

Chief Secretary envisions free & transparent procedure for grant of permission for earth cutting; orders entire process may be made online immediately

District Administration (SA) to launch online permission for Earth cutting shortly

Port Blair, April 26

The major chunk of land in A&N Islands is under forest cover and land is scarcely available for other uses such as agriculture, dwelling and developmental projects. Out of the available land, earth cutting, levelling, transportation and dumping of earth is required to develop the same for various purposes. However, to keep the ecology of the Islands and to maintain the environmental balance, the cutting of earth and its movement from one place to another requires clearance and permission of the concerned Deputy Commissioners, which is given strictly on the basis of the recommendations by the field functionaries based on the importance and requirements of the activities to be carried out on the particular

land.

Keeping in view the huge demand for such permissions from the local populace, to have a free and transparent procedure to grant permission for earth cutting and to maintain the ecology of the Island and to address the environmental concerns and further to have a check on the illegal activities that are being reported over the whole process, the Chief Secretary, A&N Islands, Shri Jitendra Narain, IAS has envisaged that the entire process may be made online immediately. He had in this regard held a discussion with the officials of the Revenue Department wherein he has directed that special attention may be given to scientific earth cutting and also to monitor contour cutting of the earth and the entire process of involving the grant of

earth cutting permission may be made online at the earliest and further directed to take stringent and strict actions against those who are involved in illegal earth cutting activities. The Chief Secretary directed that the field functionaries should keep pictures of pre and post status of the particular land for records and future references. The Chief Secretary also ordered to prepare a proposal to increase the earth cutting fees manifold.

Acting on the directions of the Chief Secretary, the District Administration under the guidance of the DC(SA) has already started to work on the modalities to develop a software for grant of permission for earth cutting and shall make the entire process on online mode very shortly, a press release from Deputy Commissioner (SA) said.

DCGI grants emergency use authorization to Covaxin, Corbevax and ZyCoV-D COVID vaccines for children of different age groups

Drugs Controller General of India (DCGI) has given restricted emergency use authorization to Bharat Biotech's Covaxin for children. The approval has been given for the children between the age of six to twelve years. It has also granted emergency use authorization to Corbevax for those aged between five to twelve years. In a tweet, Union Health Minister, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya said, the DCGI has also granted emergency use authorization to ZycovD for children above the age of 12 years for a two-dose regime. DoT A&N tests 361 out of 744 BTS till date

Conducts EMF radiation awareness session

Port Blair, April 26

The need for telecom services has gone up in an unprecedented manner in recent times. There is an immediate need for faster expansion of telecom infrastructure in A&N Islands. This calls for speedy deployment of towers to expand the coverage. DoT has planned to provide 4G mobile coverage by installing 128 towers for covering 85 uncovered villages and along NH-04 in A&N Islands. However, due to misconceptions and misinformation, public at some locations are apprehensive whenever a tower is proposed in the vicinity of residence etc.

DoT A&N team conducted an EMF awareness session today at Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK), Sippighat to create awareness and dispel myths about concerning EMF emissions from mobile towers among farmers



group of KVK. The session was inaugurated by Shri KP Mohan, Deputy Director General, DoT and attended by Officers from KVK and farmers.

A presentation was given by Shri Atul Kumar Kareliya, Director Telecom, DoT, it was informed that Government of India has adopted stringent norms by adopting 1/10th of the prescribed International EMF radiation limit. DoT has also created a mechanism to ensure that radiation limits from telecom towers are maintained by all telecom service providers (TSPs) within limits. All TSPs have to give periodic self

certificates to this effect and DoT field offices have been mandated to audit 10% BTS every year. Further, it was informed that so far, DoT A&N has tested 361 out of 744 BTS till 26th April, 2022 in Andaman and Nicobar UT and found radiation level for all tested towers are well within the permissible radiation level.

Apart from this, DoT has created a portal www.tarangsanchargov.in wherein there is a provision for the general public to see the radiation level of towers in their vicinity by entering their area postal PIN code, a press release from DoT A&N said.

The Principal/Deputy Apprenticeship Advisor, Government Industrial Training Institute (ITI), A&N Administration, Dollygunj, Shri Venketesh. CH through a power point presentation enlightened the gathering about the skill development training programmes being conducted in all the three ITIs of A&N Islands.

The Secretary also interacted with the employers present at the Marine Workshop, the venue where the recruitment/ registration of the aspirants was arranged. An overwhelming response was witnessed at the venue wherein candidates having passed 12th, Skill Training Certificate holders, ITI diploma holders, and graduates were seen registering and interacting with the employers present.

While speaking to our Reporter at the venue, aspirants spoke about the opportunities available for people to acquire training in various trades. One of the aspirant, Shri Sunil Kujur, ITI passed out (2020-21 batch) said, it was a good opportunity for the unemployed youth to get registered with the employers so that they can get a breakthrough for job as per their trades/ courses.

At the end of the National Apprenticeship Mela 2022, altogether 1500 aspirational unemployed youth were registered on GoI's Portal as prospective candidates to undergo apprenticeship training for their gainful employment.
