

PM unveils hologram statue of Netaji at India Gate; Also confers Subhas Chandra Bose Aapda Prabandhan Puraskars

'We have to move ahead taking inspiration from Netaji's 'Can Do, Will Do' spirit': PM

"We have a goal to fulfil the dreams of independent India. We have the goal of building a new India before the hundredth year of independence"

New Delhi, Jan. 23 (PIB)

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi unveiled a hologram statue of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose at India Gate. This hologram would be in place till the work of the statue of Netaji is completed. The statue would be unveiled in the same place to mark the year-long celebration of the 125th birth anniversary of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose.

Prime Minister also conferred Subhas Chandra Bose Aapda Prabandhan Puraskars for the year 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022 in the investiture ceremony. This award was instituted by the Union Government to recognize and honour the invaluable contribution and selfless service rendered by the individuals and organisations in India in the field of disaster management.

The Prime Minister paid tribute to the brave son of Mother India, Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose on his 125th birth anniversary. Addressing the gathering, he said that the grand statue of Netaji, who had established the first Independent Government on the soil of India, and who gave us the confidence of



achieving a sovereign and strong India, is being replaced by a granite statue. This statue is a homage to the hero of freedom by the grateful nation and will keep reminding our institutions and generations on the lesson of national duty,

he said.

The Prime Minister traced the historical evolution of Disaster Management in the country. He informed, for years the subject of Disaster Management was with the Agriculture Department. The basic reason for this was that the Ministry of Agriculture was responsible for dealing with the conditions created by floods, heavy rains, hailstorms etc. The Prime Minister said but the 2001 Gujarat earthquake changed the meaning of Disaster Management. "We have deployed all departments and ministries into relief and rescue work. Learning from the experiences of that time, the Gujarat State Disaster Management Act was enacted in 2003. Gujarat became the first State in the country to enact such a law to deal with the disaster. Later, the Central Government, taking lessons from the laws of Gujarat, made a similar Disaster Management Act in 2005 for the entire country", he continued.

The Prime Minister said emphasis is on Reform along with stress on Relief, Rescue

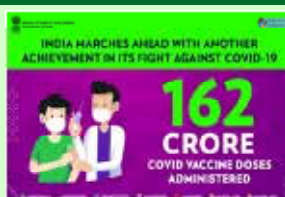

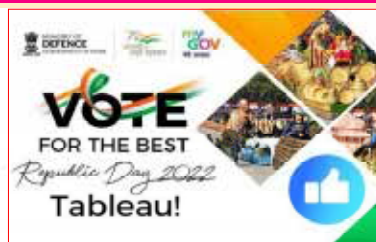

and Rehabilitation. We strengthened, modernised and expanded the NDRF across the country. From space technology to planning and management, best possible practises have been adopted, he said. The Prime Minister noted that youngsters are coming forward with schemes like 'Aapda Mitra' of NDMA. Whenever calamity strikes, he said, people do not remain victims, they fight the disaster by becoming volunteers. That is, Disaster Management is no longer just a Government job, but it has become a model of 'Sabka Prayas'.
The Prime Minister emphasized the need to strengthen institutions to improve capacity to deal with disasters. He cited examples of cyclones in Odisha, West Bengal, Goa, Maharashtra, Gujarat for illustrating the new preparedness as these disasters saw much lesser damage than earlier times. He said that the country has an end to end cyclone response system, much better early warning system and tools of disaster risk analysis and disaster risk management.
The Prime Minister elaborated the holistic approach, a hallmark of thinking in every sphere of today's governance, in Disaster Management. Today Disaster Management is part of Civil Engineering and Architecture courses and there is a Dam Safety law now. Similarly, upcoming massive infrastructure projects have built-in disaster resilience. He cited disaster preparedness of PM Awas Yojana houses in earthquake prone areas, Char Dham Maha Pariyojana, Expressways in Uttar Pradesh as examples of vision and thinking of the New India.
The Prime Minister also highlighted India's leadership in the sphere of disaster management at global level. In the CDRI- Coalition for Disaster Resilient Infrastructure, India has given a big thought and gift to the global community and 35 countries along with the United Kingdom are already part of the coalition. The Prime Minister said Joint Military Exercises among armies are common in various countries of the world. But for the first time, India has started the tradition of Joint Drill for Disaster Management.
The Prime Minister quoted Netaji that "Never lose faith in the dream of independent India, there is no power in the world that can shake India." The PM said that today we have a goal to fulfil the dreams of independent India. We have the goal of building a New India before the hundredth year of independence.
The Prime Minister said that it is the grand resolve of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' that India will revive its identity and inspirations. The Prime Minister regretted that after independence, along with the culture and traditions of the country, the contribution of many great personalities was also erased.
The Prime Minister said the freedom struggle involved 'tapasya' of lakhs of countrymen, but attempts were made to limit their history as well. But today, after decades of independence, the country is boldly correcting those mistakes. He cited Panch Teerth associated with Babasaheb Ambedakar, Statue of Unity to commemorate the contribution of Sardar Patel, Janjatiya Gaurav Diwas in the honour of Bhagawan Birsa Munda, Tribal Museums to remember the great contribution of the tribal community, **naming an Island in Andamans after Netaji to commemorate 75 years of tricolour in Andamans and Sankalp Smarak in Andamans to honour Netaji and INA, as some key steps in the direction of correcting the mistakes of the past.** The Prime Minister recalled with emotion his visit to Netaji's ancestral residence in Kolkata on the Parakram Diwas last year. The Prime Minister said he also cannot forget the day of 21 October ,2018 when the Azad Hind Government completed 75 years. "In a special ceremony held at the Red Fort, I had hoisted the tricolour wearing the cap of the Azad Hind Fauj. That moment was wonderful, unforgettable", he said.
The Prime Minister said if Netaji Subhas was determined to do something, then no power could stop him. We have to move ahead taking inspiration from Netaji's 'Can Do, Will Do' spirit.

Hon'ble Lt Governor and other special invitees shall be parked inside the Netaji Stadium. After the departure of the Chief Guest from the place of function, the vehicles of the special invitees shall follow the route Scout Hut Junction-Vikas Bhawan-Fire Brigade-Old Telephone Exchange-APWD Crossing to their destinations.
The vehicles intending to proceed to South Point from Aberdeen Bazaar shall be diverted towards Model School Crossing-Bengali Club - Goalghar- Secretariat Junction - Police Line and Nayagaon.
No heavy vehicles including Private and STS buses will be allowed to proceed to Aberdeen Bazaar from Gandhi Statue and Bengali Club Junction from 0700 hrs to 0930 hrs.
The vehicles intending to proceed to Aberdeen Bazaar from South Point shall follow the route of South Point-Shadipur-Nayagaon Junction-Police Line-RBV-Secretariat Junction and Goalghar.
Heavy vehicles proceeding to long route shall be diverted to Goal Ghar and Junglighat from Bengali Club.
All the vehicular traffic shall remain suspended in the stretches from Annapurna to Clock Tower, Clock Tower to Dharamshala, Dharamshala to R.K. Mission and Raj Niwas to National Memorial via Netaji Stadium from 0815 hrs.
No vehicles shall be allowed to proceed towards the place of function from any side after 0815 hrs. No vehicle shall be allowed to proceed to Aberdeen Bazaar after the function from any direction till the crowd gets dispersed.

CSIR-CDRI Scientists Developed Indigenous RT-PCR kit "Om" for Omicron Variant
Lucknow, Jan. 23
Under the Government initiative to make India self-reliant in RT-PCR diagnostics, CDRI developed an indigenous RT-PCR diagnostic kit "Om". As the Coronavirus continues to mutate, it becomes challenging to diagnose and treat different variants of concern. Some like the Omicron, though milder in symptoms and fatality, are a super spreader and are propagating like wildfire across the world.
Currently, detection of this variant depends upon tests like the S-gene dropout or by NGS (Nextgen sequencing) of the whole viral genome. Whereas the S-gene drop-out method is not specific to pinpoint the type of variant and the NGS (Nextgen sequencing) method has its limitations in terms of expense, turnaround, and the number of centers that can provide such service.
CSIR-CDRI Director, Prof. Tapas K. Kundu informed that the current upsurge in COVID infections indicates variants of the SARS-CoV-2 virus circulating in the Indian population. So far most of the RT-PCR-based diagnostic kits do not confirm whether COVID infection is caused by the highly mutated Omicron variant. The scientific team comprising of Dr. Atul Goel, Dr. Ashish Arora, and Dr. Niti Kumar at CSIR-CDRI, Lucknow along with industry partner Biotech Desk Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad have successfully developed the indigenous RTPCR Kit INDICoV-OmTM for specific detection of the Omicron variant. (Source: DD News)
