The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 4,05,008 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2,81,603 (approx.). A total of 3579 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 2273 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 505 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 815 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District.

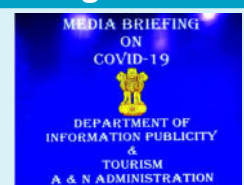

Media briefed on COVID-19

No positive cases detected during test conducted on incoming flight & inter island bound passengers: Director (IP&T)

Port Blair, Sept.17

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar briefing media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening disclosed that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 1059 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 8 flights with 1248 passengers arrived and









the RT-PCR test was conducted and the reports are awaited. He further disclosed that RAT was conducted on 229 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and all were found

negative. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, 198 passengers were tested and no positive case has been detected. Apart from this, 268 passengers travelling to different destinations were tested at Phoenix Bay Jetty and all were found negative. 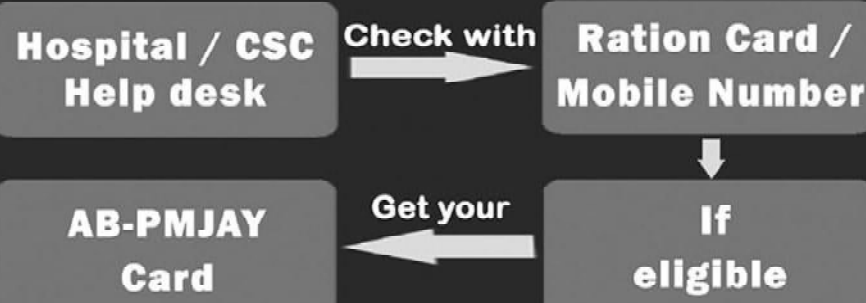

PRESS NOTE

Reservation of seats in the University of Calicut to the students of Andaman & Nicobar Islands

As per the prospectus of University of Calicut for the year 2021-22, seats are reserved in UG programmes for the students of Andaman & Nicobar Islands. As per the prospectus, an additional seats can be created over and above the sanctioned strength, but within the statutory maximum limit for the native students of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. For programmes where the sanctioned strength and the statutory maximum limit are the same, the additional seats can be created over and above the statutory limit, exclusively for the admission of the above candidates.

Further as per the Notification dated 06.08.2021 issued by the University of Calicut, all candidates seeking admission to the UG Programmes irrespective of the Quota (General Merit/ Reservation/Sports/ Persons with Disabilities/ Community/ Management/ Inmates of Juvenile Justice Home/ Kashmir Students/ Students from Andaman & Nicobar Islands/ Transgender) should compulsorily register through Centralized Admission Process (CAP) of University of Calicut.
