PM launches 'Sankalp Saptah', a week-long programme for Aspirational Blocks 112 districts that were 'Aspirational Districts' have now become 'Inspirational Districts': PM

New Delhi, Sept. 30(PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi launched a unique week-long programme for Aspirational Blocks in the country called 'Sankalp Saptah' at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi today. He also launched the Aspirational Blocks Programme Portal and inaugurated the exhibition showcased on the occasion. The Prime Minister also interacted with 3 Block Level Officers.

Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister noted the venue - Bharat Mandapam and the gathering - people who are taking care of development in the far-flung areas. It is an indication of the Government's thinking that such a gathering is taking place at the venue of the G20 Summit, where people deciding the direction of world affairs, gathered just a month ago, he said. The Prime Minister welcomed the ground-level change makers. "For me, this gathering is no less than G20", Shri Modi stressed. He said that this programme is a symbol of the success of Team Bharat and the spirit of Sabka Prayas. This programme is important for India's future and 'Sankalp se Siddhi' is inherent in this.



The Prime Minister said, "In any list of the top 10 programmes of Independent India, the Aspirational District Programme will figure in golden letters". The Aspirational District Programme has transformed the lives of about 25 crore people in 112 districts, he said. The success of this programme became the basis of the Aspirational Blocks programme, he added, mentioning the global accolades for the programme. The Prime Minister underlined that the Aspirational Blocks programme is bound to be a huge success not only because the scheme is unprecedented, but also because the people working towards it are prodigious. Recalling his interaction with the 3 Block Level

Officers, the Prime Minister highlighted his self-confidence increases manifold after witnessing the morale of those working on the ground level. Shri Modi emphasized that he wishes to work alongside the ground-level officers as a member of their team and expressed confidence that the goals of the programme will be achieved before time. Prime Minister, Shri Modi underlined that the programme will be meticulously monitored by him not because he wants to test their skills but because the successes on the ground level give him more energy and enthusiasm to work tirelessly. "The progress chart of the Aspirational District programme became an inspiration for me", he added.

Social Welfare Deptt. implementing National Family Benefit Scheme Eligible beneficiaries may obtain form from Directorate of Social Welfare or Offices of CDPOs

Port Blair, Sept. 30

The Directorate of Social Welfare is implementing the National Family Benefit Scheme (NFBS) which is administered by the Ministry of Rural Development under the National Social Assistance Program (NSAP). As per the scheme, an amount of Rs. 20000/- will be given as a lump sum assistance to the

bereaved household in the event of the death of the breadwinner.

It is clarified that any event of death (natural or otherwise) would make the family eligible for assistance. A woman in the family, who is a homemaker, is also considered a 'breadwinner' for this purpose. The family

benefit will be paid to such surviving member of the household of the deceased poor, who after local inquiry, is found to be the head of the household. For the purpose of the scheme, the term 'household' would include spouses, minor children, unmarried daughters, and dependent parents.

In case of the death of an unmarried adult, the term household would include minor brothers/sisters and dependent parents.

The death of such a breadwinner should have occurred while/she is more than 18 years of age and less than 59 years of age. The

the importance of child rights. **Right to Education:** In India, the Right to Education for children is a constitutional right. The Right to Education (RTE) Act, 2009, mandates free and compulsory education for children aged 6-14, ensuring equal opportunities and prohibiting discrimination. The Government's efforts aim to enhance access, quality, and inclusivity in the Indian education system.

Right to Healthcare: The right to healthcare for children is a fundamental aspect of their well-being. The Government has implemented various initiatives to ensure children receive proper medical care, nutrition, and immunization. The National Health Mission and Integrated Child Development Services are key programs aimed at safeguarding children's health and development.

regions of the country should be looked after. "Absence of all-encompassing development, touching everyone, benefitting all may show numerical development but basic development does not take place. That is why it is important that we should move while covering every grassroots parameter".

The Prime Minister urged the Secretaries of Departments present on the occasion to work in two new directions - Rapid development of every State and handholding of backward Districts. He asked them to identify 100 blocks in the country that are lagging behind in their respective Departments and work towards improving the conditions. He insisted that all parameters of development would change once the 100 identified blocks move above the country's average. He suggested that all Departments from the center emphasize the development of the blocks which have room for improvement. Highlighting the role of State Governments, the Prime Minister suggested identifying the 100 most backward villages and creating a model to improve them which can be further replicated to develop the next 1000 villages.

Referring to the Pran of making India a developed nation by 2047, the Prime Minister said that being developed does not mean developed metro cities and backward villages. "We don't follow that model, we wish to move with 140 crore people", he said. He mentioned the healthy competition among districts during the Aspirational Districts programme and gave the example of Kutch district in Gujarat which was once considered a place for punishment posting for officers but has now become the most respectable place with the dedication and diligence of officers who were posted there after the earthquake. He credited the young officers for the developments carried out in the aspirational districts of the country. For the Aspirational Block programme, the Prime Minister suggested the State Government encourage young officers by promoting those who become successful at the block level. The Prime Minister also talked about the shift to outcome from just output orientation of the Government's budget. This has brought about a qualitative change, he said. Speaking from his vast experience of governance, the Prime Minister said that the budget is not the only factor of change. He highlighted optimum utilization of resources and convergence as the basis of development without budget. He said convergence and complementarities of schemes should be leveraged.

The Prime Minister asked the delegates to focus on 5 parameters and get good results. This will increase their confidence. With this gradual address of problems, the block will become a source of aspiration for others, he said. "112 districts that were Aspirational Districts have now become Inspirational Districts. I am sure within a year at least 100 Aspirational Blocks will become Inspirational Blocks", he concluded.

Shri Suman Bery, Vice Chairman, NITI Aayog was present on the occasion among others.

inconvenience of having to travel to Sub-Divisional Headquarters located in Kamorta to obtain various certificates. In response to that, it was announced that a feasibility assessment for implementation of online services at these Islands has been done by the team and the District Administration will very soon establish e-corners in both these Islands. This development will significantly reduce the need for residents to visit Kamorta for accessing these essential services.

Until the e-corners are set up, an interim arrangement has been put in place by the Assistant Commissioner, Nancowrie. The residents can now submit their applications to the respective ASRO of the Island. The ASRO will forward those applications to Kamorta, where necessary certificates will be processed. Once issued, the certificates will be sent back to ASRO from where the residents can collect the same locally.

Furthermore, the applicants seeking certificates such as income, tribal and local certificates were handed over the same during the event. Altogether, 34 Income Certificates, 25 Local Certificates and 31 Schedule Tribe Certificates were issued during the camp at these two locations. Beside this, on the spot registration and updation of Aadhaar Cards were also carried out at the venue itself. 353 Aadhaar Card updations and registrations were done during the campaign. This streamlined process greatly benefited the local population. The tribal leaders demanded for continuing service of Aadhaar Card registration and updation at both the Islands, for which, it was assured that a dedicated camp for registration and updation of Aadhaar Card will be organized in these Islands on regular basis.

The Tribal Leaders expressed their appreciation for this first of kind community based initiative which serves to bridge the gap between Administration and remote communities and requested to organize similar camps in future as well, on frequent and regular basis, a press release from Assistant Commissioner, Nancowrie said.

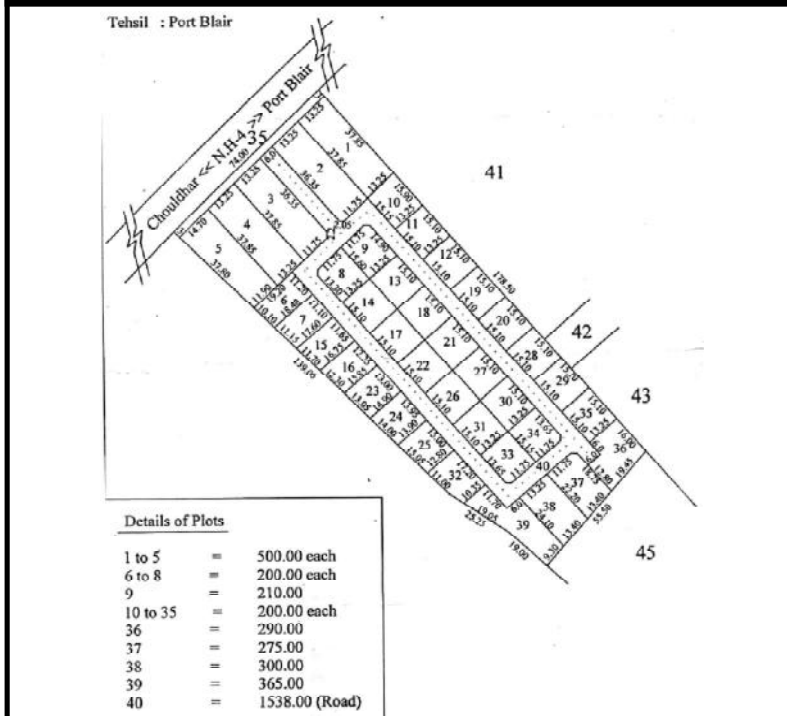
