Citizens demand operation of MV Swaraj Dweep in PB-C/Bay sector

Port Blair, Oct 12: The cancellation of sailing of MV Swaraj Dweep to Chennai due to non-availability of adequate passengers has given an opportunity to the Shipping department to operate bigger vessels like MV Swaraj Dweep in the Port Blair-Campbell Bay sector. The vessel can be operated between Port Blair and southern group of islands especially for Campbell Bay as this vessel is currently berthed with idle. The Directorate of Shipping Services have been drawing flak from the general public for non-operating sufficient vessels in the southern group of islands due to shortage of ships. Lack of boat services to various remote and far off places in the islands has spawned a wave of resentment among the residents living in remote parts of the islands. In the absence of boat services in the Inter-island sector, people in the region have been left harried, mainly students who have to appear in various examinations from time to time. By acting smart, the Director of Shipping Services can use the services of MV Swaraj Dweep to Campbell Bay as the department is already making salary and other payments to the officers and crew members of this vessel. Since the vessel has now cancelled its trip to Chennai due to insufficient passengers, the vessel can be operated in the Port Blair and Campbell Bay sector, feel some citizens. People of outer islands have been facing problems due to non-availability of adequate boat services. "In the absence of boat services, several students and the general public of other islands have been facing hardship."



MP demands 24 hrs. electricity supply in Hanspuri, urges for setting up of a powerhouse for this region

Port Blair, Oct 12: The Member of Parliament, Shri. Kuldeep Rai Sharma has requested the Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Andaman and Nicobar Islands to arrange to supply 24 hour electricity in Hanspuri area of North and Middle Andaman. The Member of Parliament has also requested to set up a powerhouse for the region. In a letter addressed to the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, the Member of Parliament said that during his recent visit to Mayabunder region, he has been informed by villagers and PRI members of Hanspuri area of N & M Andaman that power is supplied in Hanspuri area for only seven hours a day i.e. from morning 4.00 AM to 6.00 AM and evening 05.30 PM to 10.30 PM. He added that power supply only for seven hours a day is not only causing huge problems to the residents of the area but also adversely affecting the studies of children of the region. The Member of Parliament mentioned that the villagers are unable to use water pumps and other tools for cultivation due to non availability of power for most of the time in a day in the region.

Services of MVF Kadamtala withdrawn

Port Blair, Oct 12: In order to carry out repairs of the damaged ramp of the vehicle ferry vessel MVF Kadamtala, presently operating between Middle Strait and Baratang, her services would be withdrawn with effect from Oct 12, 2022. With the withdrawal of vehicle ferry vessel MVF Kadamtala from the above route, services of only two vehicle ferry vessels would be available for transshipment of passengers and vehicles in between Middle Strait and Baratang, which may cause some inconvenience to the commuters, which is deeply regretted. All commuters have been requested to cooperate and plan their journey accordingly. Nevertheless, best efforts are being put in by the Directorate of Shipping Services to repair the vessel expeditiously so that the services of MVF Kadamtala can be resumed in the above route at the earliest.

Act quickly

The Supreme Court appears to agree that hate speech is a big negative for social peace. The key point is what are the deterrents against those talking up hate. The latest high-profile hate speech controversy involves two BJP elected representatives at a VHP event. Delhi police has filed an FIR on this. In May, a PFI march in Kerala saw a minor chanting violent threats against two other communities. And last December, there was a flood of hate speech at the "Dharm Sansad" in Haridwar.

Tracking forward from last December, it can be reasonably argued that the lack of quick and meaningful police and legal action against hate speech encourages more such statements and rhetoric. Police forces sometimes file FIR, after a big delay, the cases start trundling through lower courts, once in a while SC agrees to take up a matter, but even SC is overburdened ... and so goes this depressing story. The other part of this story is that with a few welcome exceptions, political parties rarely act against their own.

It must start with the cops. Police forces have to be vigilant and proactive, lodging clearly argued FIRs immediately, making arrests, filing chargesheets and energetically pursuing trials. But cops will do this regularly only when the leadership of all political parties show zero tolerance for hate speech. Courts, especially higher courts, need to push matters along, pulling up lower courts suo motu, if necessary. There have been court-monitored investigations using the doctrine of continuing mandamus. SC and high courts should prioritise a few hate speech cases for supervision. A separate law on hate speech is unnecessary. We don't need another law that can be wilfully misinterpreted. What we need is some hate speech givers to quickly pay for what they have said.

THAILAND MASSACRE: TROUBLED MURDERER HAD DRUG ISSUES, WAS SPIRALLING

The former police sergeant behind the Thailand nursery massacre was a troubled, hot-tempered man who battled drug issues. Panya Khamrap, 34, was a user of methamphetamine, also known as yaba, and was fired from his job in January for drug possession, said a report.

However, police officials said they did not find any trace of drugs in Panya's system on the day of the killings last Thursday, reported Reuters.

According to Thailand's deputy police chief General Surachate Hakparn, the violence resulted from "exploded emotion", caused by his dismissal from service and legal, money, and family troubles.

The report, which traced Khamrap's movements on the fateful day which ended with him murdering 36 people, including 22 nursery children, revealed that the former officer used to spend nights firing guns in his

backyard.

The villager, who grew up in the remote village of Tha Uthai and graduated from a top Bangkok university, faced personal issues following the breakdown of his marriage. He shifted from Bangkok's wealthiest neighbourhoods to his home village after a divorce in 2020.

Soon, Khamrap moved in with a woman who worked at a karaoke bar and her son. Both were killed last

Thursday.

The villagers knew of his temper and the village chief too had warned Khamrap several times, but the latter was too scared to do anything, according to Suwan Tonsomsen, Khamrap's neighbour.

On the day of the massacre, neighbours heard him arguing with his girlfriend, who told him that she was leaving him. Khamrap also had a court appointment on drug charges

the same day, the verdict of which was expected the next day.

On Thursday, around midday, Khamrap left in a white pick-up truck. He reportedly crashed into a man on a motorcycle outside a shop before shooting the rider. After that, Khamrap drove to an intersection where he rammed into a group of people. He left his truck and stabbed them. Three died and several were wounded, according to the Reuters report.

It was from there that Khamrap drove into the administrative complex where the Uthai Sawan Child Development Centre, a pink, one-storey building, is located. The children were on their afternoon nap when the murderer arrived.

What ensued was a rampage with Khamrap attacking people, shooting some and slashing others. "Everything happened so quickly and there was blood everywhere. I saw the wounded and dead sitting

together at a table as if nothing had happened," office worker Kittsak Polpraksa told Reuters.

He then entered the nursery, kicked it open and went on a murderous spree for the next 20 minutes. Besides the 22 children, two teachers, one eight-months pregnant, too were brutally murdered. He then drove back to his neighbourhood where his neighbour approached him. "What are you doing?" the man asked. "I'm here to fucking kill you," Khamrap replied. He killed two people there. He walked back to his house where, at around 3 p.m., he burned his truck, and shot his girlfriend, her son and then himself. Meanwhile, his neighbour Suwan Tonsomsen recalls frantically calling the police. "They said there were not enough police," she said, and they had to wait for a commando unit. "It took them a while," she said. Police chief Surachate Hakparn too acknowledged that the police response had been slow and officers arrived too late to stop the killing.

DC(SA) expedites inspection of survey, registration process of Inland vessel

Port Blair, Oct 12: The District Administration has been receiving complaints regarding considerable delay in survey and registration/re-validation of Inland Vessel since the inspection by Surveyors from Port Management Board and District Administration was done separately. Taking in view the hardships faced by the vessel owner, a meeting was called by the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman with all stakeholders and it was decided that the inspection shall be conducted jointly by the team of Port Management Board and District Administration on a single

day. This will reduce the time taken for inspection procedure which normally requires 2-3 months and now the whole procedure shall be completed with 20-25 days. All inland vessel owners under the jurisdiction of South Andaman District is hereby informed that to reduce the time for survey and registration/revalidation of the vessels a Single Window System for survey and registration/revalidation of the Inland vessel has been introduced and that henceforth, the team for Joint Inspection of the Inland vessel by Surveyors from Port Management Board and

staff from District Administration shall be available at the office of the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman. Standard Operating Procedures for entire registration/survey/re-validation has been devised which shall be modulated and managed at a single delivery point. The documents required for initial and periodical survey, first time registration as well as for revalidation of registration certificate have been uploaded and general public may follow the link for required documentation in the web portal www.edistrictandaman.gov.in. - Source : DCSA

PS Diglipur team cracks burglary case, accused arrested

Port Blair, Oct 12: As part of zero tolerance policy against crime, PS Diglipur staff cracked a burglary case within a short span of time and arrested one accused person and recovered the stolen cash and other articles. On 23/09/2022, a burglary case was reported at PS Diglipur that contained cash of Rs. 86,000/- (eighty six thousand rupees), Gold ornaments (02 nos. Rings - 04 grams and a pair of gold earrings - 06 grams were stolen from the house of Shri. Naresh Halder. Upon this, an FR was registered at PS Diglipur and 02 teams were

constituted for the search of the accused and stolen cash & gold ornaments. The general public were also sensitized about the incident of burglary in their locality. On 10/10/2022, some villagers of Rabindra Pally village, Diglipur informed PS Diglipur that they have apprehended one person suspected to be the accused of the burglary case. CABINET APPROVES PM-DEVINE SCHEME FOR DEVELOPMENT OF NORTHEAST

The union cabinet has approved a new scheme, Prime Minister's Development Initiative for North East Region (PM-DevINE), to fund infrastructure projects in the North East India.

The PM-DevINE Scheme will have an outlay of Rs 6,600 crore for the four year period from 2022-23 to 2025-26 (remaining years of 15th Finance Commission period). The new scheme will get 100 per cent central funding and will be implemented by the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (DoNER).

Information and Broadcasting minister Anurag Thakur said that efforts will be made to complete the PM-DevINE projects by 2025-26 so that there were no committed liabilities beyond this year.

"This implies front-loading of the sanctions under the Scheme in 2022-23 and 2023-24 primarily. While expenditure would continue to be incurred during 2024-25 and 2025-26, focused attention will be given to complete the sanctioned PM-DevINE projects." PM-DevINE will lead to creation of infrastructure, support industries, social development projects and create livelihood activities for youth and women, thus leading to employment generation. "There are other MDONER Schemes for the development of the North Eastern Region. The average size of projects under other MDONER Schemes is about Rs.12 crore only. PM-DevINE will



provide support to infrastructure and social development projects which may be larger in size and will also provide an end-to-end development solution instead of isolated projects. It will be ensured that there is no duplication of project support under PM-DevINE with any of the other schemes of MDONER or those of any other ministry," cabinet release said.

PM-DevINE was announced in the Union Budget 2022-23 to address

development gaps in the North Eastern Region (NER). "Announcement of PM-DevINE is yet another instance of the importance being attached to the development of NE Region by the Government. PM-DevINE is an addition to the quantum of resources available for the development of the NER. It will not be a substitute for existing Central and State Schemes," the government said.

Centre approves one-time grant of Rs 22,000 crore to public OMCs

The cabinet, on Wednesday, approved the proposal of ministry of petroleum & natural gas to give a one-time grant of Rs. 22,000 crore to three public sector undertaking oil Marketing Companies (PSU OMCs). The grant will be distributed among Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL), Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL) and Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited

(HPCL).

Information and Broadcasting Minister Anurag Thakur said between June 2020 and June 2022, the international prices of LPG increased by around 300 per cent. However, to insulate consumers from fluctuations in international LPG prices, the cost increase was not fully passed on to consumers of domestic LPG. Accordingly, domestic LPG prices have raised

by only 72 per cent during this period. This led to significant losses for these OMCs. The grant given by the central government is to overcome the losses.

The minister said the cabinet approval will help the PSU OMCs to continue their commitment to the Amanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan, ensuring unhindered domestic LPG supplies. Domestic LPG cylinders are supplied at regulated prices to consumers by the public sector oil marketing companies namely, IOCL, BPCL, HPCL. "Despite these losses, the three PSU OMCs have ensured continuous supplies of this essential cooking fuel in the country."

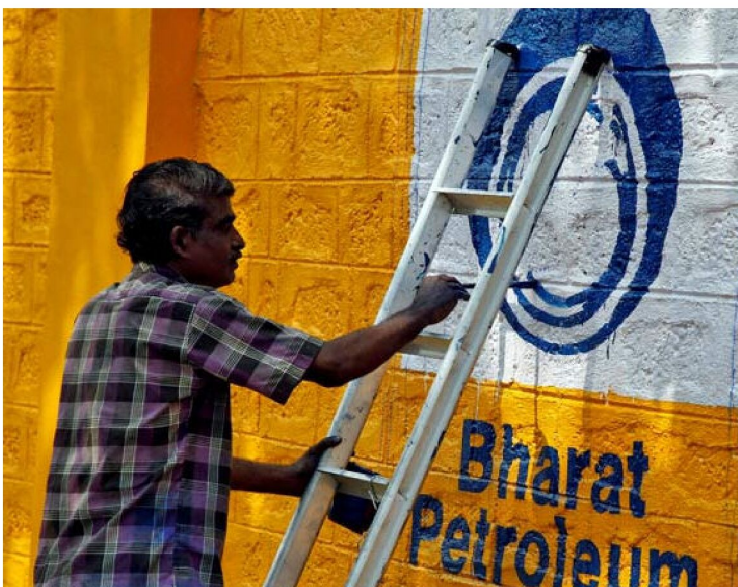
Bonus for railway employees The Union cabinet gave its ex-post facto approval for payment of

productivity linked Bonus to railway employees for the financial year 2021-22. The financial implication of payment of 78 days PLB to railway employees has been estimated to be Rs.1,832.09 crore.

The payment of PLB to eligible railway employees is made each year before the Dusshera and Puja holidays. "This year also, PLB amount equivalent to 78 days wages has been paid to about 11.27 lakh non-gazetted railway employees. The maximum amount payable per eligible railway employee is Rs. 17,951/- for 78 days. The above amount has been paid to various categories - track maintainers, drivers, guards, station masters, supervisors, technicians, technician helpers, controllers, points men, ministerial staff and other Group 'C' staff."

The actual number of PLB days paid is more than the days worked out on the basis of defined formula. The payment of PLB acts as an incentive to motivate the railway employees for working towards improvement in the performance of the railways.
