

## Weather warning for A&N Coast

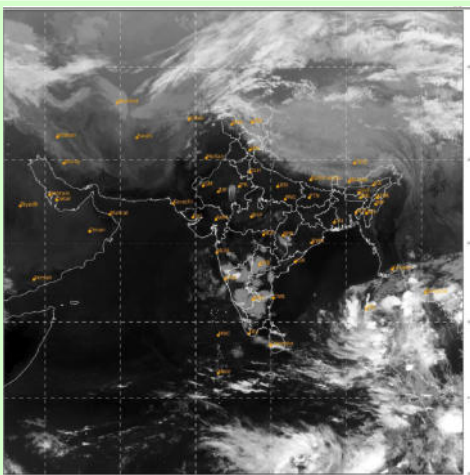
**Well-marked low pressure area over Southeast Bay of Bengal & South Andaman Sea is likely to intensify into a cyclonic storm by March 21**

**Fishermen advised not to venture into Sea till March 22**

Port Blair, Mar. 19

The low pressure area over southeast Bay of Bengal and adjoining South Andaman Sea & East Equatorial Indian Ocean has moved East-Northeastwards and lay as a well-marked low pressure area over Southeast Bay of Bengal and adjoining South Andaman Sea at 0530 hours IST on March 19. It persisted over same area at 0830 hours IST of March 19. It is likely to move nearly northwards along & off Andaman & Nicobar Islands and intensify into a depression by morning of 20<sup>th</sup> March and into a cyclonic storm on 21<sup>st</sup> March. Thereafter, it is likely to move nearly North-Northeastwards and reach near North Myanmar - Southeast Bangladesh coasts on 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2022.

Under its influence, light to moderate rainfall at many places with isolated heavy rainfall occurred over Nicobar Islands during last 24 hours. Light to moderate rainfall at a few places



occurred over Andaman Islands during the same period. 24-Hours accumulated rainfall (in mm) realized during 0830 hrs 1ST of 18<sup>th</sup> March to 0830 hrs IST of 19<sup>th</sup> March: Car Nicobar IAF: 86.2, Car Nicobar IMD: 70.2, Nancowry:39, Long Island:13, Hut Bay: 17.

## SAFETY TIPS ON CYCLONE PREPAREDNESS

(For Cyclone, Heavy Rain, Water Logging, Flash Flood etc.)

1. Listen to radio or TV weather reports for warning & advice and be alert.
2. Identify safe shelters in your area. These should be cyclone resistant and also find the closest and safe route to reach them.
3. All your family members should know the safe routes to nearest shelter/raised pucca buildings.
4. Keep your emergency kit and basic food supply, medicines, torch and batteries etc. ready in waterproof bags. Drink preferably boiled water. Keep your food items covered.
5. Doors, windows, roof and walls should be strengthened/checked before the cyclone season through retrofitting and repairing. Store adequate foodgrains and water in safe places.
6. If your area is flood-prone, consider suitable flood resistant building materials.
7. Do not let children and pregnant woman remain empty stomach.
8. Put furniture, clothing and valuable items etc. on a higher platform so that they can be shifted safely/easily.
9. Do not use electrical appliances, which are in flood water.
10. Do not go into water of unknown depth and current.
11. Do not allow children to play in, or near flood water.
12. Do not venture into the sea if so advised. Stay Indoors under the strongest part of the house/ if not moved to the cyclone shelter.
13. Remain indoors until informed that weather has improved.
14. In case of cyclone alert, do not go out, till officially advised that it is safe. If evacuated, wait till advised to go back. Use the recommended route to return to your home. Do not rush/panic.
15. Be careful of broken/uncovered power lines, damaged roads and houses, fallen trees etc.
16. Be careful of snakes, as snake bites are common during floods.

- Use the recommended route to return to your home. Do not rush.
- Be careful of broken power lines, damaged roads and house, fallen trees etc.

or local authority in respective jurisdictions. They may control & restrict vehicular traffic to, from and within the vulnerable or affected area. Evacuate people from vulnerable areas & shift them to identified Relief Shelters ensuring they are provided shelter, food, drinking water, essential provisions, health care & service.

They have also been directed to get the identified dangerous trees posing hazard to life and/or property, cut or pruned and recommend any Department or local authority to take such measures as necessary in its opinion. Requisition of any resources, services, premises or vehicles for the purpose of prompt response, rescue operations, rehabilitation or reconstruction. Procure exclusive or preferential use of amenities from any authority or person. Remove debris, conduct search and carry out rescue operation. Take any other such step as may be required or warranted to be taken as per the need of the situation.

Any refusal or withdrawal from the duties, imposed upon any Govt. Official shall be liable for punishment with imprisonment which may extend to one year or with fine, u/s 56 of the Disaster Management Act.

Due to paucity of time, the order has been issued ex-parte and shall be in operation till its withdrawal.

## Vaccination- shield against the virus 6,09,219 doses of vaccine administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far in Isles

Port Blair, Mar. 19 9616. The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,09,219 doses have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,275 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs and 687 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 73 beneficiaries

A total of 569 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands. 455 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 204 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years, 941 beneficiaries were in the age group of 15-18 years, 3 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 51. 73 beneficiaries

were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 20 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 27. 41 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 1 beneficiary was in the age group of 15-18 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 8, a press release from DHS said.

**Wind warning:** Squally winds speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph are very likely to prevail over Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Andaman Sea and adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal from forenoon and would gradually increase thereafter on March 20. On March 21, Gale winds speed reaching 70-80 kmph gusting to 90 kmph are very likely to prevail over Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Eastcentral Bay of Bengal and adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal. On March 22, Gale winds speed reaching 60-70 kmph gusting to 80 kmph are very likely to prevail over Eastcentral Bay of Bengal and along & off Myanmar coast. Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over North Andaman Islands, North Andaman Sea and adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal, Northeast Bay of Bengal and along & off Southeast Bangladesh coast.

**Sea condition:** Sea condition is very likely to become rough to very rough over Andaman Sea and adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal during March 19 and it would become very rough over the same region on March 20. Sea condition is very likely to become very rough to high over Andaman Sea, Southeast and adjoining Eastcentral Bay of Bengal on March 21, over Eastcentral and adjoining Southeast & northeast Bay of Bengal and North Andaman Sea and along & off Myanmar coast on March 22. It would be rough to very rough over northeast Bay of Bengal and along & off Southeast Bangladesh coast during the same period.

**Fishermen Warning:** Fishermen are advised not to venture into southeast Bay of Bengal between March 19 & 21 and into Andaman Sea and along & off Andaman and Nicobar Islands from March 19 to 22. They have also been advised not to venture into Eastcentral Bay of Bengal on March 21 & 22 and into Northeast Bay of Bengal on March 22.

## District Administration N&M issues advisory to deal with impending cyclonic storm

In view of the cyclonic storm likely to intensify in N&M Andaman District on March 21, the District Administration N&M Andaman has advised the general public not to panic, not to venture into sea and remain indoors till cyclone subsides. Further, people have been advised to keep away from trees which appear to be dangerous

due to likelihood of getting uprooted during the cyclonic storm. They have been advised to evacuate to safer places or the designated shelter homes in case of being vulnerably located in low lying area, flood-prone or in the vicinity of dangerous trees and remain alert against flying debris during cyclonic conditions like loose tin sheets etc.

In case of assistance, they may contact nearest Police Station or emergency numbers for any assistance viz. Police - 100, EOC -112, Disaster Control Room - 273138/262960, Diglipur- 272241, Rangat - 274111/274222 and Baratang- 279595, the Advisory issued by DC(N&M) added.

## COVID-19 status in A&N Islands No positive case detected during RT-PCR test conducted on incoming flight passengers

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 33 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 20 flights with 2569 passengers arrived, out of which, 2179 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR

test was conducted on 297 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 18 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 18

passengers, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 4 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. At helipad, 03 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

Council are deployed and will be functional round the clock. Community Halls of, Dairy Farm, Haddo and Brookshabad will be opened for rehabilitation and all the caretakers will be present in these Community halls round the clock. The Executive Engineer (Water Works) has been directed to ensure drinking water at these Rehabilitation Centers and other flood affected areas. Teams consisting of 5 to 6 workers under the respective Assistant Engineer's and Agriculture Officer have been kept on standby to render help during emergencies like earth sliding, water logging and tree branches clearance. Further, a team under the Sanitary Officer has also been constituted to attend to the complaints such as removal of carcass of dead animals and removal of uprooted trees etc. A separate team has also been constituted under the Executive Engineer (E&M) to attend to complaints received from the public and its immediate redressal.

The Civic Chief further appealed to the public not to panic as the Port Blair Municipal Council is working round the clock in tandem with the A&N Administration to face any situation. She further appealed to the general public to be safe and avoid going near sea shore areas and other unsafe places, a press release from Chairperson, PBMC said.
