Islands' pride - Ms Techa scripts history by becoming first Andamanese tribal girl to clear NEET

COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Sept. 13

One COVID positive case has been detected today in A&N Islands. Today, 11 flights with 1830 passengers arrived, out of which, 1699 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 87 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 18 passengers bound

for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 8 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. RAT was conducted on 9 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus and no positive case has been detected, a press release from IP&T said.

India to assume the Presidency of G20 for one year

New Delhi, Sept. 13

India will host the G20 Leaders' Summit at the level of Heads of State and Government on 9th and 10th September next year in New Delhi. India will assume the Presidency of the G20 for one year from 1st December this year to 30 November next year. It is expected to host over two hundred G20 meetings across the country.

The G20 is an intergovernmental forum

of the world's major developed and developing economies. It comprises of 19 countries including Australia, China, France, Germany, India, Italy, Japan, South Korea, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, UK, USA, and the European Union. Collectively, the G20 accounts for 85 per cent of global GDP, 75 per cent of international trade and two-thirds of the world population, making it the

premier forum for international economic cooperation. India is currently part of the G20 Troika comprising Indonesia, Italy and India. During the Presidency, India, Indonesia and Brazil would form the troika. This will be the first time when the troika would consist of three developing countries and emerging economies, providing them a greater voice. (Source: india.gov.in)

इन द्वीपों में हिन्दी उस समय से संपर्क भाषा बनी हुई जब 1858 में ब्रिटिश सरकार ने स्वाधीनता सेनानियों को कालेपानी की सजा देकर इस द्वीपसमूह में भेजा था। स्वाधीनता प्राप्ति के बाद इन द्वीपों में आए विभिन्न भाषा-भाषी भारतीयों ने राष्ट्र प्रेम दर्शाते हुए हिन्दी को सहर्ष सम्पर्क भाषा के रूप में अपनाया जो आज भी इस द्वीपसमूह की सम्पर्क भाषा बनी हुई है। हमें अपनी इस धरोहर को न सिर्फ बचाए रखना है बल्कि इसे और भी समृद्ध बनाना है।

इस वर्ष अण्डमान तथा निकोबार प्रशासन के सभी कार्यालयों में 14 से 28 सितम्बर, 2022 तक “हिन्दी पखवाड़ा” मनाया जाएगा। इस दौरान अण्डमान तथा निकोबार प्रशासन के कार्यालयों में अधिक से अधिक शासकीय कार्य हिन्दी में निपटाने के प्रयास किए जाएंगे। इसके साथ-साथ राजभाषा हिन्दी के व्यापक प्रचार-प्रसार के लिए अनेक कार्यक्रम और प्रतियोगिताएँ भी आयोजित करवाई जाएंगी। द्वीप प्रशासन के कार्यालयों में कार्यरत अधिकांश अधिकारियों और कर्मचारियों को हिन्दी का कार्यसाधक ज्ञान है और सभी कार्यालयों में कम्प्यूटर पर हिन्दी में काम करने की सुविधा उपलब्ध है। अतः इस दौरान अपना अधिक से अधिक कार्य हिन्दी में करें।

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands

2,75,103 beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far

Port Blair, Sept. 13

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,97,425 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the

age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,970 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years. 28,495 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years

have been administered both doses of vaccine. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at

Govt. gears up for mass cleanliness campaign on International Coastal Cleanliness on Sept. 17

New Delhi, Sept. 13

The Government is gearing up for a mass cleanliness campaign on International Coastal Cleanliness Day on the 17th of September. On the day, the 75-day long Swachh Sagar, Surakshit Sagar Campaign, which was initiated on 5th July this year, will also conclude.

Addressing a press conference in New Delhi today, Union Minister for Earth Sciences, Dr. Jitendra Singh said with the help of civil society, the Government is working towards imbuing the spirit of oceanic cleanliness among the people. Dr. Singh said, on the 17th of September, the coastal cleanup drive will

be carried out at 75 beaches across the country with 75 volunteers for every kilometer of the coastline.

The three underlying goals of the Swachh Sagar, Surakshit Sagar campaign are to Consume Responsibly, Segregate waste at home and Dispose of Responsibly. (Source:india.gov.in)

Govt. launches National List of Essential Medicines

New Delhi, Sept. 13

The Government has released 384 medicines under the National List of Essential Medicines (NLEM). Union Health Minister, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya released the updated version of NLEM 2022 today at an event in New Delhi. Dr. Mandaviya said NLEM plays an important role in ensuring the accessibility of affordable quality medicines at all levels of healthcare. Dr. Mandaviya said these medicines will improve the quality of health care. He elaborated that the list has been formulated after extensive consultations with the stakeholders. He added

that The National Pharma Pricing Authority will now determine and regulate the price of these medicines so that affordable medicines are available for the people.

Dr. Bharati Pawar, Minister of State said that under the leadership of Prime Minister, the Pharma sector is growing. She said the National List of essential medicines will guide and help the Pharma sector to work in tandem with the demands of the nation. She stressed the need to spread awareness about antimicrobial resistance.

The NLEM is a dynamic document and

is revised on a regular basis considering the changing public health priorities as well as advancements in pharmaceutical knowledge. The National List of Essential Medicines was first formulated in 1996 and it has been revised thrice in 2003, 2011 and 2015.

The NLEM 2022 contains 384 medicines as compared to 376 in NLEM, 2015. The medicines have now been categorized into 27 therapeutic categories. A new section has been added for medicines considered essential for the supportive management of COVID-19. (Source: india.gov.in)

Nationwide Vaccination Drive: over 215 crore 47 lakh vaccine doses administered so far

New Delhi, Sept. 13

More than 215 crore 47 lakh vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far under Nationwide Vaccination Drive. The Health Ministry said, over 21 lakh 67 thousand doses were administered in the last 24 hours. During the same period, 4 thousand 369 new COVID cases were reported in the country.

The country's active caseload currently stands at 46 thousand 347 and it is at 0.1 per cent. The recovery rate is currently at 98.71 per

cent. A total of 5 thousand 178 people have recovered in the last 24 hours and with this, the total recoveries touched over four crore 39 lakh. The Ministry said, the Weekly Positivity Rate stands at 1.73 per cent and the Daily Positivity Rate is at 1.25 per cent.

A total of more than 88 crore 99 lakh COVID tests have been conducted in the country so far. In the last 24 hours, around 3 lakh 50 thousand tests were conducted. (Source: india.gov.in)
