Restricting fast-food perhaps isn't a bad idea, particularly for young people amongst whom research indicates it is both a consequence of and cause for mental lightens. Parliament passes bill to repeal three farm laws

Parliamenton Monday passed Farm Laws Repeal Bill, to repeal the three contentious laws against which farmers have been protesting for over a year. The bill was passed in the Lok Sabha on was passed in the Lok Sabna on the very first day of the winter session, amid ruckus from opposition leaders demanding a discussion. The bill, however, was passed without any discussion after itwas introduced by Union Minister Narendra Singh Tomar. The emposition sought a debate on the opposition sought a debate on the bill and came to the well of the House raising slogans and banners. Speaker Om Birla said that he was opposition continued the protests, the Speaker announced the passage of the bill after voice vote. In the Raiva Sabha, before the motion was adopted for the passage of the bill, Deputy Chairman Harivansh allowed Leader of Opposition Mallikarjun Kharge to speak for two minutes. Kharge was of the view that the government has taken back the three farm laws in view of the forthcoming elections in five states after reviewing the results of recent by polls. Bharatiy a Kisan Union leader Rakesh Tikait called it a tribute to farmers who lost their lives in the agitation. He, however

farmers who lost their lives during the agitation. The protest will continue as other issues including MSP are still pending," Tikait told ANI On Saturday, farmers deferred their 'sansad chalo', or 'march to Parliament call, which was nitially scheduled for Monday. "We are postponing 'Parliament march' for November 29. In a special address to he nation, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on November 19 announced that all three farm laws, which were passed by Parliament in September last vear, will be repealed in the winter ready for he debate provided here is order in the House. Researchers try producing potato resistant to climate change

University of Maine researchers are trying to produce potatoes that can better withstand warming temperatures as the climate changes.

Warming temperatures and an extended growing season can lead to quality problems and disease, Gregory Porter, a professor of crop ecology and management, told the Bargor Dally Moure.

The predictions for climate change are heavierrainfall events, and potatoes don'ttolerate flooding or wetconditions for long without having otherquality problems, Porter said. If we wan potatoes to be continued to be produced successfully in Maine, we need to be able to produce varieties that can be resistant to change.

Around the world, research aimed at mitigating crop damage is underway. A NASA study published this month suggests climate change may affect the production of corn and

charge may alter the production to com and wheat reducingly elids of both, as soon as 2030.

Maine is coming off of a banner potable crop thanks in partth he success offhe Carbou russet, which was developed by UMaine researchers. But Porter fears that even that variety isn't as healtotlerantas necessary to resist the future effects of climate change.

Pests are another factor. The Colorado potato beete and disease-spreading aphids have Flourished with the changing climate, said Jim Dill, pest management specialist at the University of Maine Cooperative Ex basion. Breeding seemingly small changes like

hairierleav es that make it difficult for insects to move around on the plant can cut down on pests' destruction and also the need for

pess des duction and also the freet for pesticides, he said.
Breeding such characteristics into potatoes is a long process of cross-pollinating different potato varieties. The process is well underway.
They're in a research testing phase right now at sites throughout the United States. RBI working on digital rupee, govt informs **Parliament**



India's digital currency is on its way. The government informed Parliamenton the firstday of winter session that it is working on a digital rupee. This is the first official confirmation of the move, after days of speculation over RBI's blueprint for digital currency following the listing of the Cryptocurrency Bill for consideration in the present session.
