Nation bids adieu to country's first CDS General Bipin Rawat

New Delhi, Dec. 10

The country's first Chief of Defence Staff (CDS) General Bipin Rawat was laid to final rest today with full military honours, 17-gun salute at Brar Square Crematorium in Delhi Cantonment. His last rites were performed along with his wife Madhulika Rawat, who too lost her life in Tamil Nadu Chopper Crash. Their daughters Kritika and Tarini performed their last rites. The funeral procession carrying the Mortal remains of General Rawat and Madhulika Rawat began at 2 pm from his official residence three Kamraj Marg. As the mortal remains carried in a casket wrapped in a tricolour, was moved to a gun carriage, decorated with flowers, people showered petals and raised slogans in his praise. Military personnel drawn from all the three



services marched towards the streets as drummers played along in tribute to India's first Chief of Defence Staff. Thousands thronged the route taken by General Rawat's procession to pay last respects to the country's first Chief of Defence Staff were raising slogans of Bharat Mata Ki Jai, General Rawat Amar Rahe and Uttarakhand ka heera. A total of 800 service personnel were in attendance for the military funeral of the CDS. With moist eyes

people from various walks of life bid tearful adieu to General Rawat at Brar Square crematorium. Defence Minister, Shri Rajnath Singh, the three service chiefs were among those who paid their last respects at the Brar square crematorium. Earlier, the mortal remains of General Rawat and his wife were kept at their official residence before cremation, to allow people to pay respects. (Source: india.gov.in)

Former Pradhan and Panchayat Secretary convicted in misappropriation of Gram Panchayat fund case

In an old case of corruption relating to misappropriation of Gram Panchayat fund, the Hon'ble Court of Judicial Magistrate, First Class, North & Middle Andaman, Mayabunder presided over by Shri Vikramjit Sen had convicted, Shri Rangolal Halder, former Pradhan and Shri T. Hari Krishna, former Panchayat Secretary of

Dasarathpur Gram Panchayat. The Hon'ble Court has imposed sentence of three years of imprisonment on both the convicts and fine of Rs. 10,000/- was also imposed on them.

The case, as per information received, was registered against nine accused persons in the year 2007 in Police Station Rangat for misappropriation and cheating under various sections of

Indian Penal Code. The Hon'ble Court after trial found, Shri Rangolal Halder, the former Pradhan and Shri T. Hari Krishna, the former Panchayat Secretary to be guilty of the offence under section 409 R.W.S. 34 of IPC for misappropriation of public fund belonging to Dasarathpur Gram Panchayat. accused persons as it was observed in the judgement that the Prosecution could not fully establish the guilt of the rest of the accused persons. It is pertinent to mention here that the FIR was registered on the basis of the written complaint lodged by one Govindo Chandra Das, a resident of Dasarathpur village under Rangat Tehsil. The Prosecution version was that the accused persons colluded and conspired to show an existing old pond in the land of Govindo Chandra Das as a newly dug-up pond by the said Gram Panchayat. For that project, an amount of Rs. 98,410/- was also spent from the Gram Panchayat Fund which was sanctioned by the then Pradhan, Shri Rangolal Halder and Panchayat Secretary, Shri Hari Krishna. The Hon'ble Judge in his judgement had observed that although the Prosecution had failed to prove all the charges framed against accused persons but it had established the offence punishable under section 409/34 of IPC against two accused persons namely Shri Rangola Halder and T. Hari Krishna.

Giving benefit of doubt, rest of the seven accused persons were acquitted. While sentencing the convicts, the Hon'ble Court observed that the corrupt practice adopted by the convicts for misutilization of Government fund cannot be overlooked and proper sentence and punishment has to be imposed against them so that sufficient message is sent out to the society at large. The two convicts were granted bail when they applied for preferring appeal against the order of conviction passed by the Trial Court. The Prosecution was conducted by Shri Pradeep Ram, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor, Mayabunder, a press release from APP said.
