Severe cold wave conditions likely to grip parts of N/India

Severe cold wave conditions are likely to grip parts of North India, including the national capital region for the next 3 days. According to the India Meteorological Department, the minimum temperature is likely to settle around 3 degree Celsius in Delhi and adjoining areas of the national capital. The weather agency also predicted dense fog and low visibility over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, north Rajasthan and north Uttar Pradesh for the next five days. IMD said due to north-westerly winds from the Himalayas over the plains of north west India, minimum temperatures are very likely to fall by 2-4 degree Celsius over the north west and adjoining central India during the next two days. Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, and Jammu and Kashmir are likely to see moderate to light rainfall or snowfall from 18th January.

Besides, for many children, school play time is the most active part of their day. Therefore, school playground and school playtime are vitally important to children for their fun and relaxation as well as for their good health and well-being. School playgrounds play an important role in their daily life for fulfilling their interest, development and learning needs. The school playground is an important facility for children to play every day on their own initiative. It puts enormous positive impacts on children's development and learning. This initiative provides students with the leisure facilities to make primary education livelier and student-friendly. Despite all these well defined benefits and essentials for overall development of school going children, the Education Department has kept aside the requirement of play ground in schools. Accounting for the status of playgrounds in schools under municipal area, a small space was available in Model School that was cemented for several reasons. Same is the story with Haddo (Telugu Medium) school. The playground of Mohanpura School remains neglected for several years. Owing to poor

NGGOA meeting

Port Blair, Jan 16: A special meeting of the Central Office Bearers, Vice Presidents and Secretaries of various branches and Sub-Committees of the Non-Gazetted Govt. Officers' Association, A & N Islands was held at Port Blair on 12.01.2022 at the call of the Confederation of Central Govt. Employees & Workers, New Delhi to discuss upon the future course of action by the Association on the demand for scrapping of National Pension System and restoration of Old Pension Scheme to all government employees who were recruited after 2004. Share, don't gag

The National Disaster Management Authority has instructed government institutions and officials to avoid interacting with media or share information on social media about land subsidence in Joshimath. The gag order will be in force till the final report of NDMA's expert group is submitted. The immediate trigger for the gag order appears to be a satellite report of Isro that indicates subsidence of about 9 cm in seven months. NDMA should rethink its decision – a gag order won't stop the flow of bad news, if that's NDMA's motive, but it may affect intelligent opinion-building that needs a free flow of authentic information.

The situation in the region is evolving, with cracks in both the ground and buildings being reported daily. Public speculation on probable causes and on fresh incidents of land subsidence is inevitable. The information vacuum left by the government will be filled by sources that may often be dubious. Granted, NDMA's expert committee's conclusion will come after a thorough examination of the situation. However, with Joshimath residents' anxieties running high, periodic communication by scientific bodies is necessary. Also, satellite pictures of the region are not limited to Isro's, and plenty of foreign scientists are working on the Joshimath subsidence.

Global experience of Covid hammered home the lesson that scientific collaboration is the best way to diagnose a problem and find a solution. Stringent restrictions on the information flow is self-defeating. Governments at all levels in India need to encourage their institutions to collaborate with scientists in the private sector and in foreign institutions. A bigger pool of experts analysing a subject is more likely to come up with useful insights.

NDMA's gag order is the second such sarkari instance in the recent past. A few weeks back ICAR issued a similar one for GM mustard. Debates and disagreements are intrinsic to science. They expand the boundaries of knowledge. Official attempts to curb information and debate trigger suspicion. In addition, a culture of doing-little also delays recognition of problems. Joshimath's land subsidence, which even official studies noted decades ago, is an example.

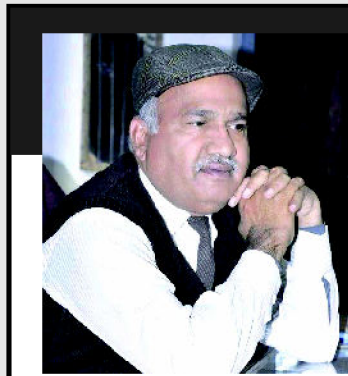

The schedule should be such that your personal responsibilities can also be accommodated and you don't have any problem in working accordingly. Whatever you do in your daily life. Ask yourself how hard you are working towards the goal you want to achieve. If not why so? Take care of health Also take special care of your health during the papers. Stay away from any kind of stress. 7-8 hours of sleep is very important because with a tired body the mind is not interested in studying. Do not waste time on difficult questions in the exam. However, thereafter, no action

was initiated. "We know working here is risky but we don't have other options. For a long time we have been pestering for repair and reconstruction of the building but till date, no action has been taken. The Farzand Ali Market Fund Committee under the direction of the District Administration is presently the owner and managers of this market," said a shop owner. Another shop owner said, "it is high time the PBMC declared the building unsafe and dangerous. The civic body should also issue orders for the demolition of this structure. The District Administration which is taking care of this market

How to time manage time in board exam

-Vijay Garg Practice writing quickly: You can try your hand at solving more and more practice papers, sample papers and past years' exam papers. Select a time limit for each question and try to adhere to the same and then check if you are able to complete your paper within the preset time constraints. You have to work on your writing speed while keeping your handwriting legible. If you won't work on your writing speed before the exam, you might be surprised at how difficult it is to write quickly and neatly under the pressure of

the time limit on the main day. Your messy handwriting in the answer script will surely annoy the person marking your paper before even checking the whole answer. So if you don't want to undersell yourself, work out a way to write quickly and neatly. Prioritise the questions: After reading the whole question paper thoroughly, mark the questions which you are more confident about and are sure to complete those questions in less time. After solving such questions, you can use the remaining time to attempt other questions that seem to be

complex to you. Be realistic with each answer: Assign each question a fixed time so that you can manage your time to complete the paper. Get an idea that what sort of answers you can realistically write in the time you've got. For example: If you've got 45 minutes for an essay question, check if you can fit in an introduction, main points and a conclusion within that time limit. Avoid writing useless text which does not relate to what has been asked in the question. Keep your answers apt and informative.
