New Delhi, Mar. 3 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, today addressed post-budget webinar organized by The Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). This is the eighth post-budget webinar addressed by the Prime Minister. Theme of the webinar was 'Make in India for the World'. The Prime Minister said that the budget has many significant provisions for Aatmnirbhar



Bharat and Make in India. He said that it is not acceptable that a country like India ends up merely as a market. He pointed towards supply chain disruptions during the pandemic and other uncertainties to

underline the critical importance of Make in India. On the other hand, the Prime Minister continued, positive factors like demographic dividend of young and talented population,

democratic set up, natural resources should also encourage us to move towards Make in India with determination. He also referred to his call for zero defect-zero effect manufacturing that he gave from the

ramparts of Red Fort. Aatmnirbhar is all the more important if we see from the prism of national security, he said.

The Prime Minister said that the world is looking at India as a manufacturing powerhouse. Manufacturing, he said, is the 15 per cent of India's GDP, but there are infinite possibilities before Make in India and we should work with full strength to create a robust manufacturing base in

Port Blair, Mar. 3 Rules, 1995, provide It is necessary to check impersonation of voters in the interest of purity of elections to Panchayats and Municipal Councils and for the conduct of such elections in a fair manner. Rule (68) of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Panchayats) (Election Procedure) Rules, 1995 and Rule (55) of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Municipal) (Election Procedure) having the EPICs, and such electors will find it difficult to cast their vote. The Election Commission, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, after taking into account all relevant factors and the legal and factual position, has directed that the following alternative documents to EPICs may be used for establishing the identity of those electors who have not been provided with EPICs or have lost their EPICs and whose names are included in the Electoral Rolls viz. Unique Identity Aadhaar Card, Indian Passport, Motor Vehicle Driving Licence, PAN Card issued by the Income Tax Department, Service Identity Cards issued to their employees by the Central Govt./Public Sector Undertakings

The Prime Minister stressed the difference between availability of a product as opposed to availability of Made in India product in the market. He reiterated his dismay that many of the supplies for India's various festivals are seeing foreign providers whereas they have been and can be easily provided by local manufacturers. He also emphasized that ambit of 'Vocal for Local' goes well beyond buying 'diyas' on Diwali. He asked the private sector to push the factors of vocal for local and Aatmnirbhar Bharat in their marketing and branding efforts. "Take pride in the products your company makes and instill this sense of pride in your Indian customers as well. For this some common branding can also be considered", he added. The Prime Minister highlighted the need to find new destinations for the local products.

This budget has given significant importance of MSME through credit facilitation and technology upgradation. The Government has also announced a RAMP program of Rs 6,000 crore for MSMEs. The budget has also focused on developing new railway logistics products for farmers, for large industries and MSMEs. The Prime Minister mentioned removal of 25 thousand compliances and auto renewal of licences, leading to significant reduction in the compliance burden. Similarly, digitization is bringing speed and transparency in the regulatory framework. "From Common Spice Form to National Single Window System to set up a company, now you are feeling our development friendly approach at every step", he added.

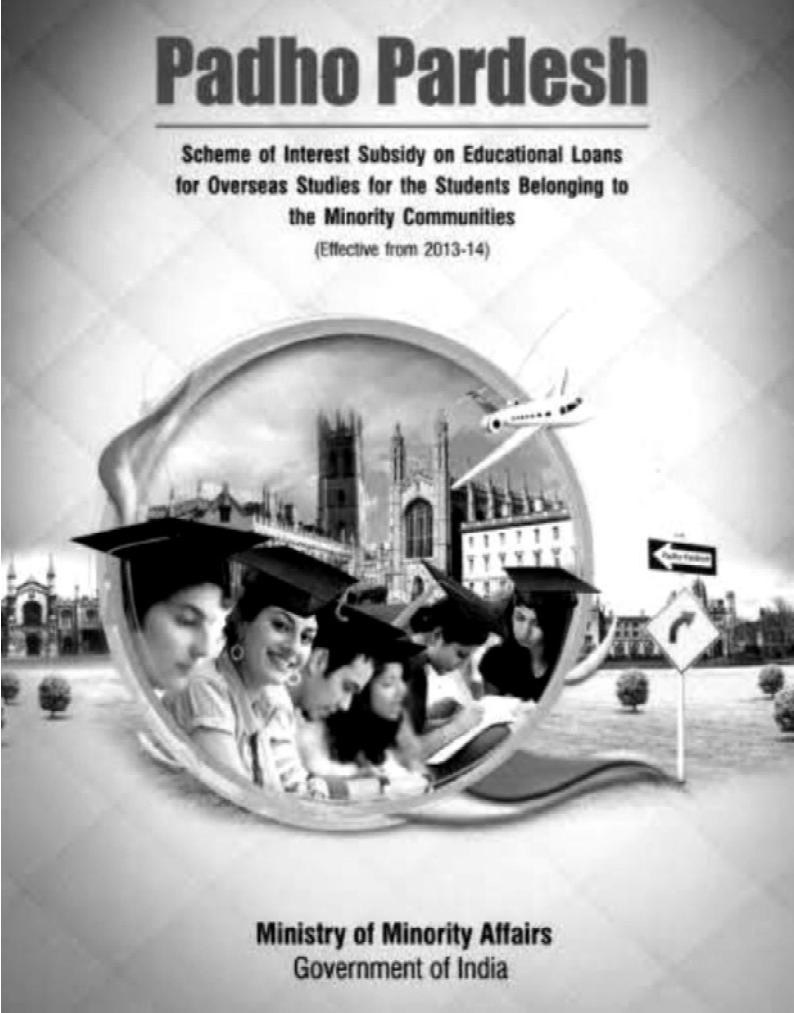
Padho Pardesh- Scheme of Interest subsidy on educational loans for overseas studies for students belonging to Minority Communities

Port Blair, Mar. 3

The Ministry of Minority Affairs, GoI is implementing Padho Pardesh- Scheme of Interest subsidy on Educational Loans for Overseas Studies for the students belonging to Minority Communities. The objective of the scheme is to award interest subsidies to meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections of notified minority communities to provide them better opportunities for higher education abroad and enhance their employability.

Eligibility Criteria:

- ◆ The student should have secured admission in the approved courses at Masters, M.Phil. or Ph.D. levels abroad.
- ◆ He/she should have availed loan from a scheduled bank under the Education Loan Scheme of the Indian Banks Association (IBA) for the purpose.
- ◆ Students should apply for benefits under the scheme during the 1st year of the course. Fresh applications received during the 2nd year or subsequent years will not be accepted in anycase.
- ◆ Preference will be given to those applications that are covered under the lower rate of interest by various banks of each State/UT to their quota.
- ◆ Payment of financial



benefit may be linked with Aadhar Number if available.

Conditions for Interest Subsidy

The Scheme is applicable for higher studies abroad. The interest subsidy shall be linked with the existing Educational Loan Scheme of the Indian Banks' Association (IBA) and restricted to students enrolled for a course at Masters, M.Phil., and Ph.D. levels.

Income Ceiling:

- ◆ Total income from all sources of the employed candidate or his/ her parents/guardians in case of the unemployed candidate shall not exceed Rs. 6.00 lakh per annum.
- ◆ Income certificate issued by the competent authority in the State/ Union Territory should be submitted in support of income shown by a candidate.
- Selection of Candidates:**
- ◆ The designated bank, on

the direction of the Ministry of Minority Affairs will open the portal for receiving applications for the claims of interest subsidy under the scheme and will be examined and recommended for award of interest subsidy under the scheme by a Selection Committee.

- ◆ Portal will be opened only once in a financial Year for fresh applications.
- ◆ For renewal cases, the portal may be opened every quarter or as decided by the Ministry.

Rate of Interest Subsidy :

- ◆ Under the scheme, interest payable by the students availing of the education loans of the IBA for the period of moratorium (i.e. course period, plus one year or six months after getting a job, whichever is earlier) as prescribed under the Education Loan Scheme of the IBA, shall be borne by the Government of India.
- ◆ The Candidate will bear the Principal installments and interest beyond the moratorium period.

Implementing Agencies:

The designated Bank as per MoU between the Bank and the Ministry of Minority Affairs will implement the scheme. <https://canarabanksis.in/PadhoSTDPortal/login.aspx> Portal is open now for accepting the application, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.

Govt. notifies rules for displaying fitness certificate, registration mark on vehicles

New Delhi, Mar. 3

Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has issued a draft notification for validity of fitness certificate and registration mark of the motor vehicle to be exhibited on the vehicles in the manner as prescribed in the draft rules. In case of heavy goods and passenger vehicles, medium goods vehicles, and light motor vehicles, it shall be exhibited on the upper

edge of the left side of the wind screen. In case of auto-rickshaw, e-rickshaw, e-cart, and quadricycle, it shall be exhibited on the upper edge of the left side of the wind screen, if fitted. In case of Motor cycle, it shall be exhibited on the conspicuous part of the vehicle. This shall be displayed in yellow colour on blue background in Type Arial Bold Script. (Source:india.gov.in)

Elaborate security arrangements made by A&N Police for upcoming Panchayat & Municipal Election

Port Blair, Mar. 3

Municipal & Panchayat Elections are scheduled to be held in A&N Islands on March 6, 2022 and counting will be held on March 8, 2022. The A&N Police is committed to ensure free, fair, impartial and peaceful elections and accordingly has put in place elaborate Police/ security arrangements. The Police Department has deployed sufficient Police personnel for election related duties. The deployment includes Police personnel from District Police, Armed Police/Special Armed Police, PHQ, India Reserve Battalion (IRBn), PTS etc. In addition, Communication Wing, Fire Service and Special Branch will perform election duties as per Police arrangements plan.

The votes will be cast in 800 Polling Booths on 6th March, 2022. Sufficient static Police personnel have been deputed at each polling booth to ensure that no unauthorized person gains access to polling station and voters can cast their votes in free, fair and peaceful manner. Lady Police has also been detailed at each Polling Station. The Police staff will be adequately equipped with wireless sets for seamless communication and prompt reporting of any Law &Order situation. Out of 800 polling booths, some booths have

been identified as sensitive booths. Detailed duty briefings have been conducted at various levels to sensitize officers of all ranks.

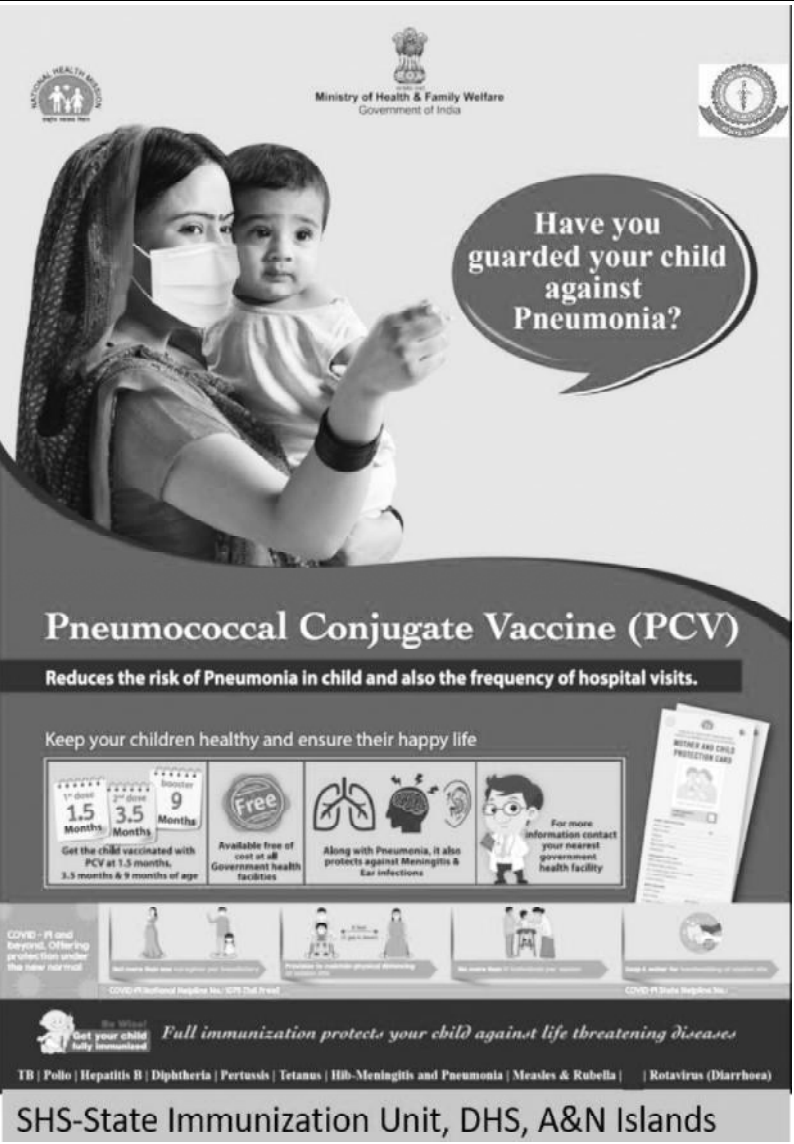
A number of supervisory officers have been deployed to supervise entire law and order arrangement. To assist in supervision, sector police officers have been deployed

who will move round the clock in their designated jurisdiction to attend to any law and order problem. Additionally, Special Check- Posts and Police Pickets are being set up in sensitive areas and the Police have also increased patrolling in such areas. Static surveillance teams, striking forces, and special

teams have also been constituted to avoid any untoward incidents.
