More than 146 crore 70 lakh COVID vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far under Nationwide Vaccination Drive. Health Ministry said, more than 99 lakh 27 thousand doses were administered in the last 24 hours. The Ministry said a total of 37 thousand 379 new cases were reported in the last 24 hours.

India's Active caseload stands at one lakh 71 thousand 830. The active cases account for less than one percent of total cases and are currently at 0.49 percent. The recovery rate is currently at 98.13 percent. A total of 11 thousand 7





No movement of public beyond these timings will be allowed except for Hospitals, medical labs, medicines and medical equipment, ambulance and hearse vehicle services, medical and its allied activities, all medical emergency cases shall be permitted. Persons engaged for essential activities for movement of goods on Andaman Trunk Road, loading and unloading of essential cargo shall be allowed on production of valid movement passes issued by the Office of District Magistrate.

Movement of officers/officials involved in providing essential services such as District Administration, Police, CISF, Health Services, Home Guards, Electricity, Fire and emergency services, Defence personnel on duty shall be permitted on production of valid Identity Cards issued by their concerned Departments. Movement of bare minimum personnel involved in providing Broadcasting and Cable services, Internet service providers, all print and electronic media persons, private security services, POL Outlets, LPG Stores/Godowns, ATMs, Cold Storages and warehouses shall be allowed for which valid passes shall be issued by the Office of District Magistrate based on the certification from the concerned organisation. Movement of Officers/Officials, involved in providing services such as Forest, Water Supply & Sanitation in Rural Areas, Disaster Management, Port and related services, Telecommunication shall be allowed after 9 pm on production of movement passes to be issued by the Office of District Magistrate.

Movement of personnel involved in providing essential/emergency services shall be allowed after 9 pm on production of e-passes to be issued by the Office of District Magistrate. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and also if any person attached with such organisation is found misusing the e-passes or using the same for purposes other than it is meant for, the owner/incharge shall be held responsible and he/she shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs. 10.000/ - and shall also be liable for action under DM Act. Movement of persons from containment zones shall be strictly restricted and shall only be permitted on case-to-case basis upon approval from the Office of District Magistrate.

Port services will continue to operate as usual and both essential and non-essential cargo can be moved in and out of port, as per requirement for loading/unloading/clearing of cargo and the same shall be permitted till 9 pm only. Movement passes for operation of cargo movement after 9 pm needs to be obtained, which shall be strictly permitted on case to case basis by the Office of the District Magistrate.

Construction activities shall be permitted till 9 pm. Construction activities of national importance and strategic projects beyond 9 pm shall be permitted with prior permission of District Magistrate and movement passes needs to be obtained, which shall be strictly permitted on case to case basis by the Office of the District Magistrate. Movement of persons involved with Hotels/Restaurants and Mess to be certified by the firm/organisation for home delivery of food shall be allowed till 9 pm on production of movement pass already issued by the District Magistrate. Dine-in shall be permitted between 6 am to 9 pm subject to 70% of the seating capacity and strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours. However, take away/parcel service and home delivery should be encouraged. It shall be the sole responsibility of the Owner/Incharge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and also if any person attached with such organisation is found misusing the movement pass or using the same for the purposes other than it is meant for, the Owner/Incharge will be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.10,000/- along with sealing of shop/establishment for 14 days and shall also be liable for action under DM Act.

Public transport/buses shall be allowed to ply with 70% of the capacity following COVID protocols. Sale and service of liquor at licensed premises shall be permitted till 9 pm with 70% seating capacity and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. SOPs and orders regarding the timings for sale and service of liquor at all licensed establishments (C, B1, B2 and B3 category) issued by the Deputy Commissioner North and Middle Andaman should be strictly adhered to. All Parks/Playgrounds/ Stadiums/Gyms and yoga institutes shall be permitted till 9 pm with 70% capacity and strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours. Any person violating the above directions shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.1000/- whereas the organization shall be fine to the tune of Rs. 10,000/-. All Religious places/places of worship are allowed to open till 9 pm with gathering not exceeding a maximum of 70% of the capacity of the hall and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The Management Committee of the religious places shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs. 10,000/- payable by the Committee. Religious places/places of worship in containment zones shall remain closed. Only those outside containment zones will be allowed to open up.

Social gatherings shall be allowed with 70% capacity of the hall and prior permission of the District Magistrate with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The parties concerned and management committee of the Hall/ Hotel shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/-.

Academic congregations shall be allowed with 70% seating capacity and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The Owner/Proprietor of the academic institutions/coaching centre shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/-.

Indoor sports activities shall be allowed with 70% capacity and strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The management of the indoor facility shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance and any violations of the directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.10,000/-. SOPs in this regard shall be issued by concerned department. The movement passes issued by the District Administration from 22nd May, 2021 onwards shall remain valid.

Now therefore, in view of the emergent circumstances, this order is being issued ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general. This order shall be promulgated in the North & Middle Andaman District. Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to note that these restrictions fundamentally relate to movement of people, but not to that of essential services.

Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 against the violator(s) and fine shall also be imposed as per order issued by this office from time to time.

This order shall has come into force from 4th January, 2022 and shall remain in force till 11th January, 2022. The order shall subsequently be reviewed after one week, the order issued by DM (N&MA) added.

It is, further, advised to all the passengers to adhere to the following measures while travelling on board

Vessels operating in the Harbour Sector and Foreshore Sector (Swaraj Dweep & Shaheed Dweep) shall carry only 70% of its carrying capacity with staggered seating arrangement thereby following safe social distancing
