continues to doubt their valour just because he signed an MoU with the Chinese, his family enjoyed Chinese hospitality and received funds in RG Foundation...", Malviya wrote. "There is striking similarity between Bilawal Bhutto Zardari and Rahul Gandhi. Both are entitled dynasts, churlish and petulant, speak

the same language, use similar words and idioms to target PM Modi. What binds them? Perhaps their hatred for India, that is growing in stature...", Malviya wrote. The full form of the INC in I need Chinese money, BJP spokesperson Shehzad Poonawalla said. "Though our soldiers gave a befitting reply to the Chinese troops, Rahul Gandhi said 'jawano ko peet rahe hain'. This is the same Congress party which signed an MoU with China and gave away 38,000 sq km of our land in Aksai Chin. They never built any infrastructure along the LAC," Poonawalla said. Addressing the press meeting on the occasion of the completion of the 100th day of the Bharat Jodo Yatra, Rahul Gandhi said, "Before I came to this press conference, I was having lunch with my friend and said I can bet that the media will not ask any question about China. They will ask about yatra, Sachin Pilot, Ashok Gehlot everything but not China who captured 2,000 square km area of India, who martyred 20 jawans, who is thrashing our jawans in Arunachal. But the

Indian press will not ask anything about this on me. Brother, desh dekh rahe hai. Don't think the country is not seeing."

After Rahul Gandhi's comment, he was asked about the recent Tawang clash which took place on December 9 in the Tawang sector in Arunachal Pradesh. Rahul Gandhi said the threat from China is serious but the government is sleeping and trying to ignore and hide. "See the pattern of their weapons. Their preparation is not for any incursion, it is for war. The government perhaps can't accept this," Rahul Gandhi said. "Indian government performs event-based work. It does not do strategic work. They do one event here, and another event there. But an event-based approach does not work in geo-strategy; it requires strength," Rahul Gandhi said adding that it is important to understand what is happening. "Their speeches come. The external affairs minister often gives out statements. I should not say this but perhaps he should expand his understanding," Rahul Gandhi said.

## Vijay Diwas: Army celebrates 51 years of India's victory in 1971 war



The Indian Army on Thursday celebrated the Vijay Diwas, marking 51 years of 1971 Indo-Pakistan war that led to the liberation of Bangladesh. A special event was organised by the Army's Eastern Command which was attended by delegates from Bangladesh.

"The skies of #Kolkata were abuzz with the sound of fighter aircrafts and combat helicopters as Military Tattoo was conducted at RCTC. The show was witnessed by Senior Military and Civil officials, Bangladesh delegation including Mukti Jodhas & Kolkata public," the official Twitter account of Indian Army's Eastern Command tweeted.

The Indian Air Force also commemorated the 51-year anniversary of the Bangladesh liberation war and shared anecdotes from the signing of the Instrument of Surrender by the Pakistan Army on its official Twitter page. The Indian armed forces on December 16, 1971, defeated the Pakistan Army in a bid to liberate Bangladesh, formerly part of East Pakistan. Over 3,000 Indian soldiers were killed in the war, which stretched over 13 days.

Around 93,000 Pakistan soldiers laid their arms down before the Indian forces. It is marked as the largest military surrender after the second world war. The day is hailed as Vijay Diwas.

Ambassador of Israel to India Naor Gilon also joined the celebration and paid homage to the Indian armed forces for its contribution. The victory of Indian armed forces in the war was also celebrated across the political spectrum. Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge remembered then Prime Minister Indira Gandhi's contribution in leading the war.

"Under the dynamic and determined leadership of our leader Smt. Indira Gandhi, the geography of the world changed today in 1971, as Indian Armed Forces scripted history by decisively defeating Pakistan & Liberating Bangladesh. Our salutations to our brave Jawans on #VijayDiwas," he tweeted.

The official Twitter page of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) also shared a video to mark the victory of Indian armed forces against the Pakistan troops. "Salute to the sacrifice and indomitable courage of the Indian armed forces on #VijayDiwas," it said.

Papa Rao admitted that he had stolen the gold and kept it in a pvt. bank. Thus the stolen gold was recovered from the Private Bank. Later the Police discovered there were some more quantities of unidentified gold left in the same bank in the name of the accused person.

Humfringunj Police team arrested the person on 29 Oct 2022; however, on 06th Nov the accused person got bail from the court and he was released on bail.

On 28 November the accused person tried to take a loan from a different bank against the gold kept in the earlier bank.

Based on the identification of gold, the

Bambooflat Police team started investigation and the Police team identified gold thief at Bambooflat and on 12 Dec they arrested the accused person Papa Rao alias Raja, resident of Ferrargunj area by the police team led by inspector K. Abdul Nasir and under the supervision of the SDPO (Bambooflat) Mr. Arshdeep Singh Panwar, Sub-Divisional Police Officer (SDPO) and under the overall supervision of Mr. Rajiv Ranjan, IPS, Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District and recovered 90 percent stolen gold from the accused person Papa Rao and on 13 Dec produced in a court where the Judge ordered the Police take the accused in to 03 days police remand, a source said.

## PIL Filed in...

Kolkata at Kolkata, Circuit Bench at Port Blair today.

As per report, the much harried students of the DBRAIT said that they have lost all hopes from the Administration as well as from all political parties, as neither of them has come up with a concrete solution in respect of the affiliation of the DBRAIT. They approached the Education Minister with the issue but that also yielded no result, and hence they were com-

pelled to knock on the doors of the honourable Court for justice.

The PIL was filed by seven members, 4 students, two parents and a public representative.

According to the PIL petitioners, their plea was given due importance and the hon'ble Judge heard them seriously and asked the Administration to come with a clear cut, concrete and comprehensive solution in Black & White.

According to the report, the Court also asked the Administration to arrange professors and if required go to Pondicherry to find a solution to this issue. "Situation which prevailed till date shall not continue any longer," the Judge reportedly said as told by the PIL petitioners.

According to Mr. Sagar the Court has also directed to stop the new admission process for B.Tech in DBRAIT.

The DBRAIT student Mr. Sagar, the main PIL petitioner said that they haven't hired any pleader, they drafted the PIL themselves with the guidance of some veteran persons wanting to end the corruption and also with the consultations with a few lawyers and with the suggestions of their colleagues, they filed a proper PIL.

Mr. Sagar alleged that about 200 students have already quit the col-

lege, in fact they were forced to quit the college and take admission in other colleges. Now there are merely 5 to 6 students in a classroom of the College while the guest Assistant Professors are also reportedly quitting job, they are leaving DBRAIT because they are harassed while local lower rank lecturers are given higher posts, besides no increment is given to the guest Assistant Professors, they further alleged.
