

**Vaccination drive in A&N Islands
Isles achieve 100% vaccination of
children in the age group of 12 to
14 yrs; crosses 13,000 mark**

Port Blair, June 10
The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,82,399 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,545 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs and 13,006 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs. With this, the Islands have achieved 100% vaccination of children in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 26010.



A total of 274 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 252 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 199 beneficiaries were vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 34. About 22 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 17, a press release from DHS said.

**EC announces schedule for presidential
elections ; Polling to be held on July 18**

New Delhi, June 10
Election Commission of India has announced the schedule for the Election of 16th President of India. Announcing the poll schedule in New Delhi yesterday, Chief Election Commissioner, Shri Rajiv Kumar said, poll will be held on 18th of July. Notification for the poll will be issued on 15th of June and last date for filing of nominations will be 29th of this month. Scrutiny of nomination papers will take place on 30th of this month. The counting will be taken up on 21st of July. The President is elected by an electoral college comprising elected members of Lok Sabha, Rajya Sabha and State Legislative Assemblies. It also includes Legislative Assemblies of Delhi and Puducherry. Shri Kumar said, election will be by secret ballot in accordance with system of proportional representation as per the Constitution. The Chief Election Commissioner said, total number of electors will be 4,809 including 776 Members of Parliament and 4,033 Members of Legislative Assemblies. Total value of the votes will be 10 lakh 86 thousand 431. (Source: india.gov.in)

Port Blair, June 10
The Chief Secretary, A & N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain in a meeting has directed that aerial survey of Port Blair area should be conducted for ensuring earth cutting in a scientific manner through drone/heli and google map for land development. He directed that it should be done to closely monitor the frequency of earth cutting, so as to avoid any natural disaster such as land slide and soil erosion due to rampant earth cutting. The monitoring of earth cutting would also prevent illegal earth cutting being carried out in those who are involved in illegal soil cutting & illegal making of plots without conversion and permission. The field functionaries have also been asked to keep pictures of pre and post status of the particular land for which earth cutting permission is being given for keeping records and future references. It may be recalled that as per the direction of the Chief Secretary, the District Administration has adopted the procedure to grant permission for earth cutting through an online service under edistrict.andaman.gov.in. The general public have been advised to apply online in the given site or may apply through the help of nearest Common Service Centre or e-corner. Further, it is informed that permission for earth cutting shall only be granted for online mode and no petition in offline mode shall be entertained. Meanwhile, the general public have been requested to contact the District Control Room on the numbers 03192-238881, 240127, 9531888844 (WhatsApp) and pass the information on illegal earth cutting.

**Towards making A&N Islands 'Drugs Free'
Two persons engaged in drug peddling
arrested with drugs; three receivers
also arrested by Central Crime Station**

Port Blair, June 10
Acting on a specific information received from reliable source, two persons of a ship company were arrested by PS Central Crime Station with 0.460 Kgs Ganja on June 8, 2022. The ganja was clandestinely concealed inside postal parcel sent from Bangalore. Two persons were arrested. A deep-rooted nexus of supply of contrabands using postal services was busted and further investigations into the case has led to the arrest of three receivers of consignment. During investigation, police team unearth entire nexus of this drugs transshipment also seized Methamphetamine and Ganja from the receivers. A case under relevant sections of NDPS Act- 1985 has been registered at PS CCS and investigation is on to unearthing entire nexus of this drugs transshipment using postal services/



other means. Greed of earning extra money lures certain individuals to these unethical practices, thus endangering gullible youths of these emerald Islands. Investigations are on to track the money trail and other suppliers and receivers of various contrabands in these Islands.

**Deptt. of AH&VS issues advisory for farmers
on 'Lumpy Skin Disease in Livestock'**

Port Blair, June 10
The Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, A&N Administration has issued advisory after receiving inputs about the occurrence of Lumpy Skin Diseases (LSD) among Livestock (Cattle) from Campbell Bay. In this regard, the Department has asked the livestock owners to adhere to several recommendations to safeguard their livestock in view of the occurrence of LSD. Farmers need not panic, as LSD in cattle causes negligible mortality. Accordingly, farmer noticed any LSD signs/symptoms in his/her flock which include mild healthy animals. They have been advised to restrict the movement of in contact animals to prevent the spread of the disease and not to allow animals for grazing at common place. These nodules are circumscribed, firm, round, raised and involves the skin, sub-cutaneous tissue and sometimes muscles. Symptoms may include lesions in mouth, pharynx and respiratory tract, emaciation, enlarged lymph nodes, oedema of limbs and reduction in milk production, they should immediately contact the concerned Senior Veterinary Officer of the area and follow the advice, a press release from Deptt. of AH & VS said.
