## Committee asked to follow up with each Secretary after every 15 days

Port Blair, April 13

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain has formed a Committee under Shri Dilkhush Meena, SDM (SA) to follow up the action taken and action proposed during the visit of the Chief Secretary to Sippighat, Dhanikhari, Guptapara, Manglutan, and Manjery villages in

South Andaman. He has been asked to follow up with each Secretary after every 15 days.

It may be recalled that the Chief Secretary during his extensive visit to these villages on April 9, had asked the concerned authorities to take up developmental activities on priority basis. He also directed that grievances

conducted by Union Public Service Commission (UPSC); State Public Service Commissions (SPSCs) for Group A and B (Gazetted and non-gazetted posts Staff Selection Commission (Combined Graduate Level), CAPF for Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted posts).

**Implementing Agency and Eligibility:** Ministry of Minority Affairs will be the implementing agency and only candidates belonging to notified Minority Communities who clear the Prelim examinations conducted by UPSC/SPSC or SSC etc. and fulfill all other eligibility criteria and conditions will be considered for financial support under the scheme. The eligibility criteria and conditions of the Scheme will be as follows:

- The candidate should belong to one of the Minority Communities notified under Section 2(C) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992 and should have passed any of the Prelim exams conducted by UPSC, SPSC, or SSC listed at Para 5 of the scheme.
- Total family income of the candidates from all sources should not exceed Rs. 8.0 lakh per annum.
- The financial support can be availed by a candidate only once. The candidate will not be eligible to benefit from any other similar Scheme of the Central or State Governments/UT Administrations. In case the candidate decides to opt for other Schemes; he/she will have to forgo the claim from this Ministry and refund the amount if already availed with 10% interest. He/she needs to give an affidavit to the effect, that he/she is not availing such benefit from any other source.

**Procedure:** Eligible candidates may apply online through the portal i.e. [www.naiudaanmoma.gov.in](http://www.naiudaanmoma.gov.in) for availing the benefit under the Scheme within one month from the date of declaration of the result along with all requisite documents. However, Selection Committee can also consider applications received even after one-month time, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.

## COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, April 13

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 132 incoming flight passengers yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 9 flights with 1238 passengers arrived, out of which, 1090 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was

conducted on 118 passengers and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 51 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Helipad, 8 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 37 passengers and no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 40 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

The Melas will also help in making people aware about the various health programmes being implemented by the Administration besides it will also create awareness on different Health programmes with focus on Ayushman Bharat Health & Wellness Centre and issuance of Ayushman Bharat e-Cards on the spot. During the mela, creation of Unique Health ID under Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission for attendees will be facilitated besides provision of Ayushman Bharat Card under Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana. It will also increase health awareness of the population for prevention of various communicable and non-communicable diseases and provide screening for early diagnosis, basic health care services with drugs and diagnostics, tele-consultation with relevant health specialists and referrals as needed. During the mela, Mobile Food Testing Vans (Food Safety on Wheels) will be deployed for generating awareness on 'Eat Right Movement India' and demonstration of food samples. It will also generate awareness and display IEC on 'Fit India Movement'. Apart from this, multiple activities under 'Khelo India' programmes will be organized for diverse audience. Wellness-related activities like Yoga, Zumba, Meditation etc. will also be conducted for the mela attendees.

The mela aims to generate awareness on kitchen gardens, medicinal plants and home remedies. Services through AYUSH clinics and deployment of Ayushman School Health & Wellness Ambassadors will be provided during the mela. Stalls will also be set up to educate communities about Ayushman Bharat Health & Wellness Ambassador, Health messengers and school health and wellness day will be organised in schools.

The District Women & Child Development teams will engage Anganwadi Workers for community sensitisation about Health Mela and mobilize communities for Health Mela. Issuance of Unique Disability Identity cards for Divyang, awareness on Village Health Sanitation & Nutrition Day for early childhood development, nutrition and sanitation will be organised across the block including awareness generation and display of IEC on POSHAN Abhiyan including take-home ration, nutrition education, immunization, etc.

PRIs have to conduct Special Gram Sabhas before the Health Mela for ensuring community mobilization for Health Melas using local announcement and awareness generation mechanisms. Stalls will be set up to popularize Govt. programs like housing, sanitation etc. offered by the PRI and ULBs. Competitions, seminars & contests under the themes 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' #Movement of Freedom Struggle 75 Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, #Ideas 75 Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, #Resolve 75 Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, Action#75 75 Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, Achievements #75 Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav will be organized.

The private clinics will provide private doctors services/ free consultation while the NGOs will conduct cultural / entertainment activities. The Deputy Commissioner (SA) has urged the general public to participate in the Health Mela and avail the services of the Govt. to keep the community healthy and to build a healthy nation, a press release from Deputy Commissioner (SA)/ Chairman, DHS (SA) said.

vegetable & fruit bearing trees, rainwater harvesting activities and rural tourism promotion in the Gram Panchayats. As such, he urged the Gram Panchayats to work in the said lines to prove their respective Gram Panchayat as the best.

The Pradhans and Panchayat Secretaries were made aware about the administrative & financial rules and responsibilities for effective working of the Gram Panchayat. Smt. Kakali Ghosh, Panchayat Secretary explained about the Gram Panchayat Development Plan (GPDP) to be prepared for implementation of various schemes of RD as well as Line Department for the development of the Gram Panchayat and its residents. The Pradhans were requested to make proper selection of works and to take up them as per the priority of public. Thereafter, Shri Edmond Fernandez, Panchayat Secretary explained about the technicalities and responsibilities of the Gram Panchayat in issuance of Building Permission for construction of buildings in the Gram Panchayats. Subsequently, Smt. Gurjeet Kaur, Extension Officer acquainted the participants about the role and responsibilities of the Gram Panchayat in the implementation of various Rural Development schemes of GOI such as DAY-NRLM, PMAY-G, SBM-G, MGNREGA, RURBAN, SAGY, PMGSY, RGSA.

The Sr. Accounts Officer, Shri Anil Koshi, explained about financial powers and obligations of the Gram Panchayats and requested the Pradhans and Panchayat Secretaries for optimal utilization of fund allocated to the Panchayats. He stressed on the use of GeM for procurements under the Gram Panchayats and timely submission of Utilization Certificates. Later, Sr. Accounts Officer, Shri P.S. Satish explained about the use of PFMS for utilization of funds released to the Gram Panchayats and requested to get onboard of PFMS platform.
