Precautionary measures taken to control spread of COVID-19 in North & Middle Andaman

Night Curfew imposed between 9 pm and 6 am; Public transport/ busses, academic congregations shall be allowed with 70% capacity

Mayabunder, Jan. 4

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 144 Cr.P.C., 1973, the District Magistrate, North & Middle Andaman has directed the following for the compliance of the normative framework for taking evidence based containment measures for COVID-19, in accordance with the advisory issued by MoHFW dated 21st December 2021, which shall continue to be strictly followed and shall remain in force up to 11th January, 2022 for the whole of North and Middle Andaman.

As per the order issued by the DM (N&MA), night curfew will be in force in the entire district of North and Middle Andaman with immediate effect with no movement of men

and materials between 9 pm and 6 am upto Jan. 11, 2022 until and unless permitted by the District Magistrate on case-to-case basis. All shops and establishments are permitted to open between 6 am and 9 pm. They shall strictly follow norms of social distancing by maintaining a distance of atleast (one) meter from a person and not allowing more than 3 persons at a time inside the premises. Any overcrowding on violation of social distancing will be responsibility of the shopkeepers and will invite fine of Rs.4000/- for violation of social distancing norms and Rs. 10000/- for overcrowding in shops/ establishments, along with sealing of shop for 14 days.

India administers more than 146.70 crore COVID vaccine doses under Nation wide Vaccination Drive

New Delhi, Jan. 4

More than 146 crore 70 lakh COVID vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far under Nationwide Vaccination Drive. Health Ministry said, more than 99 lakh 27 thousand doses were administered in the last 24 hours. The Ministry said a total of 37 thousand 379 new cases were reported in the last 24 hours.

India's Active caseload stands at one lakh 71 thousand 830. The active cases account for less than one percent of total cases and are currently at 0.49 percent. The recovery rate is currently at 98.13 percent. A total of 11 thousand 7

24 services available in online mode & digitalized certificates being issued

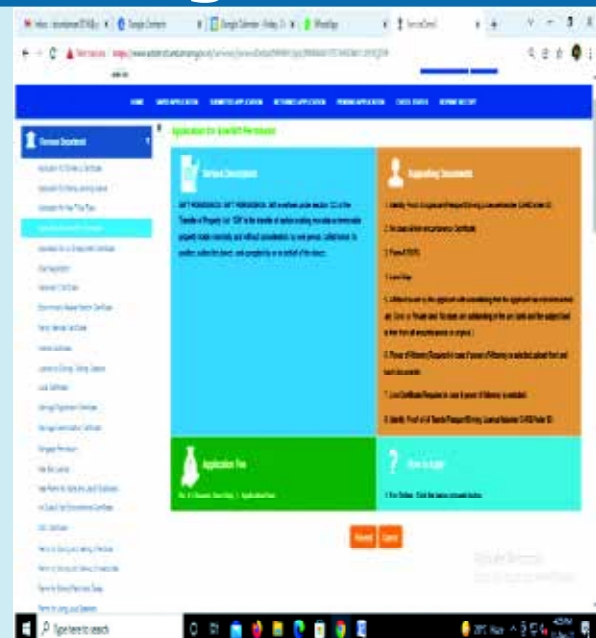
Port Blair, Jan. 4

It is proposed to fill up two (02) post of Superintending Engineer (Civil), (General Central Services) Group 'A' Gazetted (Ministerial) carrying the Pay Level – 13 (Rs.123100–215900) in the Andaman Public Works Department under A&N Administration on Deputation (ISTC) basis from the officers under the Central Govt./State Government/Public Sector Undertakings/Semi Govt./Autonomous or Statutory Organization and possessing the following experience and other eligibility conditions of appointment.

Deputation (Including Short Term Contract):

Officers under the Central Government/State Govt./UT Administration/PSUs/Universities/recognized Research Institutions/Semi-Government or Autonomous Bodies or Statutory Organization:-

- (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre/department.

- (ii) with five years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in Level-12 (Rs.78800-209200) in the Pay Matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; OR

- (iii) with ten years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in Level-11 (Rs.67700-208700) in the Pay Matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; AND

- (b) Possessing the following educational qualification and experience

Having passed Part 'A' & 'B' Examination of the Institution of Engineers (India) in Civil Engineering

The departmental officer in the feeder category who are in the direct line of Promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, Deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

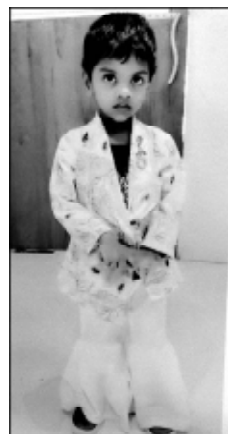
