The four Go-Go AC Electric Tourist Buses which were flagged off by the Union Minister of Home Affairs and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah has started providing service to the tourists. It is to mention that the idea of Go-Go AC Electric Tourist bus was conceived by the Chief Secretary, A & N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain and its service has been made available to the tourists in a record time.

As the UT of A&N Islands has emerged as a favorite tourist destination because of its natural beauty, the inflow of tourists is increasing year after year. Port Blair city and its surroundings have many popular landmarks, heritage destinations and other renowned places for the attraction of the



tourists. In place of the existing costly transport service with many limitations, an alternative option in the form of Go-Go Bus Service which has flexibility for the tourists is provided. Bus transport is always considered a safe and reliable form of service and tourists coming from outside the Islands will find it more convenient.

In order to provide a secure, comfortable and affordable mode of transport to the tourists for visiting maximum renowned

tourist spots in and around Port Blair, the Go-Go Bus service has started with 4 beautifully designed and attractive Air Conditioned Electric buses under Smart City Mission. The design and quality of AC Electric Buses makes it suitable for city tour operation as comfortable view of outside the saloon is facilitated by the transparent and large window glasses.

The service aims to cover 8 destinations on its circuit and the service will be available from

9 am to 5 pm with assured availability at an interval of every half-an-hour. The tourist destinations covered has been so designed that, the bus will originate from Bus Terminus and pass through Aberdeen Bazar, Andaman Club (Heritage building), Marina Park, Flag Point and Corbyn's Cove providing the commuters scenic sea view.

The service can be availed by any person interested in travelling in this service by purchasing a single ticket @ Rs.150/- per commuter per day which would enable the commuter to travel on that particular day on any "Go-Go" Bus Service. The commuter can alight or board the bus at any point on the route and then again avail the service after completion of their visit to that particular spot on that day.

For informative documentaries on Andaman and other entertainments to the tourists, the buses has been fitted with TV and audio system. The introduction of "Go-Go" bus service by A&N Administration would be beneficial for the tourists.

## Seekho Aur Kamao (Learn & Earn) scheme Upgrading skills of minority youth in various modern/traditional vocations

Port Blair, Oct. 18

The Ministry of Minority Affairs, GoI is implementing the Central Sector Scheme- Seekho Aur Kamao (Learn & Earn) for Skill Development of Minorities. The scheme aims at upgrading the skills of the minority youth in various modern/traditional vocations depending upon their educational qualification, present economic trends and the market potential, which can earn them a suitable employment or make them suitably skilled to go for self employment. The scheme is implemented through selected expert Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs). It ensures placement of minimum 75% trainees,



out of which, at least 50% placement is in organized sector.

The eligible trainees/ beneficiaries should belong to minority community, should be between 14-35 years of age, should be at least Class V. In case seat for reserved categories as prescribed under this scheme remain vacant, these vacant seats may be treated as unreserved.

## Vaccination- shield against the virus

**4,67,975 lakh doses of vaccine administered to beneficiaries in Isles so far**

Port Blair, Oct. 18

Vaccination drive to vaccinate maximum number of eligible beneficiaries of 18 above age group in the entire Island Territory is continuing and the percentage of population vaccinated so far in Isles stands at 73.06%. With 2904 beneficiaries vaccinated today, the number of cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated so far has gone up to 4,67,975 in A&N Islands.

The Health Department is striving hard to cover maximum



number of eligible beneficiaries by vaccinating them through its designated vaccination centres spread over the Islands to keep the corona virus at bay.

As per data available, the cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with first dose so far is 2,92,248 (102.18%) while cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with second dose so far is 1,75,727 (60.13%).

Meanwhile, 1716 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which 147 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 893 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District

## Over 97 crore 79 lakh COVID-19 vaccine doses administered in the country so far

New Delhi, Oct. 18

India has administered over 97 crore 79 lakh doses of COVID vaccine so far under the Nationwide Vaccination Drive. Union Health Ministry said, more than 12 lakh five thousand vaccine doses were administered in the last 24 hours.

The Ministry said, 19 thousand 582 COVID patients recovered during the last 24 hours and the national recovery rate has reached 98.12 per cent. Till now, more than three crore 34 lakh people have recovered from COVID-19.

The country reported

13 thousand 596 new cases in last 24 hours. Currently, India's active caseload is around one lakh 89 thousand. The active cases constitute less than one per cent of the total cases and it is currently at 0.56 per cent, the lowest since March last year. The daily

## Media briefing on COVID-19 held

**No positive case detected during test conducted on mainland and inter-island bound passengers: Director (IP&T)**

Port Blair, Oct. 18

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar addressing the media briefing on COVID-19 held in the conference hall of IP&T stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 460 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 8 flights with 1352 passengers arrived, out of which, 900 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on remaining 452 passengers and the reports are awaited. RAT was



conducted on 180 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and no positive case has been detected. Apart from this, RT-PCR test was conducted on 47 crew members of MV Kalighat and 1 crew member of MV Makruzz. RAT test was conducted from 10 passengers at Helipad and




the results were negative. RAT test was conducted on 22 passengers at Phoenix Bay Jetty and all were found negative. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 114 passengers and all were found negative. At Haddo Wharf, RAT test was conducted on 81 passengers and all were found negative.

On vaccination, the Director said that 251 persons were vaccinated today till 3 pm, out of which, 232 were in the age

## Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

### Carambola (Averrhoa carambola): a suitable fruit crop for the islands

Carambola or star fruit is a beautiful five cornered fruit native to South East Asian countries. It is sometimes sold in the local markets of our islands. Both sweet as well as sour types are available in it. The fruits are not only aesthetically appealing but are also the sources of antioxidants including vitamin C. Their high potassium and low sodium content makes them suitable for consumption by people suffering from hypertension. However, considering its high oxalic acid content, kidney patients should defer its consumption. The juicy fruits are suitable for fresh consumption as well as for processing in the form of juice, squash, salad, pickle etc. While sour type fruits are usually consumed in processed form or along with salt, sweet types are liked in fresh form as well. Since the fruit is native to tropical regions of South East Asia, agro-climatic conditions of Andaman and Nicobar Islands are suitable for its cultivation. A few farmers in various parts of Andaman Islands have planted the trees of sweet carambola in their backyards. Studies at ICAR-CIARI have suggested that it can be planted at closer spacing with appropriate canopy management and produces flowers and fruits throughout the year with three major picking seasons. The tree bears fragile branches and hence, the field should be protected against high wind velocity. However, the tree revives back on its own, thereby making it a suitable plant for fragile island ecosystem. A grafted or budded plant starts bearing fruits within 2-3 years of planting and from 7-8 years onwards, commercial harvest is obtained. Ideal stage of harvesting of fruits for direct consumption or for sale in local market is when about 50% of the fruit surface has turned yellow. Fruits should not be stored in refrigerator as they are sensitive to chilling injury.

**Benefit:** Cultivation of carambola and its processing could promote small scale enterprises such as fruit salads, beverages etc. in tourist places of our islands.

leader has accorded an extraordinary esteem to India which was never forthcoming in the earlier decades. Significantly, Prime Minister, Shri Modi has a special aptitude for science driven developments, which has enabled all the scientific programmes to concentrate on applications which are relevant to the life of the common man.

Dr Jitendra Singh said, India's blue economy is understood as a subset of the national economy comprising an entire ocean resources system and human-made economic infrastructure in marine, maritime, and onshore coastal zones within the country's legal jurisdiction. He said, it aids the production of goods and services that have clear linkages with economic growth, environmental sustainability, and national security. The blue economy is a vast socio-economic opportunity for coastal nations like India to utilize ocean resources for societal benefit responsibly, the Minister added.

Referring to the term "Earth Sciences" the Minister said, this includes study of earth's atmosphere and the water flowing on and beneath the surface and also the earth's seas and oceans. In the times to come, the Minister said, Marine pollution is going to pose a formidable challenge and denudation of the coast will add to the erosion of the coastal land. The Ministry of Earth Sciences, he informed, has developed an innovative technology from the coast of Pondicherry and it can be strengthened in further areas as well.

New York, Oct. 18

Finance Minister, Ms. Nirmala Sitharaman told global leaders and investors in an interaction in New York that India has undertaken several reforms to ease foreign investment in infrastructure, including fiscal benefits which have created opportunities for investors and industry in the country. At a round table organised by FICCI and the US-India Strategic Partnership Forum, Ms. Sitharaman said, with the current reset in the global supply chain and clear-headed and committed leadership in India, she sees opportunities galore in India for all investors and industry stakeholders. The Finance Minister is on a week-long tour of the United States, where she

met several business leaders and US Government officials including Treasury Secretary Janet Yellen last week.

She said, India has fully leveraged the potential of digitisation even during the most challenging time of the Covid-19 pandemic. Ms Sitharaman also highlighted that the role of technology in the financial



sector is enabling pushing the frontier of financial inclusion. She said, fintechs are playing a key role in this area.

Pointing to the opportunities in India, the Minister said startups in India have grown tremendously and many are now raising money through capital markets. She said, this year itself, more than 16 of them will qualify as unicorns.

## NASA launches Lucy spacecraft, first space mission to study Trojans Asteroids

New Delhi, Oct.18

NASA launched Lucy spacecraft, the first space mission to study the Trojans Asteroids. Lucy will journey for 12 years, observing one main belt asteroid and seven Trojan asteroids.

The swarms of Trojan asteroids associated with Jupiter are thought to be remnants of the primordial material that formed the outer planets. These primitive bodies hold vital clues to deciphering the history of the solar system.

The Jupiter Trojan asteroids are leftover raw materials from the formation of our Solar System's giant planets (Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, and Neptune) over 4.5 billion years ago.

They hold a record of the composition and physical conditions in the protoplanetary disk from which all the Sun's planets, including Earth, formed. At

some time in the distant past, the Trojan asteroids became trapped in their current locations, orbiting the Sun approximately at the distance of Jupiter in two broad swarms associated with the L4 and L5 Lagrange points.

These are locations where the combined effects of the Sun's gravity, Jupiter's gravity, and orbital motion create an equilibrium, such that objects orbiting near these points will stay near them indefinitely. The "L4 swarm" leads, one-sixth of a lap ahead of Jupiter, while the "L5 swarm" trails one-sixth of a lap behind. Current scientific theories indicate that the Trojan asteroids could have been trapped in these stable orbits early in the Solar System's history, at the end of an era of giant planet "migration" during which the planets' orbits shifted substantially.
