struggling to make their ends meet. This sudden unilateral decision of the Management of this School is definitely going to pressurise many students to leave this institution for want of money. Monthly fee for class IX and X is fixed Rs 2000 per month. In comparison all the other private educational institutions charge much less. When Vivekanand Kendra

vidyalaya charge only Rs 3200 as session fee per annum, Kamraj School charges Rs 9000 as Maintenance and Miscellaneous fees. There is urgent need for Director of Education to interfere in this issue to ensure that education doesn't turn into business with lucrative profit.

## Model Career Centre organizes Career Guidance Programme on Civil Services Examination

Port Blair, Apr 06: The Model Career Centre under the aegis of the Department of Labour, Employment and Training has organized a Career Guidance Programme on the topic of "Civil Services Examination" intending to educate the students and aspirants of the Islands about the syllabus, strategy and methodology to crack civil service exams at the Tagore College of Education Auditorium on 04th April 2022.

More than 350 aspirants from different colleges, schools and other interested youths of the Islands were present.

On the occasion, Mr. Suneel Anchipaka IAS, DC( SA) & Secretary (RD & PRI) was Chief Guest while Mr. Hari Kallikkat IAS, Secretary (L&ET) & ADM (SA), Mr. R.Kalaivanan IPS, ASP(SA) and Ms. B.Yashaswini, IAS, AC (U/T) presided over the programme as facilitators.

The Chief Guest Mr. Suneel Anchipaka IAS, DC (SA) & Secretary (RD & PRI) while addressing the gathering mentioned that the sole objective of this orientation programme is to motivate the aspirant students of these Islands to achieve success in civil services exam. He expounded that the civil services exam is considered one of the most challenging exams in the country and it is not only because of the knowledge in the variety of subjects being tested but also because of test of perseverance,

dedication, discipline, and determination. Among other challenges sustaining motivation during preparation is the key determinant of the success in civil services exam. To succeed in the exam, one must have a proper plan and executable preparation strategy. An executable strategy acts as a constant motivator for the aspirants of the civil services. He appealed to the participants to draw up the right plan and believe in smart work to crack the civil services exam.

Mr. Hari Kallikkat IAS, Secretary (L & ET) & ADM (SA) has briefed comprehensively about the pattern of civil services exams. He spelled out that one must start preparation in advance strictly as per the syllabus provided by the UPSC to clear preliminary and main exams besides reading and noting national daily newspapers especially editorial columns and perusal of NCERT textbooks from 6th std to 12th std. There are several myths that only toppers can crack the civil services exam but the fact remains that even a dedicated aspirant can crack the same with adequate dedication. He emphasized that the civil services exam would not test academic brilliance beyond the syllabus but would test your perseverance, adaptive skills, courage and positivity.

Ms. B Yashaswani IAS, AC (U/T) elucidated that it is ideal to read current affairs in the morning, prelims in the afternoon, study for

the optional subject in the evening and round it off with Mains subject at night and one must evaluate their preparation at regular intervals and sufficient time need to be spared for testing through practice and mock interviews at regular intervals which will act as a feedback mechanism in rectifying mistakes. Mr. R. Kalaivanan IPS, ASP (SA) explicated that the UPSC conducts the Civil Services Exam to recruit suitable candidates for IAS, IPS, IFS and other allied services. Lakhs of aspirants apply for the exam, yet only a few achieve the feat therefore the aspirants of civil service must develop the source of inner motivation and inner resistance and resilience.

The achievements of IAS officers who made significant social changes in society are displayed in the mode of standees in the Tagore College of education auditorium with an object to motivate the students to venture into the civil services.

Concluding the program, the aspirants and teachers from various schools/colleges expressed their gratitude for conducting such a beneficial program and requested to conduct the same at regular intervals. Mr. Hari Kallikkat IAS, Secretary (L&ET) gave instructions to the department accordingly.

## NSUI State General Secretary demands for conducting campus interviews, Job Fairs and providing free Wi-fi in all colleges of A&N Islands.

The National Students Union of India's State General Secretary Mr. Saurav Nair on Tuesday demanded for conducting campus interviews, Job Fairs and providing free Wi-fi in all colleges of A&N Islands.

In a letter addressed to the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands, Mr. Nair stated that there are totally nine government colleges functioning in Andaman & Nicobar Islands but no Campus interviews are conducted in the said 9 colleges which hampers the job opportunity of Islander students. He suggested that the A&N Administration should make a proper tie up with private

companies of A&N Islands and mainland states in order to conduct campus interviews and provide the opportunity of employment for the graduating students.

Further, he highlighted the directives of MHRD in which they asked all universities and colleges of state's/UT's to make their campus digital by providing internet services for free and install Wi-fi facilities. The deadline to complete the process of Wi-fi campus was given as August 2018. Mr. Nair stated that till date no action has been initiated by A&N Administration and there is no Wi-fi facility provided inside any single campus for students. Moreover, he stated that the

A&N Administration conducts "Job Fair" every year in the capital city Port Blair which comes under South Andaman District. But due to no proper or timely transportation connectivity between different Islands, thousands of students residing outside Port Blair cannot participate in the said Job Fair. Mr. Nair demanded to conduct Job Fairs separately in all 3 Districts of A&N Islands. Hence, he requested the Hon'ble Lt. Governor to direct UT Administration to look into the plight of student community of A&N Islands and take appropriate action in students interest.

## MP demands to set up one Gym in every ward of Port Blair Municipal Council and every Gram Panchayats of A & N Islands

The Member of Parliament of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma has requested the Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Andaman and Nicobar Islands to set up one Gym in every ward of Port Blair Municipal Council and every Gram Panchayats of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, so that youths remain actively focus in health and constructive activities. He also requested the Member of Parliament to order inspection of currently operational Gyms in many wards and Panchayats and

provide those Gyms with the latest fitness equipment.

In a letter addressed to the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, the Member of Parliament mentioned that in recent years many Gyms have been established in several wards of PBMC and Gram Panchayat across Andaman and Nicobar Islands, which are extremely popular among youths of concerned areas. Such facilities not only help youths to focus on their health but also help in saving youths from several harmful distractions, he added.

However, he noted that there are still many areas where there is no such facility.

## PS Pahargaon Staff solves attempt of Murder Case within 24 Hours

Port Blair, Apr 03: The team of PS Pahargaon solved the attempt of murder case of a young girl in Garacharma and arrested the absconding accused person within 24 hours.

On 30th March 2022, an 18 yrs old girl was brutally assaulted with a machete inside her house at Garacharma Murdha Khadi Road by the offender Srikant Sardar. On receipt of information, an FIR vide No. 57/22 dated 30/03/2022 U/s 450/307 IPC was registered at PS Pahargaon. The offender absconded from the spot and went underground. Acting swiftly, 02 teams consisting

of HCA Raja, PC Manikandan, PC Jagdish Babu, PC Amit Kumar, PC Santosh Kumar Yadav, PC Ashok Kumar, PC LendaHoro, PC CheriyaUraon and PC Suresh were formed under the supervision of Insp. Girish Kumar, SHO PS Pahargaon for search and arrest of the absconding accused person.

The teams followed several leads including sifting through various CCTV footages of the locality and examining several witnesses. Finally, the teams were able to track the accused who was hiding near Fish landing jetty, Junglighat.

Immediately, the accused person was nabbed by the team of PS Pahargaon and the weapon of offence was also recovered. The accused is identified as Srikant Sardar S/o ChamuSardar, (33) yrs, Pvt. Worker, R/o Garacharma.

Help from the general public was crucial in solving this crime and therefore, the general public is requested to pass credible information regarding any anti-social activities noticed in their locality to phone numbers 100, 03192-250525, 9434280100. The identity of the informer will be kept secret.

## Member of Parliament once again prominently highlights unemployment Issue of A & N Islands in Parliament; Demands to fill up nearly 10,000 vacant posts



The Member of Parliament of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma has once again highlighted the unemployment problem of Andaman and Nicobar Islands in Parliament. Highlighting this issue during the Budget Session of Parliament today Mr. Kudeep Rai Sharma said that on 14 December 2021 the Andaman and Nicobar Administration had issued an order to fill up all vacant posts in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The Member of Parliament during the session requested the Government of India to issue directions to the Andaman and Nicobar Administration to fill up nearly 10,000 vacant posts as early as possible, as lakhs of unemployed youths in A & N Islands are struggling to get a government job.

He also urged the government to stop online recruitment because unemployment is a major issue in these Islands. Regarding generating jobs through Palm Oil Cultivation, he said that recently the government has made a financial outlay of Rs.11,040 crore for Palm Oil Cultivation and Under this scheme, it is proposed to cover an additional area of 6.5 lakh hectare (ha.) for oil palm. The Member of Parliament informed the Parliament that Palm Oil Cultivation was started by the Government of India in Little Andaman Island of Andaman and Nicobar Island in 1978 and in November 2017 the Palm Oil plantation was closed. He urged the Government to restart Palm Oil Cultivation in Little Andaman under this scheme so that thousands of unemployed

youth of Vivekanda Pur, Rabindra Nagar, Ram Krishna Pur, Netaji Nagar and Hut Bay get employment. Regarding the unemployment issue of Long Island the Member of Parliament said that in 1956 boat building work was started at Long Island but the project was later closed. He requested the government to start boat building at Long Island so that the unemployment problem of Long Island can be solved. Earlier also on several occasions the Member of Parliament had highlighted the issue of growing unemployment in Andaman and Nicobar Islands and demanded filling up of all vacant posts and conducting all recruitment in totally offline mode.

## Member of Parliament demands Chartered flights between Port Blair and Mainland sectors from 15, April to July end 2022 so that Islanders can get plane tickets at an affordable rate

The Member of Parliament of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma has requested the Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Andaman and Nicobar Islands to operate Chartered flights in Port Blair - Kolkata and Port Blair - Chennai routes twice a week from 15, April to July end 2022 so that Islanders can get plane tickets at an affordable rate. In a letter addressed to the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, the Member of Parliament mentioned that due to ongoing repair works of the runway of Veer Savarkar International Airport, at present flights are not landing at VSI Airport for three days in every alternative week. He added that because of this restriction the number of flights to Andaman and Nicobar Islands has also been reduced by Airlines

companies, as a result the Airfare in Port Blair Mainland Sector has gone up. The Member of Parliament pointed out that at present for many 'specific' days in coming months, the Airfare has gone upto Rs. 20,000, which is unaffordable for Islanders, who have to visit mainland for various social, medical, education, job etc purposes. He mentioned that as summer vacation is also going to start soon, thousands of Islanders are now planning to visit the mainland but they are shocked to see the astronomical high rates of flight tickets. Most importantly, Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma pointed out that the students of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and their parents, who are planning to pursue their Undergraduate, Post Graduate,

technical courses and undergo various coaching classes in Mainland India are also finding it very difficult to plan their visit to the mainland due to soaring airfare. Adding to this, he said that last two years thousands of people from Andaman and Nicobar Islands have not gone to Mainland India to visit their native to meet their parents due to the Covid-19 pandemic and hence this year they would like to visit the mainland. Considering the problems being faced by people of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, he requested the Hon'ble Lt. Governor to operate Chartered flights in Port Blair - Kolkata and Port Blair - Chennai routes twice a week from 15, April to July end 2022 so that Islanders can get plane tickets at an affordable rate.

## MP requests CS to organize Flea Market and Similar events twice a week

In a letter addressed to the Chief Secretary the Member of Parliament mentioned that before the pandemic people of South Andaman used to witness events like Flea Market on a regular basis, which were very

He added that these extremely popular events were great sources of entertainment and amusement for the people of South Andaman region, who often feel isolated due to remoteness from Mainland India. These events also used to attract a lot of visiting tourists. The Member of Parliament added that the Flea Market was also a source of income for various social groups and SHGs and a good platform for local artists to

showcase their talent, who are hired for various events. As the third wave of COVID-19 is over and there are zero active COVID-19 cases in Andaman and Nicobar Islands, the Member of Parliament requested the Chief Secretary of Andaman and Nicobar Islands to issue instruction to the concerned department to organize Flea Market and similar events atleast twice a month at Marina Park, Port Blair for the entertainment and amusement of Islanders.

## SOUTH ANDAMAN DISTRICT POLICE SOLVES BURGLARY CASE AND ARRESTS 6 PERSONS

In continuation of the zero tolerance policy against any kind of crime, PS Aberdeen staff have cracked the Aberdeen Bazaar Hotel burglary case and recovered 2 Nos. I-Phones worth Rs. 1.17 Lakhs and Rs. 20,700/- cash.

On 21/03/2022, a case vide FIR No. 67/22 U/s 457/380 IPC was registered at PS Aberdeen and investigation was entrusted to SI Regan Isaac of PS Aberdeen. The case was initially a blind case of theft of Rs. 2 Lakhs of cash from the Hotel Beach Castle, Aberdeen Bazaar. However, working professionally, the team collected technical evidences in the form of CCTV footages, CDRs and identified the accused person. Based on the investigation, total 06 persons have been arrested for their

involvement in the crime. The team of PS Aberdeen lead by SI Regan Isaac (Investigating Officer), HC/Sunil Singh Yadav, PC/S.N Rao, PC/Sandeep Lakra, PC/Sonu Yadav, PC/Ashish Kumar and PC/Shiv Kumar under the supervision of Insp. ## POSITIONING OF FIRST INSHORE PATROL VESSEL(IPV) AT THE SOUTHERN GROUP OF ISLANDS



Headquarters Andaman and Nicobar Command (ANC) welcomed its first Inshore Patrol Vessel (IPV), Indian Coast Guard Ship Rajdhwaaj on 03 Apr 22 at Campbell Bay. The ship is rebased from Port Blair and is the first IPV based at Southern Group of Islands. It was formally inducted in a rebasing ceremony held at Campbell Bay, with all security stakeholders and civil dignitaries in attendance. The Vessel is last in the series of eight Inshore Patrol Vessel designed

and constructed indigenously by M/s GRSE, Kolkata. The ship was commissioned in Indian Coast Guard on 11 Dec 2013 at Chennai and has been operating in Andaman and Nicobar Region since Apr 2018. The ship is equipped with state of art navigation and communication equipment. ICGS Rajdhwaaj has extended patrolling capabilities and capability to intercept targets. Along with surveillance and intercept capabilities, the Ship is well equipped to respond/ contain

marine pollution and execute Search & Rescue (SAR) operations in the Area of Responsibility.

Basing of an Inshore Patrol Vessel at the Southern Group of Islands will enhance the capabilities of Andaman and Nicobar Command (ANC) in maintaining Surveillance over two major Sea Lines of Control (SLOCs) i.e. 10 Degree Channel in the North and 6 Degree Channel in the South.

## BSNL launches Public Data Office (PDO) near Jirkatang Check post and Shaheed Dweep

Port Blair, Apr 06: To cater to the needs of the general public and tourists for high-speed public internet services, BSNL A&N has launched BSNL WiFi services through the Public Data Office (PDO) near Jirkatang check post and Shaheed Dweep on 05th April 2022.

The Public Data Office (PDO) is a retail hotspot location where users can walk in and use high-speed internet service connectivity through Wi-Fi. The public Wi-Fi service will be available within a radius of 100 to 150 meters from the hotspot which is located in PDO.

PDOs are primarily aimed at removing the digital divide for internet access for the rural population. The following recharge plans are offered for the

users of these Public Wifi, wherein 1 GB of data will be available at Rs 9 on 1-day validity, 3 GB data for 3 days validity at Rs 19, 7 GB data for 7 days at Rs 39, 15 GB data for 15 days at Rs 59 and 30 GB data for 30 days at Rs 69. In addition, BSNL A&N has started providing high-speed Broadband on radio under the brand Bharat Air Fibre at Shaheed Dweep, which will help to provide faster and more reliable internet services on the Island.

Bharat Air Fibre has speed at par with high-speed fibre FTTH and all FTTH plans are applicable for Air Fiber. This being completely wireless technology is easy to deploy, more reliable needs less maintenance and will provide connectivity in Non-feasible areas

and villages which can't be connected through FTTH.

To boost the mobile internet services at Little Andaman Island, BSNL A&N has recently augmented 2 Nos of 3G towers to 4G (working on the 3G spectrum) and 3 Nos of 2G towers to 3G. Customers of these areas are requested to upgrade their SIMs to 4G SIMs (if not done earlier) by visiting the nearest BSNL Point of Sale and avail of BSNL 4G services.

## JICA signs grant agreement of 4 billion Yen (INR 250 crores approx.) with the GoI for the 'Project for the Improvement of Power Supply in A & N Islands'

Port Blair, Apr 06: The Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) yesterday signed a grant agreement with the Government of India, to provide aid of up to 4,016,000,000 Japanese Yen (INR 250 crores approx.) for the Project for the Improvement of Power Supply in Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

The objective of the project is to utilise the power generated from renewable energy sources and stabilise the power supply in South Andaman, by introducing necessary equipment and facilities such as storage battery system (30MW / 15MWh), grid interconnection cassette, SCADA, buildings etc. for energy storage, thereby contributing to the improvement of industrial competitiveness in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The scope of work for the project includes

construction of facilities, procurement and installation of equipment, and consulting services.

Speaking on the grant agreement signing, Mr SAITO Mitsunori, Chief Representative, JICA India Office, said, "Stable and reliable power supply is critical for a better livelihood and promotion of industries in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Being disconnected from the mainland, the group of islands currently rely on isolated generation and distribution systems powered by the diesel generation with frequent blackouts. However, Power development Plan in Andaman & Nicobar is under transitional stage from Diesel Power generation to Clean renewable energy. This project is assisting Power development policy and plan by Andaman and Nicobar

Administration through reduction of the carbon footprint by gradually replacing diesel-based power generation with greener energy. JICA is hopeful to support the Government of India's commitment made at the COP 26 Summit, towards net zero carbon emissions by 2070 as well as supplying 24X7 reliable and quality power to the people of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. We will provide all necessary support to the administration in achieving various milestones and targets outlined in this project roadmap." The project is targeted to complete by February 2024. The executing agency for the project is Andaman and Nicobar Administration, a release sent to Andaman Sheekha Daily by Cradle Communicare said here today.
