Former Chairperson of Muricipal Council, Mr K Ganeshan says that there are many students who tell him that they sit clueless "Lack of teachers as teachers are forced to teach subjects they themselves don't understand well. The Department of

Ministry of Human Resource Development had directed the UT Administration to fll up 570 posts of elementary schools, 20 posts of elementary schools, 20 posts of Headmasters/Principals and 100 posts of subject teachers in secondary schools by August2020. Various political parties have time and again raised the issue of shortage ofteachers in gov ernment schools before various authorities. However the Directorate of Education has taken no steps in this regard. It should im med ally acant posts in the larger interest offthe students in these islands, said Mr Ganeshan.

It may be recalled that in

December 2019, Mr Kuldeep Rai Sharma. Member of Parliament raised the issue of shortage of Principal, Vice Principal and

Parliament had stated that though there are 329 Gov ernment schools there are 329 Gov ernment scrools in the Islands out of which there are 46 Gov tSenior Secondary Schools, only nine posts of Principals have been filled in sofar. He also stated that out of 182 Primary schools only 46 ceabs filled mades have been been solved. 46 posts of Head masters have been filled up. "Since 2013 no post of Principal has been filled in whereas since 2017 no post of Head master has been filled. In Andaman and Nicobar Islands there remains acute shortage of Principal, Head Master and teaching staff and informed the Parliament that in these Islands there are lots of CTET passed unemployed teachers, who can be accommodated to these vacant nosts for which immediate remedial action is needed to be

Port Blair. Dec 08: The Port Blair, Dec US: The shattered family of 25 year old, Mithun Das, performed the final rites of the deceased at their native place in Madhupur, Diglipur on Tuesday. Hundreds of villagers of the area attended the funeral ceremony. While praying for eternal peace for the departed soul, the villagers rued the poor health care services at the lone referral hospital, GB Pant Hospital reieria hospital, GB Parit hospital at Port Blair, forwhich the 25 year old bst his life, as per reports. This daily reported that the deceased, Mithun Das, accidently fell from the fourth foor ofhis residence at around 8 am on Dec 1. He was immediately shifted to GB Pant Hospital for treatment. In the absence of a Radiologist, CT Scan could not be performed and doctors attending the patient recommended an X-Ray to ascertain the extent of injuries sustained in the mishap. India-Chinatalks The Indian delegation arrived in Beijing on December 6 night to start talks on the Sino-Indian border dispute. Eric Consalves, head of the delegation, told reporters it would be premature to forecast what would happen during the talks. "But we come with expectations of making further progress, "he said. Gonsalves was received at the airport by Chinese Vice-Foreign Minister Han Nainlong, who will head the Chinese side at the talks. This is the first time in 21 years that the two sides will sit together to begin sorting out the tangled border question, which New Delhi believes continues to stand in the way of the complete normalisation of ties between the two countries. The last time officials from India and China had discussions on the issue was in November 1960 in Rangoon — those talks were unsuccessful. SouthAfrica

South African soldiers knocked out the central headquarters of the South-West Africa People's Organisation during their deepening invasion of Angola since the 1975 Angolan war, a military spokesman said on Monday. However, the spokesman said the three-week operation that ended on November 20 but was only disclosed on Monday was much smaller than an invasion launched in August. Unlike the August operation, there was no contact with Angolan forces or their Soviet advisers during the 240 km deep strike, the spokesman said.

FUTURE LOOKS PROSPEROUS FOR FOOD SERVICE INDUSTRY; ORGANISED PLAYERS WITNESSING RAPID GROWTH

The Indian food service industry), which is around Rs 4.2 trillion, is expected to see healthy growth of nineper cent CAGR over the financial year 2020-25. This is mainly due to the rising income levels, urbanisation, thensing income levels, urranisation, innovative offerings that appeal to the youth, and the changing dynamics of the sector with the growth of online fooddeliver yand food technology.



RBI MONETARY POLICY: EXPERTS FORESEE **INTEREST RATE HIKES IN 2022**

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI)'s economistat CRISIL monetary policy committee (MPC) left its benchmark reporate as well as the reverse reporate unchanged on Wednesday, while also maintaining its accommodative policy stance. This was the ninth consecutive time that the MPC This was the nirth consecutive time that the MPC left the reportate on hold affour per cent, as a resurgence of COVID-19 cases in many countries and a fast-preading new virus statin add to uncertainties at a time the economic recovery in the country was seen gathering

recovery in the county was seen gathering momentum.

The policy was as expected and cautious on the uncertainty due to the Omicron variant. Also, the RBI continued with the liquidity normalisation on expected lines without any explict signal offquidity withdraw at The inflation estimates are also lower than what themarkets are expecting. Broadly, the policy is more dovish than expected possibly given the uncertainty from the new COVID-19 variant," said Suvodeep Rakshit, senior economistal Kotek Institutional Equities.

The RBI left India's GDP growth freecast unchanged at 9.5 per cent for the year ending March 2022, while also martaring the consumer/lation expectation at 3.5 per cent.

While the MPC chose to keep the interest rates on hold, it did amiounce further steps to unwindthe excess fluidity that was injected in the system in the wake of the pandemic and plans to enhance the 41-day variable reverse repor ate auction amounts on a fortrightly bass. In doing so, thecental bank tried to strike a balance between supporting the ongoing economic procurs and resonance in challenges.

a balance between supporting the ongoing economic recovery and responding b challenges emanating from inflationary pressures and external risks, said Dharmakirti Joshi, chief

economistat CRISIL.

"The MPC is taking cautious steps towards normalising policy as the Indian economic recovery emains uneven, with private consumption trailing pre-pandemic levels until the second quarter, "said Joshi.

He, however, feels the RBI may not have leeway b sand patin he coming months, given the risks from pensishminifation and he US Federal Reserve expected to withdraw their monetary policy stimulus sooner than earlier expected.

CRISIL expects the MPC to raise the reverserepor rate in February to reduce the gap with the repor ate and then hike thereporate by 25 bass points in March.
