## PM commissions first indigenous aircraft carrier INS Vikrant

**It is the largest ship ever built in maritime history of India and houses state of the art automation features: PM**  
**INS Vikrant is a symbol of indigenous potential, indigenous resources and indigenous skills**



Kochi, Sept. 2 (PIB)

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi commissioned the first indigenous aircraft carrier as INS Vikrant today. During the event, the Prime Minister also unveiled the new Naval Ensign (Nishaan), doing away with the colonial past and befitting the rich Indian maritime heritage. Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister said today, here on the coast of Kerala, India, every Indian,

is witnessing the sunrise of a new future. This event being held on the INS Vikrant is a tribute to the rising spirits of India on the world horizon. He said that today we are seeing a manifestation of the dream of the freedom fighters where they envisioned a capable and strong India. The Prime Minister exclaimed "Vikrant is a huge, massive, and vast. Vikrant is distinguished, Vikrant is also special. Vikrant is not just a

warship. This is a testament to the hard work, talent, influence and commitment of India in the 21<sup>st</sup> century. If the goals are distant, the journeys are long, the ocean and the challenges are endless - then India's answer is Vikrant. The incomparable Amrit Ka Amrit Mahotsav is Vikrant. Vikrant is a unique reflection of India becoming self-reliant." Commenting on the new mood of the nation, the

Prime Minister said, no challenge is too difficult for today's India. He said, "today, India has joined those countries in the world, which manufacture such a huge aircraft carrier with indigenous technology. Today INS Vikrant has filled the country with a new confidence, and has created a new confidence in the country." The Prime Minister acknowledged and praised the contribution of the Navy,

engineers of Cochin Shipyard, scientists and specially the workers who worked on the project. He also noted the happy and auspicious occasion of Onam that is adding even more happiness to the occasion. Every part of INS Vikrant has its own merits, a strength, a development journey of its own. It is a symbol of indigenous potential, indigenous resources and indigenous skills. The

steel installed in its airbase is also indigenous, developed by DRDO scientists and produced by Indian companies, he said. Explaining the massive proportions of the Carrier, the Prime Minister said it is like a floating city. It produces electricity that is sufficient to power 5000 households and the wiring used will reach Kashi from Kochi, he said. He said that INS Vikrant is a living embodiment of the Spirit of

## COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Sept. 2

Two COVID positive cases have been detected today in A&N Islands. These two cases were detected during the screening of incoming flight passengers who arrived here yesterday. Today, 9 flights with 1419 passengers arrived, out of which, 1272 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 101 passengers and the

reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 20 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 24 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. RAT was conducted on 14 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus and no positive case has been detected, a press release from IP&T said.

## Precaution dose: Boosting fight against COVID-19

### Islanders urged to avail free vaccination facility at nearest Health Centres

Port Blair, Sept. 2

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands has achieved 100% target coverage for COVID-19 vaccines for all the age groups. It is to mention that to boost the herd immunity among the populace especially of the adults, a precaution dose is necessary. Seeing the greater participation of general public during the 'Har Ghar Dastak' campaign under 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav', requested to avail the free vaccination facility in the



precaution dose in Government Health Institutions has been extended till stock lasts. In this regard, all the islanders have been requested to avail the free vaccination facility in the

nearest Health Centres free of cost. The 18+ eligible beneficiaries who have taken second dose 6 months or 26 weeks or have completed 182 days are eligible for precaution dose. Further,

beneficiaries who has taken Covishield as 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose may either take Covishield or Corbevax as precautionary dose subject to availability and choice. Moreover, those who have taken Covaxin as 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose and are more than 18 years of age must only take Covaxin as precaution dose. It is also informed that children below 18 years of age are not eligible for any precautionary dose, a press release from DHS said.

the Panch Prans that he proclaimed from the ramparts of Red Fort.

The Prime Minister talked about the Indian Maritime tradition and naval capabilities. Chhatrapati Veer Shivaji Maharaj, he said, built such a navy on the strength of this sea power, which kept the enemies on their toes. When the British came to India, they used to be intimidated by the power of Indian ships and trade through them. So they decided to break the back of India's maritime power. History is witness to how strict restrictions were imposed on Indian ships and merchants by enacting a law in the British Parliament at that time, the Prime Minister said.

The Prime Minister noted that today on the historic date of September 2, 2022, India has taken off a trace of slavery, a burden of slavery. The Indian Navy has got a new flag from today. Till now the identity of slavery remained on the flag of Indian Navy. But from today onwards, inspired by Chhatrapati Shivaji, the new Navy flag will fly in the sea and in the sky.

INS Vikrant is designed by Indian Navy's in-house Warship Design Bureau (WDB) and built by Cochin Shipyard Limited, a Public Sector Shipyard under the Ministry of Ports, Shipping & Waterways. Vikrant has been built with state of the art automation features and is the largest ship ever built in maritime history of India.

The Indigenous Aircraft Carrier is named after her illustrious predecessor, India's first Aircraft Carrier which had played a vital role in the 1971 war. It has a large number of indigenous equipment and machinery, involving major industrial houses in the country as well as over 100 MSMEs. With the commissioning of Vikrant, India will have two operational Aircraft Carriers, which will bolster the maritime security of the nation.

### Promoting scientific cultivation & processing of spices in Isles

#### Training Prog. organized by CIARI under CSS-MIDH Project

Port Blair, Sept. 2

Spices are the low volume high value horticultural crops having immense potential for commercial exploitation. However, maximizing the returns from their cultivation requires knowledge of scientific cultivation and post harvest management techniques. To create awareness about these techniques through demonstration and hands on experience, a three days training programme on 'Scientific cultivation and post harvest handling of spices under Island conditions for

better profit' was organized by ICAR-CIARI under CSS-MIDH (NHM) project on Spices from August 29 to 31, 2022. During the inaugural programme, Dr. E.B. Chakurkar, Director, ICAR-CIARI who was the chief guest of the programme interacted with the participants and expressed his happiness over the diversity of participants who had gathered for a common cause of enriching their knowledge about spices, despite variations in their profession, age group, gender etc.

During the technical sessions, Dr. Ajit Arun Waman, Coordinator of the programme gave a presentation about the basics of spices cultivation and overview of its present status and future opportunities in the Islands. It was followed by an interactive session with the participants on their expectations from the programme. To promote the cultivation of spices, planting material of cinnamon, tejpat, long pepper, woody pepper and lemon grass were distributed to the participants, a press release from CIARI said.
